PRESIDENT'S REPORT (Bob Tuckett)

1999 was a year of consolidation with good performances in many areas including

- finance – a surplus of \$1552
- membership - 3497 registered members a slight increase on last year
- playing: Victoria won team events in nine (9) age divisions at National Championships including the prestigious Mens and Womens Team events.
Victorian players won nine (9) individual National Singles titles including Mens and Womens Singles (Russell Lavale and Jian Fang Lay respectively)

At the 1999 Annual General Meeting, Marc Huinink was re-elected Vice President, Joan Guggenheim and Phil Davis were re-elected to the Board of Management. During the year Fran Keyhoe resigned from the Board of Management and Helen Pottage filled the vacancy in the Affiliated Associations portfolio. I thank Fran on behalf of TTV for her dedication and commitment to table tennis through many years of service at Board level.

At a Special General Meeting of Table Tennis Australia the constitution of TTA was amended to reflect the proposals of the TTA Taskforce. Principal features of the new structure are:

- policy and planning powers (including financial) would be transferred to the TTA Board
- the State and Territories are the only voting members at TTA Annual General Meetings and all other General Meetings
- five (5) Board Members - the President, Finance Director and three (3) other directors will be elected by the voting members
- The Director Finance must be a qualified accountant and a member of or eligible to be a member of one of the main regulatory bodies for accountants known as CPA, ICA and NIAA, or such other successor or replacement bodies as may arise.
- up to four (4) Board members may be appointed by the elected Board members
- the Chief Executive Officer is no longer a Board member
- voting members review the TTA Board's performance in achieving its predetermined aims

TTV celebrated our second anniversary as a Tenant of the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre (MSAC). TTV has developed a constructive relationship with MSAC and through programs such as the "Search for a Star" are working harmoniously for the mutual benefit of table tennis and MSAC.

In relation to MSAC I am happy to report that 1.436 million visitors attended the centre in the 1998/99 financial year. Original budget expectations have been exceeded with total revenue reaching \$7,106,473 whilst operating expenses totaling \$5,921,327 were incurred. An operating deficit of \$828,515 was reported after providing for depreciation.

Many major table tennis events were staged at MSAC during 1999 including: Australian Open Championships, Australian Youth Championships, Australian and New Zealand Police Games, Public Sector Games, Corporate Games, Victorian Open Championships, Yasaka Easter Classic, Sportscover Victorian Country Championships and Javor Cup.

TTV again conducted a successful Gala Auction fundraising dinner. This event was well supported by the table tennis fraternity and net amount of \$6689 was raised which will be utilised exclusively for the Development of table tennis in Victoria.

1999 has been a dramatic year for our elite players with Olympic Qualifying tournaments being held on a National and Oceania basis. It is an indication of Victoria's pre-eminence in table tennis that so many of our players qualified through this exhaustive process. Congratulations to Shirley Zhou, Miao Miao, Stella Zhou, Jian Fang Lay, Mark Smythe, Russell Lavale and Simon Gerada. Former Victorian Brett Clarke (now a Queensland resident) also qualified.

In conclusion I wish to thank the TTV Board members, staff and Affiliated Associations and Clubs and volunteers for another year of service to table tennis.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT (Graham Lockwood)

Part funded by Sport and Recreation Victoria

I am pleased to report at the end of my third year as Executive Director of TTV that our Association is in relatively good shape as we head into the new millennium. 1999 has been a year of further consolidation for our sport in Victoria. Registered Members in 1999 were slightly up on the previous year with Princes, Colac and Camperdown dropping out of the Association and Sunbury, Melton, Bairnsdale and Portland joining. Other of our Associations have experienced good growth during this year while some others declined. This situation is a familiar pattern, with an Association or Clubs "health" very much dependent on the professionalism and dedication of its office bearers. We welcome the new affiliates to the Victorian Association and wish them every success. Bairnsdale have already distinguished themselves in their first year with success in some grades at the Country Championships and Sunbury with some of their players performing well at other TTV tournaments.

TTV's financial position remains sound with a surplus of \$1552.00 being achieved for 1999 and members funds increased by \$3516 to \$106,642. This result has been achieved despite a decline in registration income compared to the previous year and after payment of Long Service Leave entitlements.

The TTV internet site, at ttv.com.au, was established during the year. A master plan involving an extensive site has been developed by Phil Davis. To date only a home page, the Tournament Calendar, and tournament results have been published on the site. The volunteer developers, Greg Linwood and Rachel Saunders, have been working on a complex database system that would enable the site to be maintained by authorised people, with no knowledge of web site programming, from any computer connected to the internet. While this is a major project and has slowed the further development of the TTV site, when it is complete it will provide us with the means for maintaining the site utilising the broad volunteer base available to TTV. We are indebted to Greg, Rachael and Phil for their expertise and many hours of input to this project.

The unfortunate position of our national organisation is of great concern, however TTV's situation remains solid and we must ensure it continues to do so while the issue of a national body is being resolved. It is thus important during this time that all affiliates and members strongly support their State Association.

Late in 1999 it was decided prudent to change our legal adviser from Dunhill Madden Butler lawyers for TTA and MSAC because of potential conflict of interests during 2000. Accordingly Campbell and Shaw Lawyers were appointed in November 1999.

TTV's initial two year License Agreement with the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre expired on 30 June and was successfully rolled over for a further 12 months with a small increase in License Fee to TTV. The reason for only a 12 months extension was due to the need to assess the impact of the GST by MSAC and ourselves before finalising a long term agreement. In this regard, negotiations with the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre have now commenced. A satisfactory outcome for TTV is very much dependant on increasing usage of the stadium be it table tennis or other activities. During the year because usage did not warrant its use, the rear section of the stadium was let out to volleyball and badminton on Saturday to Thursday inclusive except for tournaments etc.

Improvement of the amenities of the table tennis stadium for TTV members has been an ongoing issue with MSAC and I am pleased to advise that they will install TTV honour boards in the stadium during the second quarter of this year.

Our relationship with the MSAC and other resident sports are good, with 1999 seeing further progress in co-operation with the facility and other sports. A notable example of this was the "Search For a Star" promotion initiated and promoted by MSAC. This program saw some 90 children under 12 years assessed for their table tennis star potential with four girls and four boys selected for 6 months free table hire and coaching. This program is being conducted by Tammy Gough and overviewed by Jerzy Grycan on Saturday afternoons and is due to conclude in April 2000. Graduates for this program will then be asked to train with the Victorian Development Squad.

Considerable emphasis has been placed on junior development during 1999. A Victorian Squad and a Development Squad were formed utilising the coaching services of Peng Quach, Jian Fang Lay and later in the year former national coach Jerzy Grycan, and also SDO Alois Rosario. The improved performances of the Victorian team at the National Championships last October reflects the benefits of this work. The increase in junior tournaments entries at MSAC and player standard is further support for this direction. The attempt to initiate a junior pennant competition at MSAC on Saturday afternoons during 1999 failed because of lack of support but, will be trialled again in 2000 at a different time segment.

Other initiatives apart from the foregoing during the year were the introduction of the Javor Cup and the videoing/televising (C31) of the Victorian Open.

The year was not without its drama's surrounding Olympic qualification for Victorian players but, it was good to see six Victorians emerge as Olympic selections.

1999 was a milestone year for TTV with the retirement in December of Joan Guggenheim after some 33 years part and full time service with the Association. Joan's presence, experience and skills as a member of TTV staff will be greatly missed. We wish her well in her retirement from the staff. Joan will however continue to play a leading role with the organisation of the Veterans. Following Joan's retirement Alois Rosario has been appointed Executive Officer VicHealth. He will also continue in his role as Sports Development Officer and in this capacity will be assisted by Tammy Gough as part time Administrative/Sports Development Officer. Tammy was appointed to begin this position on 17 January 2000.

My contract with the Association as Executive Director expired in January but has been extended to 30 June to allow for management continuity following the foregoing restructure and also for the new President to succeed Bob Tuckett who stands down from his role following the 2000 Annual General Meeting, to be involved in the selection of my successor.

I would like to take this opportunity of stating that it has been a privilege to work with Bob whose leadership and conscientious dedication to the affairs of the association over the last six years has been outstanding and for this all members owe him a tremendous debt and gratitude. During his two terms as President he has taken the Association from a precipitous financial position to one of progressive stability, overseen the relocation of TTV to its new home at MSAC and the development of the sport in Victoria in various directions. The Association has indeed been fortunate to have a person of his calibre at its helm over this period.

I would again like to thank the staff of TTV and its volunteers for their unfailing and conscientious dedication to their duties in the interests of the Associations, for their loyalty and also their companionship and support without which, I would not have been able to carry out my role and the Association would have been much poorer. I would like to personally say thank you to members for their friendship and support during my term as Executive Director. I have enjoyed and been stimulated by the challenge of the position however it will be soon time to hand over to a younger and fresh incumbent to carry the Association into the new millennium. I wish all affiliates and their members every success in the future.

DEVELOPMENT OFFICER'S REPORT (Alois Rosario)

Part funded by Sport & Recreation Victoria

The highlight of 1999 was the continued distribution and acceptance in Primary schools of the TOPS Table Tennis Program. This was a follow on from the SEPEP manual that had been established in 1996. There have been great reports from the schools that have implemented the program in their school. Our next step is to encourage these students into our associations and clubs.

This year saw a change in some duties involving coaching of the Junior squad which has been resurrected. This was a fresh change to the position. It is becoming evident that the position has and needs to constantly change in line with the needs of the time. Next year we are looking to employ a part time development officer / administrator who will be able to increase the profile and service the needs of the schools and affiliates. On several occasions this year we were unable to fulfil requests because of demand. Next year being an Olympic year we look forward to even higher demand.

School clinics proved once again to be popular with some 89 general school clinics conducted, and approximately 100 clinics conducted in conjunction with affiliates

During the year I visited and conducted sessions for Dandenong, Diamond Valley, Maccabi, Coburg, Werribee, Ballarat, Eaglehawk/Bendigo, Geelong, Hamilton, Horsham, Kerang, Melton, Mornington, Sunbury, Traralgon, Warracknabeal, Warrnambool and Yarrawonga.

Thank you to all the helpful people from the Associations that made the year enjoyable. A special thanks to Sport & Recreation Victoria for their continued funding and support of the Sport Development Officer position. Thanks to the Education Department School sport unit especially Doug Sandiford and Keith Grainger in the Junior Sport department.

JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT REPORT (Phil Davis)

1999 was my first full year in the Junior Portfolio. During the year seven junior tournaments were conducted by my assistants and I at MSAC. The Victorian Closed was conducted at Bendigo by the Eaglehawk/Bendigo TTA. Of the junior tournaments held at MSAC the Victorian Open had the largest field with 101 players. Unfortunately the Victorian Junior Open was not held on the same weekend as the senior event, which led to a total lack of interstate players entering the junior event. The Yasaka Easter Junior Classic had the strongest field with a significant number of interstate players. This year the Top 10 Invitational Tournament was held over two days; enabling players in the top 10 of more than one age group to participate in two of the round robin events. Approximately 35 new boys and girls participated in one or more of the tournaments throughout the year. Overall the numbers attending junior tournaments at MSAC was comparable with 1998.

A Junior Pennant was initiated at MSAC on Saturday afternoons early in the year. The program struggled to get viable numbers and was disrupted by breaks due to school holidays and the Grand Prix. Despite advertising in all manner of ways and a strong focus by the SDO, Alois Rosario, in schools in the MSAC area, the program had to be discontinued due to lack of numbers. Rex Rouse put significant effort into running this program for which we are very grateful.

MSAC set up a novice talent identification program called Search For a Star. The program was held in early October and saw some 90 novices vie for eight free training scholarships in table tennis. Similar arrangements were made with the other sporting groups at MSAC. The four girls and four boys will be trained at MSAC on Saturday afternoons over a six month period.

The junior tournament program relies heavily on volunteer support. Throughout the year many people kindly offered their assistance and I often took them up on their offers. I can't list here all those that assisted in the running of tournaments during the year, but I would like to thank those that carried the bulk of that workload. Angelo Tabone, Helen Pottage, Keith Holley, Fran Keyhoe, Chris Horwood, Peter Bishop, Karen O'Brien and Braerne Spigelman can all take a bow. In addition to these eight key volunteers I would like to acknowledge the effort and the professionalism of others that contributed significantly to the program. Graham Ireland, Ron Keyhoe, John Mackey and Ruth Singer all played their part on the refereeing/umpiring side, while the TTV staff of Alois Rosario, Joan Guggenheim, Graham Lockwood and Donna Griffiths were always available to provide guidance and assistance when asked. You can see by the list of names that I've had plenty of support throughout 1999.

Overall it was a successful year on the junior scene which should provide a strong platform for 2000 and beyond.

COACHING REPORT (Jim Montgomery)

STATE TEAMS DEVELOPMENT

The stated aim for coaching in Victoria for 1999 was to hold the line against the other states this year and have a good structure to improve our position next year. We knew this was going to be difficult as it was apparent that several states had well organised and currently running coaching programs. Due to the considerable effort and dedication of players, coaches and management, I am both happy and relieved to report that our position in the various divisions at the 1999 Australian Championships improved beyond our expectations and that of Table Tennis Australia's seedings.

In junior events our teams were successful in:

- Gold Medal: Under 14 Boys
Under 18 Boys
Under 18 Girls
- Silver Medal: Under 16 Girls
- Bronze Medal: Under 14 Girls
Under 16 Boys

In Senior events our teams were:

- Gold Medal in Women's
- Gold Medal in Men's

The basic structure was a State Squad to help develop our prospective state team players, and as it evolved, a Development Squad to help train those just outside this group because of experience, age, no alternative coaching in their region, etc.

To ensure that this program remains successful and to avoid the mistakes of our own and other sports, we need to continue to guarantee that:

- the coaching stays at the highest quality
- it remains at low cost to give maximum access
- it continues to run on weekends to facilitate country players
- players continue to be treated equally, regardless of their own perceived "eliteness"
- all players get the greatest variety of training and practice available
- we are able to financially support the program and can continue to offer some financial support to the state team members
- the participants and supporters, ie parents, Associations, Table Tennis Victoria, know that their efforts and ours can produce internationally competitive players.

The present Squad management comprises Jim Montgomery and Phyllis Scales, the State Coach is Peng Quach, Assistant Coach is Alois Rosario, Specialist Coach is Jian Fang Lay. The Development Squad is coached by Jerzy Grycan with assistance from a visiting Japanese player and local senior players.

BEGINNER DEVELOPMENT

The *Search for a Star* is a program run in conjunction with Melbourne Sports & Aquatic Centre to identify new talent then offer a scholarship for six months' coaching. Eight young boys and girls are currently being coached by Tammy Gough.

GENERAL GROUP COACHING

While it has been our publicised stance for some time, and practised by some associations, many more associations are coming to recognise the long term advantages of group coaching in their areas and have local coaches supplemented by higher level people on a less regular basis. As this trend continues, the standard in the particular Association will improve in the juniors and their retention rates will be higher. Members of the State Team now show a predominance of players from associations with organised coaching supplemented by Table Tennis Victoria's State Squad and/or Development Squad training.

DEVELOPMENT OF COACHES

Olympic Solidarity Coaching Course

Organised by Table Tennis Australia and under the auspices of the National Olympic Committee, twenty-five coaches from Australia and Oceania attended an Olympic Solidarity Coaching Course in Adelaide. Thomas Stenberg, Director of Coaching, Sweden, was Course Director.

Peng Quach, Alois Rosario and I spent the week with the immediate aim of improving the State team now and into the future. Since Sweden has to be considered the most successful structure in world table tennis, I took close note of their evaluations and directions for the future. Technical improvements are already being incorporated into the present state program and I am sure other coaches who attended from Victoria are doing likewise with their own students.

PREPARATION FOR 2000 AUSTRALIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS

Since next year's Championships are so early due to the Sydney Olympics, we have started our 2000 coaching program and hope that all players will see fit to gain eligibility in the teams; however, if players prefer to only play singles, we must respect their view rather than place them in teams and then have them withdraw with various "reasons" as has been the case in each of the last eight years.

I would also like to take this opportunity to publicly ask the many Associations involved with these dedicated youth to seek ways to assist them in their quest to represent their state as it bestows considerable prestige on their Association. This help can be in many forms from added local coaching, table hire subsidies, organising transport, direct cost subsidy to State team fees, encouragement of parents and of players by articles in local media and school newsletters etc, are just a few of the ways presently used by Associations with great success.

VICHEALTH PROGRAM REPORT (Joan Guggenheim)

Once again we wish to acknowledge our appreciation for the funding provided by the Victorian Health Promotion Foundation for the Active For Life Program in which we joined with Arthritis Victoria as our Health Sponsor.

The Program covered the entire range of players - Juniors, Seniors and Veterans - with varied sponsorships which covered both metropolitan and country areas. Regional pennant, tournaments for juniors, seniors, veterans and women, State League, Victorian Schools Singles Championships, Metropolitan Associations Challenge, TOPS, regional recruitment and coaching of juniors, seniors and veterans, visits to Retirement Villages and Associations, coaching of women and NESB's, coaching camps and school coaching at both girls and mixed group schools were all sponsored.

The Active For Life message is continually brought before the attention of all Table Tennis players and the general public by signage, brochures, posters, shirts, entry forms and bags. We now have Posters for Basic Rules and Stretching for Table Tennis.

I have been the VicHealth Co-ordinator since the inception of the Program in 1987 and have enjoyed the challenges that it has imposed, but now after more than 30 enjoyable years working for Table Tennis Victoria I have decided to resign. I would like to thank all those, too numerous to mention, who have helped make this Program the success it is and know that it is in good hands with the appointment of Alois Rosario as my successor.

VETERANS REPORT (Joan Guggenheim)

If you are over 40 you are invited to play Veterans events. With pennant played at MSAC (averaging 100 players per season), Croydon, Dandenong, Hamilton, Geelong and Ballarat there are ample opportunities for veterans to become involved.

The tournament circuit of Croydon, Mornington, Ballarat, Geelong, Dandenong, Victorian Open and Victorian Closed provides for all standard of players to enjoy competing at their own level and for getting the experience necessary to be able to play for Victoria at the Nationals. This year has seen record numbers participating in tournaments, 94 at Croydon and 92 at Victorian Closed. What we urgently need are more women participating, especially in the Over 40 events. If you would like to be on the mailing list please get in touch with the office.

Senior Citizens Day at MSAC continues to be successful. A large group of players took up the offer of free table usage and coaching. Players come from far and wide to participate and this year several of them decided to go one step more and compete regularly. This is what it is all about, getting players to play on a regular basis.

'Making the Most of Life' the International Day of the Elderly was conducted this year at the Royal Exhibition Building. Once again we united with the Over 30 Club from Princes to present our Sport. We had 2 full sized tables, 1 TOPS table, 1 small table, an electronic display which was eye-catching and a ball machine which never stopped all day. This was an excellent opportunity to showcase our sport as 8500 people went through the Exhibition that day.

As usual Victorians were well to the forefront of medal winners at the National Championships held at the Gold Coast. Igor Klaf must be the most prolific winner in National Veterans events, he has won Over 40, Over 50 and now Over 60 Singles. Victoria won Gold in 3 team events - Over 60 Men, Over 70 Men and Over 60 Women. Pam Tait won the Swaythling Award for the Over 60 Women. (see further details under Australian Championships). 2000 Nationals will be held in November at Campbelltown NSW.

Veterans table tennis is on the move, make sure you are part of the movement.

WOMENS REPORT (Graham Lockwood)

The vacancy on the Board of Management for this position was again not filled in 1999 due to no nominations for the position.

The major work in relation to increasing female participation in table tennis was undertaken by TTV in 1998/99 in schools particularly girls schools while there has been a slight increase in membership in 1999 any marked increase is not expected in the short term. A reviewed approach to this objective will be initiated in 2000.

Another initiative, was the formation of a Monday morning Social Club at MSAC which encourages women to take up the game. Some small success of this program is evident to date.

Number of women members increased slightly this year from 632 members to 650 (18.6%) out of a total membership of 3497.

It is essential that this Board of Management vacancy is filled in 2000 and that there is greater focus on female membership development particularly at Junior level. The appointment of Tammy Gough as part time Administrative Assistant/Sports Development Officer should ensure this objective is achieved.

SENIOR PENNANT/TOURNAMENT REPORT (John Mackey)

Pennant

1999 was another successful year in Table Tennis Victoria pennant although there was an unfortunate drop in numbers again. Attracting new players to the three a side format is getting harder and harder with most new players adopting to play in the two a side format on Tuesdays because of the earlier finish. A survey was conducted amongst all pennant players during the Spring Pennant seeking comments on the structure of the TTV pennant. 24 players replied out of a possible 170 plus, with most players that replied in favour of the pennant structure staying as it is. One member did suggest a European format for the pennant and that will be considered in the coming year. In 1999, three pennant seasons were conducted (Summer, Winter and Spring) which kept the players playing most of the year.

The 1999 State League was held in conjunction with the Winter Pennant, with the St.Kilda Cricket Team of Brian Berry, Paul Langley & Jeff Plumb defeating the Croydon team Mark Smythe, Stella Zhou & Chamara Fernando. The State League would not be possible without the support of all players and the continued support of the chief sponsor "VicHealth". Many thanks for your continued support.

TTV is always looking at ways to improve the pennant and if you have any ideas please forward them on to me at the office.

Tournaments

Seven tournaments were conducted in 1999 by TTV: [MSAC Open, Yasaka Easter Classic, Olympic Qualification, Chas Clothing Vic. Affiliates, Javor Cup, Centra Victorian Open, AKT City of Melbourne]. These were all well supported by all players. Albury/Wodonga, Ballarat, Croydon, Dandenong, Geelong, Mornington and Yarrowonga conducted successful tournaments. Eaglehawk/Bendigo conducted the "Active for Life" Victorian Closed on behalf of TTV for which we are very grateful on a job well done.

Also in 1999 TTV conducted the Yasaka Australian Youth Championships at MSAC. This event was successful although the non appearance of some states was disappointing.

Many thanks to the following people for their contribution to the successful running of TTV events during the year. BOB GRATTIDGE, HELEN POTTAGE, GRAEME IRELAND, MIKE KREDINAC and not forgetting ANGELO TABONE who does an enormous amount of volunteer work. Thanks also to the many other volunteers who assisted throughout the year to help make these tournaments a success.

Many thanks to the Senior Victorian Selectors, Graeme Ireland (Chairperson), Suzy Javor and Mary Le Gassick for their work doing the seedings and ranking points during the year.

I would again like to thank Ruth Singer (Secretary VTTUL) for the excellent and professional manner she went about organising referees/umpires for tournaments and pennant.

AFFILIATED ASSOCIATIONS REPORT (Helen Pottage)

Many thanks go to Fran Keyhoe for her work as Affiliated Association's representative on the TTV Board of Management for the first half of 1999. Fran organised the highly successful Country Championships in June with 64 teams entering from around country Victoria. 1999 had nearly 3,500 registered players with TTV from metropolitan and country regions from established associations and clubs to the newer and expanding members such as Melton TTA. It was great to have news coming from regional clubs to appear in Nets and Edges; Yarrowonga's playing area extension, Sunbury TTA's junior development and Ballarat TTA's history. Sharing ideas and communicating bonds all associations and players in our goal of encouraging and promoting table tennis in Victoria and Australia.

The successful organisation of tournaments by smaller, and larger associations was another major achievement in 1999 with Eaglehawk/Bendigo for instance hosting the Victorian Closed Championship. Tournaments are vital in providing experience and social interaction for players of any level and all individuals and clubs involved in running these must be thanked for their great work.

As a member of the TTV BOM I attended the Annual General Meetings of the Diamond Valley TTA and South Eastern TTA in November and December 1999. A wonderful opportunity to learn association's concerns and meet players and office bearers of both groups. All invitations to AGMs from other associations in 2000 gratefully received!

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The computerised (MYOB) accounting program installed in 1998 has allowed a direct comparison with last years results and has facilitated budget preparation and analysis with actual results which, has allowed more effective month to month financial management.

The result for the year was a gain of \$1552 which was a particularly good result considering the statutory requirement for a Long Service Leave payout for Joan Guggenheim of \$5000.

Members funds increased over last year by \$3516 to \$106,652 assisted by gain on Telstra and TAB NSW shares sold during the year and by a transfer to TTV of remaining assets of the now defunct Charlton TTA.

SPECIFIC ITEMS

Increase of dividends for the year was due to proceeds of sale of Telstra and NSW TAB shares.

Increase in Government Grants was due to a "once off" receipt of Sport and Recreation Victoria Innovations Grant of \$20000 relating to the 1999 and 2000 Victorian Open Championships and of a special grant of \$33738 for purchase of Taraflex flooring which purchase has not been effected to date awaiting arrival of material from supplier.

Coaching costs were up some \$8000 on the previous year due to the re-formed Victorian and Development Squads for juniors which activity is proving very successful.

Fundraising activities for the year resulted in a net gain of \$6689.

Wages were down some \$24,000 as no assistant development officers were employed in 1999 with cessation of Government Grant which was for the 1998 year and with the reduction to temporary part time employment of the Executive Director for the last few months of the calendar year.

Stocks of merchandise remaining at a cost value of \$1700 were considered unsaleable and have been written off together with some old ball stocks at a value of \$540.

Office equipment was increased by \$548 for the purchase of a new printer. Provision for depreciation has been increased to allow for purchase of new equipment and to accelerate depreciation on equipment becoming obsolete.

NAB Income Securities were purchased during the year at a cost of \$6969.

Government Grants unexpended to date have been taken into the Balance Sheet as Current Liabilities to offset "at call" Government Grants in Investments. After allowing for this amount net investments at call decreased by some \$6000 for the year.
