### ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The 2001 Annual General Meeting of Table Tennis Victoria was conducted at the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre (MSAC) on Sunday 1 April 2001 at 11am. The major items of business discussed related to:

- The TTA profit of \$20,000, Government funding including a \$75,000 promisory grant and \$80,000 from ASC. Possibly another \$40,000-\$50,000 from outstanding grants previously promised.
- Victoria does not have a representative on the TTA Board
- Issues relating to Victorian players who missed out on selection for the World and Commonwealth Championships
- TTV profit of \$39,000 due to the Taraflex flooring and computers taken in as assets
- Player registration fees for 2001 and impact of cost on small associations
- Vote for vacant board position. Phil Carruthers was declared elected to the TTV Board

# MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT (Phillip Carruthers)

Welcome to Table Tennis Victoria's 2001 Annual Report.

On the court Victoria has been less successful this year than it has in recent years. The number of registered players has been in decline in real terms for a number of years and erosion of the base of the table tennis can only weaken our peak. All our associations, clubs and individual members should seek to encourage new players. If each of us could get one friend to play one pennant in the coming year, the long term boost to table tennis in our state would be incredible.

At our clite level we recorded some excellent results, but we should be aware that we have no divine right to be the power base of table tennis in Australia. Other states, with strong assistance from their state governments and with private sponsorships, which dwarf the support we receive, have become more competitive and are laying the plans for future success. We need to regain our advantage so liaison with potential funding bodies will be a priority in the coming year.

The future is positive at Junior levels where Victoria is particularly strong in the Under 14 age group with the team winning the Australian Junior Championships and Kyle Davis and Champnarn In ranked 1 and 2.

Our Scnior players are also strong with 6 Victorian men ranked in the Top 10 in Australia for 2001 amd Miao Miao ranked the top womens player. The Victorian Mens and Womens Teams were both victorious at the Australian Closed Scnior Championships as well as Miao Miao individually winning the 2001 Womens Championships.

Veterans have again provided excellent results with the Mens and Womens Teams placing first in the Over 60 and Over 70s at the 2001 Australian Veterans Championships. Individually Olgerts Bergmanis, Joan Guggenheim and Ron Thomas came first in their prospective age groups.

Our staff have had a challenging year with Dale Gilson 'learning the ropes' as the Chief Executive Officer with quality support from Donna Dennis, Alois Rosario and Tammy Gough. Unfortunately Donna has left us

recently after helping TTV for 9 years, making a career progression move, and we wish her all the best in her new position. Also unfortunately, the specific funding which allowed us to employ Tammy Gough as a Development Officer ceased late last year and we were unable to continue to employ Tammy. We thank her and encourage her to continue to pursue her goals. On the positive side we have employed Renee Mc Hugh to replace Donna and look forward to Renee's development at TTV.

Finally, I would like to thank Greg Linwood. Greg's energy and passion for table tennis should be appreciated by all our members. We thank him for his commitment.

### CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS REPORT (Dale Gilson)

One of the most common questions I have answered since taking on this position was whether it was full or part time. The perception was that it is only part time, but after a year in this position I can guarantee that it is more than fulltime. It is an incredibly demanding position at times especially during events where days start early and finish late. Table Tennis is played 7 days a week from 9am to 11pm across Victoria and so there is little doubt that there is always plenty to do.

Firstly I would like to thank Graham Lockwood for his support in helping me case into this role. I think TTV's ability to remain a viable entity in challenging times has been largely due to the stability of its workforce. The sheer quantity of work that Donna, Alois and all the volunteers cover has been paramount to the success of the organisation. There is little doubt that more help is needed and I urge you all to help where possible.

Donna's decision to leave after 9 years has left a big hole and we thank her for her efforts during this time. The positive side is that it offers an opportunity for someone else and we have now secured the services of Renee Mc Hugh who has been terrific in the short time she has been with us.

2001 proved to be an absolute rollercoaster road. Many positives have come out the year but just as many negatives have countered all the good work put in by all. When I first started it was evident that relations were strained between TTV and TTA, TTV and MSAC, between some Board Members and some Sponsors. This was a difficult time to start a new job but I am pleased to say that year a later the Board is working well together, TTA have invited current TTV President Phillip Carruthers to join the National Board and our sponsors are once again happy to support us. Pleasingly all my requests to MSAC have been supported and encouraged. For Table Tennis in Victoria to prosper we must never forget the importance of the role each organisation and individual plays in helping us achieve our goals.

An important part of improving Table Tennis in Victoria was the 2001 player surveys we sent out to 3000 players. We received an excellent response with 1000 people replying. There are some wonderful suggestions and many reoccurring themes, which are important for us to correlate and present to MSAC for instance, when trying improve services at this facility. There is also some important feedback for Associations and TTV as to what our members want for the future. These will continue to be correlated and the final results will be forwarded to all Associations with results also being listed in future editions of Nets n Edges. Particular thanks go to AAA Table Tennis Equipment, Butterfly Australia and Vichealth for their support of the survey.

TTV tournaments ran smoothly during the year and were well attended; in particular the 50<sup>th</sup> Country Championships and Victorian Open Championships were well supported. While Victorian Table Tennis was successful in running professional events and our teams winning many local and National championships, behind the scenes there are many challenges ahead in 2002.

The disappointing aspect for TTV financially is that the best we aim for each year is to break even. This is proving more and more difficult as expenses continue to grow. We need to be making money in order to promote the sport and it is obvious that continuing to raise player registration fees is not the answer. There are many opportunities that are particularly obvious from this position but there is no money to follow them through. In order to understand why this is so has led me to analyse our move from the old Centre to MSAC four years ago, and whether it has been a success. We are in a different business at MSAC, one where we have no control over hire rates, merchandising and fundraising at the centre. Although we receive a license fee this has not altered in 4 years and is unlikely to in our final two years of our current contract.

Looking at the financial performance of the time we have been located at MSAC we have been very lucky to make a profit with a number of "one off" items getting us over the line during the previous three years. 2001 was a year where there were no "one off" items, Government grants were reduced by \$15,000 and our membership based dropped by 10%. While we expect the membership base to recover this year, the player registration fees lost for this year contributed greatly to the substantial financial loss for 2001.

Before we moved to MSAC there was also no need to fundraise yet these days we need to raise at least 100 strains and strain of \$20,000 in Sponsorship and Fundraising each year is becoming a full time job that has now been added to the CEO's role at the loss of time for other important duties.

It was also evident early on that TTV is heavily reliant on Government funding and we would be in trouble if we were to lose some of this funding. 2 Months later the funding was reduced by \$15,000. The ultimate result of this was the loss of the part time Sports Development Position held by Tammy Gough. I would like to thank Tammy for all her work in promoting Table Tennis in Victoria.

There are many areas that before we attempt to raise income we needed to assess if there is unnecessary expense involved. One such area was Social Membership, which TTV subsidised by \$3000 in 2001. This has subsequently been removed and in order to not penalise recreational players we now provide them with the opportunity to be covered under Table Tennis Victoria's Recreational Player Insurance Cover. The Nets n Edges Magazine is another area where TTV was subsidising it and I have now changed the format that each magazine will have enough advertising in it to cover its costs. This should guarantee that we will be able to continue to print it a couple of times a year as it is an important part of communicating with our members as well as recording the history of Table Tennis in Victoria.

There are a number of areas such as this that I am in the midst of changing to become more financially responsible. At this stage I am more comfortable that this years budget will be achieved having written it myself with the assistance of the current Board. However it should be noted that a loss of this size will not be easy to turn around in one year and we will need to see the support of our members at events such as the Annual Auction Dinner Dance.

There are a lot of changes that need to be made to reverse the 2001financial result. I urge you all to support the Staff, Board and your local Association in order to guarantee the long-term future of Table Tennis in Victoria.

Finally I would like to thank all the people who have welcomed and supported me during a very tough year in this position. It is greatly appreciated.

## DEVELOPMENT OFFICER'S REPORT (Alois Rosario)

Part funded by Sport & Recreation Victoria

The year saw another increase in the demand for school clinics throughout Victoria. This was serviced through the network of able coaches not only from TTV but through the associations. A further network needs to be established to service the demand and to assist table tennis to grow.

We conducted 116 separate school coaching visits involving approximately 5000 students throughout the year. There was also an increase in demand for schools wanting coaching for their school teams such as Wesley, Ivanhoe Grammar, Xavier College and several others. Many of these were referred to relevant coaches within our association.

We visited Albury/Wodonga, Eaglehawk/Bendigo, Geelong, Horsham, Shepparton, Sunraysia, Warracknabeal and Yarrawonga.

We advertised to all Active Australia schools for clinics during the year. There was a large response to the offer with approximately 20 replies.

There has been an increase in teacher education session with the Australian Catholic University running pre service training session for their students.

Thank you to all the coordinators in the association who spent many hours of coordination for the visits and the School Singles championships. Thanks also to Sport & Recreation Victoria for their funding and

support of the Sport Development Officer position. Thanks to the School Sport Unit through Doug Sandiford and Keith Grainger for their support and to the many teachers who put in their own time to assist the growth of table tennis in schools.

### JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT REPORT (Claire Dillon)

2001 was a year of learning for me in catching up on junior tournaments in Victoria as the Junior Portfolio holder. During the year, six junior tournaments were conducted by myself and support crew at MSAC. Of the junior tournaments held at MSAC; the Butterfly Easter Junior Classic had the largest field with 122 players, up from 100 players in 2000, which, was a pleasing result for all involved on the day. The annual Victorian Junior Open Championship was the second largest tournament attracting 108 players. There were also some good reports of increased player numbers at many of our regional Junior Tournaments.

Volunteers throughout 2001 continued to provide great support for the junior tournament program at MSAC and all our Associations. Of the many people kindly offering their assistance, I would like to extend a special thank-you to Angelo Tabone, Helen Pottage and Phil Davis who played a major role in supporting the bulk of the workload. I would also like to acknowledge the contribution made by some of the parents namely Bruce Carter, Phyllis Scales, Karen Donnelly, Peter Bishop and Braeme Spigelman. In addition to these key volunteers I would like to acknowledge the effort and the professionalism of others that contributed significantly to the junior tournament program in 2001 including the referees organised by Ruth Singer - not forgetting the junior selectors; Jim Montgomery, Phyllis Scales and Peng Huy Quach, and all the TTV staff.

Junior tournaments have changed since I last competed as a junior and I have come away from 2001 with a number of ideas to improve tournaments hosted by Table Tennis Victoria.

It was very obvious that our clubs are doing a wonderful job in the development of their junior players. During 2001, I continually noticed new faces arriving to play their first MSAC tournament. I commend the coaches and club committees in their dedication and encourage the continuation and improvement of their junior player programs. Thank you for supporting MSAC and all your local junior tournaments throughout Victoria.

Junior table tennis tournaments experienced an increase in participation during 2001, which is a great sign for the future. I feel the need to be continually inspired, as a junior player, is tremendously important in regard to wanting to play competitively long term. To enable growth in junior tournaments, a focus on continual improvement is required by all involved in Victorian Table Tennis.

The impressions we create at these events contribute to keeping player loyalty, and every effort must be made to ensure we are doing the best by our players, the parents and the clubs.

I look forward to the coming year and hope to record an even better result in 2002.

### COACHING REPORT (Phil Davis)

#### Junior State Squad

2001 saw the expansion of the Junior State Squad training program beyond MSAC to include satellite groups at Ballarat, Croydon and Dandenong. Approximately 60 juniors from around the state were regular participants in the program. Squad membership remains a prerequisite for selection in our state teams. The challenge for the program remains the balance between accessibility and program quality. While various Associations aspire to be included, only those with an accredited top level coach and a high quality program will remain part of the program.

The fruits of the labours of my predecessors began to ripen this year as the nationals results of our younger juniors, that have been part of the program for over three years now, were very good. Our Under 14 Boys team took Gold at the Australian Junior Championships, while our Under 14 Girls got Silver and Under 14 Boys B team got Bronze. Six U14 boys and three U14 girls were ultimately ranked in the top 10 in Australia. The results were reasonable at the higher age levels where we showed a

greater depth but lacked standout players. It will take at least another four years of hard work before the

The challenge of greater female involvement remains for us and for each and every club across Victoria. Senior State Squad

A Senior State Squad program remains under development but is expected to begin early in 2002.

### Sunraysia Challenge

A weekend in Mildura, initially named the Sunraysia Challenge, was run as a reward for some of our younger hard working juniors that didn't make state teams. Four young boys joined four similar players from South Australia and a large group of locals in Mildura on the weekend before the Melbourne Cup. The individual matches, coaching session and integrated team matches provided the basis for enthusiastic participation and the involvement of local juniors who otherwise find it difficult to participate in most of our junior activities, which are usually held a long way from their homes. The weekend was very successful and has been rescheduled for 2002.

### **Coaching Courses**

Three Level 1 Coaching Courses were conducted during the year. The fees for these courses were reduced to cover TTV out-of-pocket expenses only, which ensured a good participation rate at the courses. Unfortunately only five of the 24 participants went on to complete the full course requirements and subsequently registered by the end of the year. A number of these participants are still actively working towards registration, but the overall finalisation rate was disappointing.

### Volunteer Support

I'd like to acknowledge the support of a number of key volunteers who played key roles in supporting the activities under the Coaching portfolio throughout 2001. It is oft repeated how much we rely on volunteers; their contributions remain invaluable. Phyllis Scales (Mornington), Jim and Claire Montgomery (Geelong), Vicki and Phil Carruthers (Geelong), Bruce Carter (Oak Park), Theo Rosmulder (Yarrawonga), Frank Woodward (Ballarat), Joe Hiku (Croydon), Bob Scarborough (Warrnambool), Daryl Wilkinson (Werribee), KM Chuk and many others - thanks for the help!

# VICHEALTH PROGRAM REPORT (Alois Rosario)

The funding for the VicHealth program has undergone several changes during the year.

Thank you to the Arthritis Foundation of Victoria for their support over many years with the program. Table Tennis Victoria now has new Health agency support from the Heart Foundation through the Healthy Food Choices program and Quit with Smokefree. These agencies will now assist us with the implementation of workplans over the funding period of two years.

During the first 6 months of the year we conducted the VicHealth Challenge, the Active For Life Junior tournament, sponsored regional pennant competitions, State League, Veteran, Senior and Junior tournaments, the Girls of All Ages tournament and the Victorian School Singles Championships and

The popular Rules poster was update for the changes in the rules and a revamped Stretch poster was also

Many thanks to the agencies involved and especially to Julie Crothers from Arthritis Victoria for her support with the program.

The thrust of the program for the new funding period commencing 1st July 2001 is to change environments such as the canteens and clubrooms where table tennis is played therefore leading to healthier players. The program involved the setting up of workplans in each of the areas of Participation, Health Food Choices and Smokefree. This will be a new challenge for all associations.

#### VETERANS REPORT (Val Crumbie)

2001 saw 3 changes in the Chairmanship of the Melbourne Veterans Table Tennis Club. Joan Guggenheim held that position for some 16 years and stood down in March after giving many years of loyal and dedicated service. Alan Hopkins then became the new Chairman and unfortunately due to ill health, he had to resign after only 2 months tenure. Joan then assumed the role again until September. I took over that role as your Chairman in that month just prior to the Australian Veterans Championships, which were held in Perth.

At these Championships there was some outstanding performances by our Victorian Members and I congratulate you all on your efforts. Well Done.

During 2001, Pennants and Tournaments, including the Victorian Closed and Open, were conducted at MSAC and Regionally.

We want to thank our Regional Associations for their efforts throughout the year in helping to provide Veteran Members excellent competition and facilities.

Planning began for the World Masters Games (7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> October, 2002) and the Australian Veterans Table Tennis Championships (13<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup> October, 2002). Both events will be conducted at MSAC and will be very exciting in which to participate and I encourage you all to do so. Senior Citizens Day, which is held annually, was well attended by the Public. We want to thank our Volunteers for giving us their valuable time on this day in helping to promote our Sport.

I would like to personally thank all those members who have given me tremendous support in my new role and I look forward to having a continuous association with you all in helping to develop and further promote Veterans Table Tennis in Victoria.

#### SENIOR PENNANT/TOURNAMENT REPORT (John Mackey)

#### Pennant

During 2001 three seasons of Wednesday Pennant & four Seasons of Tuesday Pennant were conducted. Attracting new players to the three a side format is getting harder and harder with most new players adopting to play in the two a side format on Tuesdays because of the earlier finish.

The 2001 VicHealth State League was held in conjunction with the Winter Pennant, with the Dandenong Team of Michael Belot, Robin Moore and Russell Lavale defeating the Albert Park team of Andrew Moore, David Zalcberg and Matthew Rouse. #### Tournaments

Seven tournaments were conducted in 2001 by TTV: [MSAC Open, VicHealth Easter Classic, Victorian Closed, Javor Cup, Centra Victorian Open, AKT City of Melbourne, Victorian Affiliates]. These were all reasonably well supported by all players but measures need to be undertaken to increase the number

of female participation in tournaments. Albury/Wodonga, Ballarat, Croydon, Dandenong, Geelong Mornington, Traralgon, Sunbury and Yarrawonga conducted successful tournaments.

Also in 2001 TTV conducted the Australian Youth Championships at MSAC. This was once again a very successful event.

The Grand Prix points rewarding system where players received points for entering tournaments and bonus points depending on how far they progressed in the draw in specific grades for singles & Doubles was again conducted. In 2001 the winners were Open Men's Michael Belot, Open Women's Tammy Gough, A Grade Brett Sonnet, B Grade Bill Sheehan, C Grade Hua Hu & D Grade Ruth Singer.

Many thanks to the following people for their contribution to the successful running of TTV events during the year. BOB GRATTIDGE, HELEN POTTAGE, GRAEME IRELAND, MIKE KREDINAC and not forgetting ANGELO TABONE who does an enormous amount of volunteer work. Thanks also to the many other volunteers who assisted throughout the year to help make these tournaments a success. Many thanks to the Senior Victorian Selectors, Graeme Ireland (Chairperson), Suzy Javor and Mary Le Gassick for their work doing the seedings and ranking points during the year.

I would again like to thank Ruth Singer (Secretary VTTUL) for the excellent and professional manner she went about organising referees/umpires for tournaments and the TTV pennant.

### AFFILIATED ASSOCIATIONS REPORT (Dale Gilson)

This year we welcomed Bellarine Table Tennis Association and congratulate Theresa Pape and all those who are contributing their time to getting this club up and running at Ocean Grove.

This year was the 50<sup>th</sup> Country Championships and it was celebrated with the exhibition of a huge collection of photos and memorabilia of those 50 years. 64 teams took place with Ballarat taking out the team's events in the top grade and Ballarat player Mark Smith also won the Mens Open singles event. Claire Montgomery of Geelong won the Open Womens event. Players who had participated for 10 or more years in these championships were acknowledged for their efforts and presented with certificates of recognition.

I personally played in Tournaments in Albury/Wodonga, Ballarat, Bendigo/Eaglehawk, Croydon, Geelong, Mornington, Traralgon and Yarrawonga and I thank each association for their hospitality and the professional tournament they each held. Having visited many country associations this year and spoken to others via the phone and meetings it is evident to me that our Country Associations are in good hands. #### FINANCIAL REPORT

### 1 JANUARY 2001 - 31 DECEMBER 2001

The financial report is audited.

### NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The result for the year was a loss of \$49,240 due mainly to the loss of certain Government grants, 10% less Player Registrations, reductions in sponsorship, fundraising and the increase of \$10,000 in depreciation for the Taraflex Flooring. An increase in wages also contributed to the loss significantly.

### SPECIFIC ITEMS

The increase in fees from MSAC of \$5000/over last year is due to all a fee increase to cover rental to MSAC.

\$30,000 was withdrawn from investments during the year in order to finance the shortfall in the above items. This also contributed to a reduction in interest received.

Both Sport and Recreation Victoria and Vichealth reduced government Grants in 2001.

Player Registration fees were up, but were well down on expectations due to a loss of 10% of members. Subsidising of the Social Members category also contributed to the loss.

Payroll was increased by \$11,886 even though 2000 good figures were owing to a Government Grant that was not to be repeated in 2001.

Fundraising was down due to the Auction Dinner Dance not being held.

Technology Interplet costs increased due to setting up a new email system.

TTV Tournament costs at MSAC increased by \$10,000 for 2002 with only a \$1000 increase in income.
