Our membership has moved from 3892 to 3732, disappointing in the context of constant increases over the past 7 years.

We have maintained our competitive position with the other states but increasingly they are building programs to develop their young players and we must match or exceed these programs if we are to maintain our pre-eminent position in Australian table tennis.

## FROM THE CEO

The past year has been one of consolidation. While our overall membership figures have reduced, which is disappointing in the light of constant growth over the past years, there were some encouraging signs for the future. Gisborne & District Table Tennis Association joined TTV during the year and has already had members take part in coaching accreditation courses, which will encourage greater participation in their activities. Croydon & District table Tennis Association continues to be the largest association within TTV, while Albury-Wodonga and Ballarat are the two largest non-metropolitan associations, and second and third largest overall.

While the year has been more stable on the staff front, we did lose our Administration & Events Officer, Anthea Bonew, during the year. Once again, TTV has been fortunate in recruiting an outstanding replacement. Brinnen Reiss joined the TTV team on 1<sup>st</sup> September after a career with Addidas in retail. He has taken on his new and different role with enthusiasm and has proved to be a most valuable team member. The procedure manuals that had been developed by Anthea have proved very valuable and he continues to expand his role within the organisation.

Student volunteers have continued to be of great assistance to TTV. Sport & Recreation students from Victoria University maintain their commitment to TTV and assist greatly in the operation of the Victorian Schools Singles Championships. We continue to explore other links with tertiary organisations to see if they are able to offer any assistance in areas such as media and marketing as part of the courses students are undertaking.

The National Training Centre program that has been funded by TTA came to a close at the end of December 2010, as the funding stream that provided the resources was discontinued. It was disappointing to have this first class activity terminated, as it provided our elite athletes with the opportunity to train on a regular basis with others of the same standard. We will be examining strategies to replace the program, although TTV does not have the resources to maintain the program in its current format

The Regional Sports Academy programs continue to be a clear demonstration of the value of providing assistance to players in areas outside Melbourne with access to high level coaching. Players from both the South West and Gippsland programs were successful in being selected for teams in the 2010 Australian Junior Championships, which reinforces the view that the talent is there in regional areas, it just needs the opportunity to develop.

The coming year will provide some challenges for TTV. The Federal Government's response to the Crawford Report has seen TTA charged with greater responsibility for participation in the sport throughout Australia and we look forward to the opportunity to develop co-operative approaches to delivering the appropriate outcomes. The change of government at the State level may bring changes in emphasis, as each party has differing views on the best ways to achieve what are their most important outcomes in the area of sport. The new Minister, the Hon Hugh Delahunty MLA, has an extensive sporting background and has indicated a focus on higher participation levels, while acknowledging that the costs of facility access has an impact on attracting new players to sport.

## **OPERATIONS**

The TTV website continued to provide our main communication medium, with more contributors providing a wider range of news. Training on the pennant management system for affiliates new to the system was excellently provided by Greg Bristowe (Croydon), with the support of a manual developed at Sunshine & District table Tennis Association. At the end of 2010 we had 8 affiliates regularly using the on-line pennant management system, with these results feeding into the TTV Athlete rankings.

The athlete points/ranking system continued to evolve with over 1,300 registered members with active rankings. The Points Sub-Committee continued its good work; and for this we thank Michael Brown for his support throughout the year. While the model on which our system is based continues to be a topic of divided opinion within TTV, the system provided excellent objective data for selectors and athletes throughout the year.

## **SENIOR**

### **Tournaments**

Ten Open tournaments were successfully conducted during the year,. Starting in mid-February with the Open event at MSAC, events were conducted at Bendigo, Ballarat, Albury-Wodonga, Geelong and Mornington in addition to those held at the Sports & Aquatic Centre. A maximum of 30 events made up each of these tournaments, in accordance with TTA policy, including Over 30 and various grades. We continue to be aware of the way in which tournaments are conducted and look at alternative structures for events.

## **Australian Championships**

### Australian Open, 20<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup> June 2010

This championship was staged from the in Gosford, New South Wales and included the Under 21 individual events in its program. The Over 30 team event for women was not staged due to a lack of entries, and only three teams entered for the Men's team event. It is doubtful that these events will be held in future. The event was a disappointing result for Victoria, with the Men's team finishing in 4<sup>th</sup> place and the B team in 7<sup>th</sup>, The Women's team finished in third place overall and second in the interstate competition, which was a significant achievement in the circumstances, as a leading player was absent from the team due to an unexpected emergency. In individual events, the results were mixed, with gold medals in Under 21 men's singles and a number of other gold and minor medals shared with interstate players in doubles events. We are looking forward to a far better result in 2011, when we expect to have a full strength team back in action.

### Commonwealth Games Qualifying Tournament, 22<sup>nd</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> July 2010

Table Tennis Victoria successfully staged the qualifying tournament at the Melbourne Sports & Aquatic Centre for the 2010 Commonwealth Games in New Delhi. Held over three days, the organisation of the event required significant effort from a number of volunteers. Alan Hopkins and the floor laying crew from the 2006 Commonwealth Games tournament were instrumental in having the court area properly prepared for the tournament, and Alan and Graeme Ireland supervised the running of the event. Our thanks also go to Mark Taylor of Warrnambool Table Tennis Association and Keith Mundy of Central Highlands Table Tennis for the loan of Taraflex flooring for the event and for arranging for transport. A big thank you also goes out to Phil Davis for his work leading up to the event. In the end, Simon Gerada and Robert Frank qualified for the men's team and Miao Miao, Jian Fang Lay and Stephanie Sang qualified for the women's team.

### Australian Closed, 3<sup>rd</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> September 2010

This event was staged on the Gold Coast, with the tournament only having individual events. Victorian players took gold medals in the women's singles and mixed doubles, sharing the gold medal in men's doubles with minor medals in men's singles and mixed doubles.

## **TTV Pennant Competition**

Another year has passed and there have been a lot of positive developments with the TTV pennants which are conducted at MSAC.

The major development over the past year has been the appointment of Health, Wellness and Table Tennis (HWATT), as a partner with TTV, to assist with the management and conduct of the TTV pennants. This appointment has provided TTV with a significant new resource. Since their appointment on 1 January 2011, HWATT have already implemented the following initiatives;

- Designed new logos for TTV Metro League and TTV Premier League
- Designed a new marketing webpage and flyer for Metro League
- Assisted clubs with new Metro League entry forms specific for their club
- Design and construct a Pennant Board, to assist with pennant night (at HWATT's cost)

Metro League continues to grow and we are currently using all 18 tables on Wednesday nights this season – there is still opportunity to expand the competition to 27 tables, which is our objective. With the current strength of Metro League, we have implemented restrictions on team entries being received from players i.e. team entries must come from a participating club and team entries from players are no longer accepted (there are some exceptions to this rule for pre-existing non-affiliated teams).

The Metro League sub-committee continues to work well, and we are delighted to have a Croydon representative join the committee, and Croydon are working towards submitting teams into future Metro League seasons.

Premier League has been another successful year with record sponsorship, and even more elite players, many of whom travel from interstate, are taking part in the League.

### **Player Awards**

The formula that TTV has adopted for the French and Coburg awards, which includes weighted consideration of the various criteria that have been established, has led to the nomination of worthy recipients to the Board. The winners of these awards are listed elsewhere in this report.

## **JUNIOR**

Victoria had continued success in the past year, with the boys, in teams and individual events, particularly successful. It is especially pleasing to note the success of the Under 13 boys teams at the 2010 Australian Junior Championships, where the State & B teams contested the gold medal match. This is an indicator of future success. While the girl's team was not so successful, the influx of new players into this age group holds hope for the next few years.

The 2010 Australian Junior Championships were staged on the Gold Coast and conditions were more enjoyable. In Under 18, the boy's team claimed gold, while the B team came 5<sup>th</sup> with the girl's team finishing 2<sup>nd</sup>. In Under 15 both the boy's and girl's State teams claimed bronze medals with the boy's B team finishing 4<sup>th</sup>. In Under 13, the boy's teams claimed both gold & silver medals and the girl's team claimed bronze. Overall, this was a good result given the available players. In individual events, Victorian players claimed gold medals in Under 18 boy's and girl's singles, Under 15 boy's singles and Under 13 girl's singles as well as a number of minor medals in singles and doubles events.

Junior tournaments during the year attracted very good fields. Lily Phan, Anna Du and Yi-wen Li shared honours as outstanding female junior players during the year, as no one player dominated the tournaments. Heming Hu and Dillon Cathcart proved to be the strongest players among the boy's at Under 18 and Under 15 levels respectively.

The large number of players taking part in the Encouragement tournaments was very pleasing. These events are designed to introduce players to tournament play and structures and means that they are less nervous when entering an Open event. We are looking at conducting more of these events and perhaps moving to regional areas to promote the sport to a greater extent outside Melbourne.

The Regional Sports Academy programs continue to show that there are talented players in regional Victoria waiting to grasp opportunities if they are presented. The Gippsland Sports Academy continues to build on its strong beginnings, with 2 of its young girls being selected into the Under 13 bronze medal girl's team at the 2010 Australian Junior Championships. While not having the same player depth, the South West Academy continues to develop players from the region and again had representatives at the Championships. Players from both these programs continue to compete for selection in State teams and their numbers at junior tournaments in their Academy uniforms reflects extremely well on the program organisers



It is pleasing to report that students will be entering the Maribyrnong Sports Academy program in 2011. TTV has continued to work with the Maribyrnong Secondary College to bring to fruition the plans that had been laid for the involvement of table tennis in the Sports Academy program. We now look forward to having even more students involved so that the Academy can be provided with the resources to employ a coach for the players taking part.

## **MEMBERSHIP AND DEVELOPMENT**

The past 12 months have shown a reduction in membership which was a disappointing result after 7 years of constant growth. There were bright spots however, with Croydon and District Table Tennis Association increasing membership and Gisborne & District Table Tennis Association joining TTV during the year. Having a new club established in this growth area should lead to a greater number of participants taking up the sport in the district, and early indications are promising.

Manningham City Council has moved to improve the access of table tennis in the Donvale Indoor Sports Centre in Springvale Road and TTV is working closely with the Council and the nearest association (Eastern Suburbs & Churches) to maximise the benefits to TTV. We also hope to establish links with the social table tennis activities that already exist at the Centre.

Our club information kit has been useful in connecting with new organisations. Although Gisborne is the only new organisation to formally affiliate with TTV during the past 12 months, the kit has provided guidance to others contemplating the formation of new clubs.

Facility access and the costs involved continue to be issues of concern. We continue to work with our affiliated clubs and associations to assist them in their relationships with local government authorities and to represent them in negotiations to improve certainty of access to facilities at a reasonable cost.

The challenge ahead is to improve the attractions of table tennis as a sport and to examine alternative models of participation that will enable TTV to maintain contact with players such as those involved in activities such as inter-school competitions and recreational and social groups such as University of the Third Age and Keenagers. Membership in our sport is predominantly based around competition and we need to be open to alternatives that enable the sport to reach deeper into the community.
