MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT (Phillip Carruthers)

Two thousand and five has been a solid year for TTV. A tremendous effort by a number of people has helped to turn around the difficult financial situation we found ourselves in over the previous two years. This effort has been led by the CEO, Dale Gilson, with assistance from the Treasurer, Alan Hopkins. We are confident that we have established a platform from which our financial stability is assured.

On the playing front our membership has increased as an overall total. Some Associations are losing numbers, while others seem revitalised and other new Associations are being established. We have enjoyed our traditional success at a national level in junior, senior and veteran competition. I would like to congratulate every player on their achievements.

I also want to take this opportunity to thank the army of volunteers who make our sport possible in Victoria. All of these people make sacrifices to provide the players with venues, facilities, competitions and community. They extend from those who have the high profile roles such as those held by board and committee members to the less visible but very important activities like staffing canteens and sweeping playing area floors. These people deserve our thanks.

Finally I would like to thank the Board of TTV for their efforts in the past year. As the community has placed greater emphasis on governance issues in the wake of the HIH and One.Tel collapses and the corporate excesses of the late 1990's, even not-for-profit organisations have felt the impact. This has resulted in the establishment of Equal Opportunity and harassment policies; corporate governance guidelines; player, parent, official and coach codes of conduct; greater financial transparency and accountability, and, to a degree, the corporatisation of what was once more of an organising committee. This has provided many challenges for the Board, and it has responded and is in a strong position to both lead and respond to our members in the future.

CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS REPORT (Dale Gilson)

The end of 2005 provided Table Tennis Victoria with some excellent results. This was due to difficult decisions being made and hard work by all those involved from staff, volunteers and Board Members. Table Tennis Victoria recorded a solid profit and achieved the highest membership levels in 6 years. To achieve this combination is a very pleasing result as no one doubts some of the difficult decisions the Board faced and implemented leading into 2005 were not popular. In particular, the decision to increase registration fees to be more in line with other sports our size, and not replacing our Sports Development Officer in the short term. I would like to thank all our Associations for supporting the need for these changes.

In 2005 we saw the development of the first Affiliates folders, the first stages of the on-line website registration and pennant system and Board Indemnity insurance to all Association committees. Development trips to Associations and schools were conducted with the aid of our many coaches on an "as required" basis. This proved successful as the many coaches involved were able to cover some significant territory and in some cases focus on a particular demographic as identified.

Table Tennis Victoria continued to work with the Department of Victorian Communities (Sport and Recreation Victoria) VicHealth and the Victorian Institute of Sport. Through the assistance of these organizations Table Tennis Victoria was able to fund and implement many of these initiatives listed above. We were particularly pleased when the Minister for Sport Justin Madden attended the launch of our Affiliates folder grant at the Bendigo & Districts Table Tennis Association. Keenagers also continues to grow in numbers and popularity.

In looking to 2006, Table Tennis Victoria remains committed to ensuring that the sport of table tennis remains financially viable and in achieving this, providing greater assistance to our Associations, in particular with increased marketing initiatives. In a year where we have the Commonwealth Games we look forward to even better outcomes for the sport of table tennis and our members.

Thank you to all those who were involved in the support of the Table Tennis Victoria Office and staff in 2005.

VETERANS PORTFOLIO REPORT (Fanny Ho)

The Veterans world has again been very active with all tournaments around the state well supported.

The annual pilgrimage to New Zealand was again a success, with Margaret Mulcahy having to gain a special customs clearance to allow her to return with a suitcase full of gold. The State teams performed well in Darwin (see results elsewhere in the report). Congratulations to all our medallists and competitors. The Friday night pennant is still well supported and enjoyed, both for the competition and the social side of the night.

2006 will be an exciting year for us all with the Melbourne 2006 Commonwealth Games and the World Veterans Championships in Bremen Germany. Many of our players are either officiating or volunteering at the games and a large contingent is heading to Germany.

May I take this opportunity to thank all those wonderful people that have volunteered during the year either on the committees, helping out at pennant and tournaments. If it was not for these people our sport would not be the enjoyment it is.

A very heartfelt thank you to you all.

MEMBERS PORTFOLIO REPORT. (Bill Sheehan)

At the 2004 AGM the Affiliate members present voted for an increase in Registration fees, based partly on the need to assist TTV to become financially secure longterm and to be more into line with other sports. Some members expressed the view that the increase should be more than that calculated by our CEO Dale Gilson, others (only a few) predicted dire consequences such as large memberships dropping off. We are pleased to note that the membership figures have actually increased in 2005 to the highest number in 6 years.

This has helped our financial position considerably, although other factors have been important. Many areas of cost-cutting in the Administrative area have assisted greatly. In past years it was the custom for the Membership portfolio holder, and in some instances the CEO, to visit each Association to discuss any problems or suggestions you may have. This is still the case and if you would like to talk face to face please let me know.

Please be assured that any urgent need for personal consultation will be attended to as soon as can be arranged between the two parties, particularly as it may be some time before all Affiliates are hooked up to our website.

Congratulations to Albury Wondonga, Kerang, South Eastern and Sunshine Table Tennis Associations who achieved their highest membership levels in the past 10 years. The popularity of Keenagers also continues to go from strength to strength.

SENIOR PORTFOLIO REPORT (Chris Horwood and Claire Montgomery)

Two thousand and five proved another very successful year for Victorian Table Tennis. At a National level, Victorian teams and individual players recorded outstanding results once again. At the 2005 Youths and Senior championships, Victorian teams claimed gold medals in both men's and women's teams events whilst claiming individual gold medals in a number of other events. In the three event series to decide invitations for the Commonwealth Games qualifying, Victorian men claimed six out of the top ten places and our women took the top two places. Our men occupy seven of the Top Ten positions in 2005 whilst we also hold the top two places in the women's rankings.

On the local scene, Table Tennis Victoria trialed a new tournament format in two events during the year. The Butterfly event in February and the City of Melbourne tournament in November were conducted in round robin format. Initial feedback indicates that competitors appreciate having an alternative format in some events, and Table Tennis Victoria will continue to explore differing structures to provide new tournament concepts.

The number of competitors in country events continues to cause concern. The Board of Table Tennis Victoria is looking at ways to encourage players to travel to country events, where well organised tournaments are conducted by dedicated volunteers. We need to support our country Associations so that they can continue to develop the sport outside Melbourne.

While entries to our events in Melbourne have held steady, late entries to tournaments continue to cause difficulties for organizers. On many occasions during the year, we have been close to canceling events due to low numbers, but have received sufficient entries well after the posted closing date to make the competition viable. We need to encourage players to ensure entries are received by the posted closing dates so that we are able to plan events properly.

2006 presents unique challenges and opportunities for table tennis in Victoria. The staging of the Commonwealth Games in Victoria creates a crowded schedule for our elite players and limits the number of events that can be staged at the Melbourne Sports & Aquatic Centre. However, the Games also provide us with an outstanding opportunity to showcase table tennis to a far wider audience than we would normally hope to reach and we should be poised to take advantage of this by opening up opportunities for large numbers to take up table tennis after the Games.

As we approach this most exciting year for table tennis, we wish all our players the best of luck for their activities during 2006.

COACHING PORTFOLIO REPORT (Jim Montgomery)

I am happy to report another successful year at National level, where to summarise; the Juniors have gained two thirds of No 1 rankings, two thirds of players ranked from 1 to 5 and two thirds of players ranked 1 to 10. At the Senior level at the recent Commonwealth Games, again slightly over two thirds were Victorians. This gives us a strong base from which to develop our international standing in conjunction with our talented players, their hard working coaches and our officials.

Present ongoing projects include:

- Working with the Sports Psychology Department of Victoria University to help coaches and players to perform at their best;
- Digitising an extensive video library of table tennis' best international players so it can be used to carry out real time analysis of movement of our own athletes for our coaches. While of importance to coaching in general, I expect it to have great significance in outer areas when specialist coaching is not available as an assistance to local coaches;
- Formulating methods by which we can disperse the information through the coaching community and gain local feedback as well as input. This is only achievable if the information is in readable form, of common language, and viewable. These criteria are usually missing in technical fields.

I hope this work can be successfully completed in 2006.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

A turn around from 2004 of \$34,082.74 was achieved, resulting in a \$15,415.42 ^{surplus} profit in 2005.

SPECIFIC ITEMS

Income: 2005 / 2004 Comparison

Category 41000 Membership Fees: Increased due to the highest membership levels since 1999 and an increase in membership fees.

Category 42000 Participation Receipts: Decreased due to National Championships being held in Victoria resulting in less Accommodation income and expenditure.

Category 44000 Supplementary Income: MSAC License Fees decreased due to only 11 payments of the usual 12 being received. This was due to 13 payments being received in 2004. M2006 income reduced in 2005 due to a one year only funding arrangement in 2004 for staffing to assist in preparing for the Commonwealth Games.

Category 47000 Hire Income: Reduction in income in 2005 is attributed to the 2004 figures including a range of income streams rather than just hire. This category has been better defined and the 2005 figure is a more accurate reflection of yearly hire income.

Expense: 2005 / 2004 Comparison

Category 61100 Payroll Expenses: Reduction in Payroll Expenses due to not replacing the Sports Development Officer in the short term. Increases in other areas such as Administration salaries due to casual staff employed to assist in this area as a result of the absence of the Sports Development Officer.

Category 61200 Personnel Expenses: Expenses reduced due to not including any team accommodation in this category in 2005 as was the case in 2004.

Category 61300 General Administration: Web Hosting increased due to the introduction of the new Website Pennant Registration system.

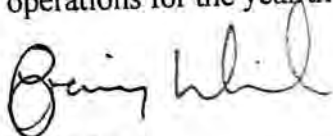
