The 2000 Annual General Meeting of Table Tennis Victoria was conducted at the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre (MSAC) on Sunday 26 March 2000 at 11am. The major items of business discussed related to:

- The TTA operating loss of \$65000 for 1999, TTA creditors of \$103,000 proposed TTA national registration fee for 2000 of \$24/member special once off levy of \$20/member; requisition by six States for a Special General Meeting of TTA; motion of no confidence by seven States in Board of TTA; unanimous support of meeting of action proposed by States for the election of an interim Board.

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT (Greg Linwood)

Welcome to Table Tennis Victoria's 2000 Annual Report.

Table Tennis is truly alive and well in Victoria. We have experienced a positive year, enjoying success at the Sydney Olympic Games, an increase in junior player registrations, solid performances at National Championships, inducted the first members into our Hall of Fame and returned a positive financial result.

The Sydney Olympic games were an exciting showcase for Table Tennis and eight out of the nine 2000 Australian Olympic Table Tennis Team were Victorians. These were: Brett Clark, Simon Gerada, Russell Lavale, Jian Fang Lay, Miao Miao, Mark Smythe, Shirley Zhou, Stella Zhou. Shirley Zhou and Miao Miao produced arguably the best international performance by any Australian Table Tennis players by finishing 5th in the Women's Doubles event, losing only to the eventual runners-up in the Quarter finals. Mark Smythe also had a memorable victory over his much higher ranked opponent, ChuYan Leung from Hong Kong. A number of international Olympic Table Tennis teams were kindly hosted by Victorian Associations during their lead-up preparations for the Sydney Olympics. Ballarat & Districts hosted the Australian, French, Croatian and Polish teams and Sunraysia hosted the German and Swedish teams.

Victorian Table Tennis players also performed well at the Australian Championships in Adelaide. Russell Lavale and Miao Miao winning the Mens and Womens Open Singles Championships respectively and Simon Gerada teamed with Mark Smythe to take the Mens Doubles Championship and with Miao Miao to take the Mixed Doubles Championship. Victorian players also filled the top three positions in both the Senior Men's and Senior Women's rankings.

This year has seen two key retirements from within Table Tennis Victoria's organisation. Bob Tuckett retired from the position of President after six years of service and Graham Lockwood retired from the position of Executive Director after four years of service. Both Bob and Graham contributed considerable effort in advancing Table Tennis Victoria in their tenures and their efforts are sincerely appreciated by the Association.

Graham's replacement was confirmed at the conclusion of this year and Dale Gilson will take office as the New Executive Director, commencing 15th January 2001. Dale will bring 20 years of experience from within the Victorian Table Tennis community to the organisation as well as Technology organisation business experience. I congratulate Dale on his appointment and wish him well in his endeavours as Executive Director.

Our Gala Auction dinner was another resounding success this year where a large attendance thoroughly enjoyed an evening which was well organised by Graham Lockwood and Mr Paul Bronstein. The highlight of this evening was the induction of Jim Thoms, Walter Lowen, Norma Buckland, Suzy Javor, Charlie Wuvanich and Steve Knapp as inaugural members of Table Tennis Victoria's Hall of Fame. Each was introduced by Mr Bob Tuckett and a member of the current Olympic Team and was presented with a plaque commemorating their achievements in Table Tennis. A framed photograph of each of these champions now hangs at the entry to Table Tennis Victoria's offices at the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre.

It is with regret that we learned of the passing of Mr Zhou Lan Sun in Beijing on October 23rd. Lan Sun was Victorian and National Coach from 1988 to 1997 and also had a distinguished career as Player and Coach in the Chinese National Team from 1957 to 1986. Lan Sun's daughter Shirley represented Australia at the Sydney Olympics in September and is also survived by his wife Ivy and son Neil (in China).

After many years service, Life Member and Chairperson of the TTV Veterans Committee - Joan Guggenheim has announced her retirement from Table Tennis Victoria's Board of Management at the end of this year. I would like to congratulate Joan on many years of outstanding service to Table Tennis and the Veterans Table Tennis movement especially. Joan's experience and continued enthusiasm on our Board will be missed.

To those who retire this year we wish a happy and healthy retirement and I look forward to working with all those who continue with us into 2001.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT (Graham Lockwood)

Part funded by Sport and Recreation Victoria

In writing this report I am conscious that I will not be at the Annual General Meeting of TTV on 1 April as I am finally to retire on 26 January. My contract has been further extended to this date following the difficulties that occurred with our national organisation culminating in the resignation of its Board of Management and CEO during May of last year. As far as TTV is concerned these difficulties are now largely behind us and during the last six months we have been able to get on with the affairs of table tennis in Victoria. Hopefully in future our sport will be better off nationally to provide the leadership so necessary if table tennis is to become more prominent in this country.

Again I am pleased to report that the Association remains in a financially viable position at the end of the year even though the membership level and therefore income was below expectations for the year. TTV finished with a surplus of \$39000 for the year with Members Funds at \$160,806.

Official membership of the Association has oscillated between 3350 and 3550 approximately over the last four years and remains a concern finishing at 3497 for the year. Of that number juniors were 968 and as such at a higher level than for some years which is a healthy sign as this age group represents the future of our sport and where our development effort must be targeted. In this regard, TTV will be focusing on strategies to increase this membership group further during 2001 with further emphasis on tournament entry and also on establishing a viable competition for juniors in the City of Port Phillip and adjacent cities. The confirmation by MSAC and the sports of the continuance of the Search For a Star program and an ancillary "all star" program for 2001 will assist in further promotion of the sport to juniors.

During the year it was pleasing to welcome new affiliated associations Bairnsdale and Orbost and we wish them every success with the development of table tennis in their areas.

TTV's License Agreement with the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre was renewed for a further three years from 1 July on acceptable terms however, table tennis usage in the stadium is not meeting target levels necessitating the hire out of the rear section to other sports and events on an increasing basis. To endeavour to boost this usage several initiatives have been tried without success however, it is anticipated that the latest initiative of the introduction of a "Racquet" Membership at MSAC should produce better results and lift stadium usage rates.

Increasingly our sport along with others is being forced to fund its own administration and programs with little if any increase in grants from government. This last year we raised some \$8000 in funds and obtained sponsorship of around \$11000 in addition to Sport and Recreation Grants and will need to achieve a similar result or better in 2001 to balance the budget.

Registration fees were only increased in 2000 by 5% to cover the July-December period for GST and had to be increased for 2001 by a further 5% for the balance of GST also another 5% to cover inflation over the last two years. It should be noted that despite these increases junior fees will still only be around the same level as in 1997.

Every effort is being made to communicate with Affiliates on the various matters associated with our sport – monthly mailings, Nets N Edges and "Short Serve". In addition, this year TTV's website has been significantly upgraded to keep members as informed as possible. This site will be developed further in 2001 and will hopefully provide an avenue to generate advertising revenue as well as a medium to communicate to members and to promote table tennis.

The debtor level that exists at TTV is of concern with the many small debts consisting of fees and fines. The members currently concerned have now been formally advised that failure to meet their commitments will make them ineligible for all TTV pennants and tournaments.

During this year the Associations auction dinner dance was attended by around 200 members. This activity has grown in stature each year and has now become a permanent feature of TTV's Calendar of Events. 2000 was a special event involving a parade of Australia's Olympians of which, all but one were Victorian's and the inauguration of TTV's Hall of Fame. Six past Victorian and Australian Champions were inducted at the function which was also witnessed by many past Victorian and Australian Champions. Congratulations to Suzy Javor, Charlie Wuvanich, Stephen Knapp, Norma Buckland, Jim Thoms and Walter Lowen on their induction. The Auction Dinner Dance is foremost a function to bring the family of Table Tennis in Victoria together with the raising of funds for sport development as a secondary but nevertheless important aim.

contract as Executive Director was extended to 30 June of this year to assist the transition of the role of President from Bob Tuckett to Greg Linwood and then to 31 December following the difficulties experienced with our national association. I am pleased that Mr Dale Gilson has been appointed to replace me and I wish him every success in the role.

I would again express my thanks to the many volunteers who have assisted in the affairs of the Association both at Club and State level and without which, as a sport we would not exist. It has been a pleasure to be associated with them and the many other members of the Association that I have met over my term. I wish them all health, happiness and every success both on and off the table.

I also gratefully acknowledge the support of the Associations various sponsors many of who have been with us for many years and without whom we would not be able to run such a comprehensive calendar of events.

As I stated on several occasions I have been fortunate to work with a dedicated Board led for most of my term as Executive Director by Bob Tuckett to whom I believe our Association owes a great debt of gratitude and latterly by Greg Linwood who brings to the role a fresh vision to carry our Association forward into the new millenium. I have also been fortunate to work with an excellent staff – Donna Griffiths, Alois Rosario, Joan Guggenheim and latterly this year, Tammy Gough all of whom have taken a positive and conscientious approach to their respective roles. It has been a pleasant and productive work environment in which to work and I take this opportunity of wishing the Board and staff of Table Tennis Victoria every success in the future.

DEVELOPMENT OFFICER'S REPORT (Alois Rosario)

Part funded by Sport & Recreation Victoria

The year saw a change of staffing and coverage of Associations. With the employment of Tammy Gough as a part time development and administration officer we saw a greater ability to service the affiliates and schools during the year. Often during the year we had multiple clinics conducted on the same day.

The highlight of the year was seeing the implementation of the TOPS program in schools and the enthusiasm of teachers and students to the program. Along with the implementation in the schools there has been several requests to conduct teacher in-service sessions on the program.

Being an Olympic year there was great interest in table tennis in the schools. School clinics proved once again to be popular with some 89 general school clinics conducted, and approximately 100 clinics conducted in conjunction with affiliates

During the year I visited and conducted sessions for Dandenong, Diamond Valley, Maccabi, Coburg, Werribee, Ballarat, Eaglehawk/Bendigo, Geelong, Hamilton, Horsham, Kerang, Melton, Mornington, Sunbury, Traralgon, Warracknabeal, Warrnambool and Yarrawonga.

Thank you to all the helpful people from the Associations that made the year enjoyable. A special thanks to Sport & Recreation Victoria for their continued funding and support of the Sport Development Officer position. Thanks to the Education Department School sport unit especially Doug Sandiford and Keith Grainger in the Junior Sport department.

JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT REPORT (Phil Davis)

2000 was my second full year in the Junior Portfolio. During the year seven junior tournaments were conducted by my assistants and myself at MSAC. Of the junior tournaments held at MSAC the Butterfly Easter Junior Classic had the largest field with 100 players. Unfortunately the Victorian Junior Open was held immediately prior to the national junior championships and subsequently failed to attract a large field. The Easter tournament had the strongest field with a significant number of interstate players. The program of junior tournaments was largely squashed into the first half of the year due to the Australian Junior Championships being held mid-year as a follow-on from the Olympics being held in Sydney in September. Tournaments around the state after the nationals were predictably slightly down on entries, although the Encouragement Tournament at MSAC at the end of the year was very well attended, particularly by new or non-regular tournament players. Overall the numbers attending junior tournaments at MSAC was slightly down compared to 1999.

The Search For a Star program in 1999 identified four boys and four girls, new to table tennis, that went on to be coached until April 2000. Two of the girls and two of the boys are now members of the Vic Squad and a third boy continues to be a regular player at Sunshine. We made an investment in this program by way of coaching support, but it must be considered a success, particularly considering the outcomes with the girls. A selection

day was again held in late 2000 and we will see four new girls and four new boys training at MSAC on Saturday afternoons over a six month period.

The junior tournament program at MSAC relies heavily on volunteer support. Throughout the year many people kindly offered their assistance and I often took them up on their offers. Angelo Tabone, Helen Pottage and Chris Horwood carried the bulk of the workload while Bruce Carter, Zoltan Gyuricza, Phyllis Scales, Karen Donnelly, Peter Bishop and Braeme Spigelman contributed significantly, with assistance from many others. In addition to these key volunteers I would like to acknowledge the effort and the professionalism of others that contributed significantly to the junior program in 2000, namely the referees; organised by Ruth Singer, the junior selectors; Jim Montgomery, Phyllis Scales and Peng Huy Quach, and all the TTV staff.

The success of the junior program at state level is made stronger by, and indeed built on, successful junior programs at our various affiliated clubs and associations. Compliments must go to those clubs/associations that ran successful junior programs in 2000; your contributions are the foundations on which we can build our future and I employ you to continue your great work and to be ever vigilant to do it even better. Congratulations to the teams of volunteers that ran the various open junior tournaments around the state. I managed to get to all but one of these and continued to be impressed by the dedication and effort displayed by all concerned throughout the year.

Overall it was a successful year on the junior scene which should provide a strong platform for years to come.

COACHING REPORT (Jim Montgomery)

Over the past two years we have run a State Squad and an ancilliary coaching group for players throughout Victoria, with several aims:

- Improve the technical standard of a wide group of players
- Create a team spirit amongst groups of players normally competing against each other
- Give education and training on the physical requirements for table tennis
- Have high quality coaching available and accessible to players from across regional Victoria and smaller associations
- Develop a working relationship between players, parents, coaches, selectors and management to enable better supported, quality teams to represent the State.

These aims are still paramount, and to this end the Committee of Table Tennis Victoria has developed a set of criteria for the relationship between the State Squad training and State Team selections.

We support the training program, while we recognise that it is not a selection criteria during the period between the 2000 Australian Championships and February 2001.

Up until the nationals in September, the players selected are expected to train at Saturday Squad and compete in the regular tournaments. While due consideration will always be given to such matters as health or schooling, the selectors with Board approval, retain the right to change the team if a player fails to comply to his or her obligation to train or compete after initial selection.

Whilst it is easy to say you are achieving most of your aims, it is difficult to prove. Two points however do indicate some success. The first was the achievement of one year's bottom five Under 14 Girl players in winning the Under 16 gold, and also comprising two members of the U18 team.

The second is the response of the parents in bringing larger numbers each year to weekend coaching.

We look forward to further developments in our coaching program and would like to thank the parents for their support.

HEALTH PROGRAM REPORT (Alois Rosario)

I would like to acknowledge our appreciation for the funding provided by the Victorian Health Promotion Foundation for the Active For Life Program in which we joined with Arthritis Victoria as our Health Sponsor. Through the support of Julie Crothers of Arthritis we were able to spread the message of Active For Life.

The Program covered the entire range of players - Juniors, Seniors and Veterans - with varied sponsorships which covered both metropolitan and country areas. We assisted with several aspects including regional pennant, juniors, seniors, veterans and women tournaments, State League, Victorian Schools Singles Championships, Metropolitan Associations Challenge, TOPS, regional recruitment and coaching of juniors, seniors and veterans, visits to Retirement Villages and Associations, coaching of women and NESB's, coaching camps and school coaching at both girls and mixed group schools.

The Program funding has been extended to June 30th due to the changes being made to Vichealth funding guidelines. An extension will be applied for in the New Year. The Active For Life message is continually brought to the attention of all Table Tennis players and the general public by signage, brochures, posters, shirts, entry forms and bags. Posters on the Basic Rules of Table Tennis proved popular especially with schools.

AS this was my first year in the position I would like to thank Joan Guggenheim for her tireless work in setting up and improving the program since 1987. Thanks also to the many people around the state who have made the position easier and rewarding.

VETERANS REPORT (Joan Guggenheim)

Life begins at 40 as the old saying goes. If you are 40 it is time you participated in veteran events. There is pennant played at MSAC, Croydon, Ballarat, Dandenong and Hamilton and at other associations, and the tournament circuit covering both metropolitan and country venues - Traralgon, Dandenong, Mornington, Geelong, Ballarat, Croydon, Victorian Open and Victorian Closed both played at MSAC. These tournaments provide the opportunity to compete against your own age group and give you necessary experience to play at the Nationals. If you wish to have entries posted to you be in contact with the office to go on the mailing list.

Senior Citizens Day at MSAC is a chance for players to be introduced to our game and have some coaching. This year was no exception. A large group took up the option and enjoyed it so much that several decided they would play on a regular basis. This is one way of recruiting players.

The International Day of the Elderly was once again held in the Exhibition Buildings, and as has happened for a few years we joined with the Over 30 Club from Princes. Two tables, an electronic display which was eye-catching, and Brian and Carol Perry once again providing the ball machine made the day a resounding success. With 8000 people going through the exhibition that day our coaches and players were not given a minute's break.

The Olympics and Paralympics provided the opportunity for a large number of Veterans to participate both as volunteers and as umpires. Everyone who attended has said that it was a unique experience, one they would never forget.

It was mentioned last year that Igor Klaf had now won Over 40, 50, and 60 Singles National titles, we now have a second person who has achieved this record - Pam Tait by winning the Over 60 Singles she added it to her previous wins in the Over 40 and Over 50. Congratulations Pam on an excellent Championship 3 Gold, 1 Silver and the Swaythling Award, and to Igor with 4 Gold, 2 Silver and the Swaythling Award as well.

Our teams did better than last year winning Gold in Over 50, 60 and 70 men and Over 60 women, and Silver in Over 40 men and Over 70 women (see further details under Australian Championships results).

After being with the Veterans Committee since its inception in 1985 I have decided to step down as Chairman and will not be standing for re-election to the Board in 2001. The Veterans Committee have worked hard throughout these years and given me their total support on all levels, especially Lois McConnell, Bill McMahon, Pam Tait, Neil Roberts and our selectors Roy Cintolo, Arnold Puts and Pam Tait who have done a first class job over a long period. I hope that my successor enjoys the work as much as I have done.

If you turn 40 any time during the year 2001 you are eligible to play in veterans, we need you.

SENIOR PENNANT/TOURNAMENT REPORT (John Mackey)

Pennant

2000 saw another decline in numbers in the Table Tennis Victoria pennant. Three seasons of Wednesday Pennant & four Seasons of Tuesday Pennant were conducted throughout the year. Attracting new players to the three a side format is getting harder and harder with most new players adopting to play in the two a side format on Tuesdays because of the earlier finish.

The 2000 Active for Life State League was held in conjunction with the Winter Pennant, with the St.Kilda Cricket Team of Paul Langley, Andrew Gilbert & Jeff Plumb defeating the Albert Park team of Shaun Priddle, Simon Gerada, Matthew Rouse & Andrew Wilson. The State League would not be possible without the support of all players and the continued support of the chief sponsor "VicHealth". Many thanks for your continued support.

TTV is always looking at ways to improve pennant & if you have any ideas please forward them onto me at TTV.

Tournaments

Six tournaments were conducted in 2000 by TTV: [MSAC Open, Butterfly Easter Classic, Javor Cup, Centra Victorian Open, AKT City of Melbourne]. These were all reasonably well supported by all players but measures need to be undertaken to increase the number of female participation in tournaments. Albury/Wodonga, Ballarat, Croydon, Dandenong, Geelong, Mornington and Yarrowonga conducted successful tournaments.

Also in 2000 TTV conducted the Butterfly Australian Youth Championships at MSAC. Whilst entries in 2000 were slightly up on 1999 it was again disappointing of the non appearance of some states.

In Tournaments in 2000 we introduced a grand prix points rewarding system where players received points for entering tournaments and bonus points depending on how far they progressed in the draw in specific grades for singles & Doubles. In 2000 the winners were Open Men's Michael Belot, Open Women's Tammy Gough, A Grade Phillip Websdale, B Grade Bill Sheehan, C Grade Ruth Singer & D Grade Ruth Singer.

Many thanks to the following people for their contribution to the successful running of TTV events during the year. BOB GRATIDGE, HELEN POTTAGE, GRAEME IRELAND, MIKE KREDINAC and not forgetting ANGELO TABONE who does an enormous amount of volunteer work. Thanks also to the many other volunteers who assisted throughout the year to help make these tournaments a success. Many thanks to the Senior Victorian Selectors, Graeme Ireland (Chairperson), Suzy Javor and Mary Le Gassick for their work doing the seedings and ranking points during the year.

I would again like to thank Ruth Singer (Secretary VTTUL) for the excellent and professional manner she went about organising referees/umpires for tournaments and the TTV pennant.

AFFILIATED ASSOCIATIONS REPORT (Helen Pottage)

It is tremendous to see the development of new table tennis clubs such as Mahogany and Monash TTC and the resurgence of associations such as, Orbost TTA, that have regained player numbers after closing in 1995. The support TTV can provide both to Mahogany and Monash TTC and Orbost TTA in coaching, insurance cover and tournament access to registered players can only support the expansion of table tennis as a respected sport in each of their geographic areas.

Tournaments at all levels were again hosted by country and city associations starting with the combined Junior, Senior and Veteran tournament organised by Dandenong TTA in March 2000. This was followed by Croydon, Geelong, Ballarat, Albury, Traralgon and Mornington all organising valuable competitions in the first half of 2000. In August the Kerri Tepper Tournament was held for handicapped players by the Horsham TTA with 33 players from around the district entering.. Many thanks go to the large number of volunteers from all associations and clubs who provide countless hours of their time to make these wonderful events possible.

On the Queens Birthday weekend the 49th Country Championships were held at MSAC with 74 teams entering, an increase in numbers from 1999. This championship is always an important three days in country associations' calendars providing players with great competition and a chance to catch up with friends and rivals from around Victoria. 2000 was no exception and thanks go to Fran Keyhoe for her work in organising this annual event and the many players, volunteers, umpires and referees who contributed.

During the year Affiliated Associations are encouraged to participate in the Country Affiliates meeting held during Country Championships & the Affiliated Associations/Clubs meeting held in November. This is a chance for Associations/Clubs to voice their concerns, suggestions and criticisms to the TTV & share ideas with equally committed table tennis officials from around Victoria. It is a great time to network with others & I can only encourage more Associations/Clubs office bearers or their representatives to attend these meetings in 2001.

Table tennis is a great sport and, with the input and commitment of all associations and clubs in Victoria, working hand in hand with TTV it will firmly establish itself as a popular and respected sport!

FINANCIAL REPORT

1 JANUARY 2000 - 31 DECEMBER 2000

The financial report is audited.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The result for the year was surplus of \$38,999.71 due mainly to receipt of certain Government grants which have been fully expended and where appropriate taken into the Balance Sheet as Non Current Assets.

Members equity increased over last year by some \$54,163 being mainly due to the purchase of Taraflex flooring \$33,738, purchase of two new computers \$5,680, purchase of a coaching copyright \$5000.

SPECIFIC ITEMS

National Securities were sold during the year for \$6597 to fund the purchase of the two new Windows 2000 computers.

A once off grant of \$33,738 was received through the year from SRV for purchase of Taraflex flooring for pre-Olympic Training, Grand Prix and National Events. A further grant of \$10,000 was received from SRV for pre-Olympic training expenses for visiting international teams. This training took place at Ballarat and Sunraysia Table Tennis Stadiums.

Fundraising activities mainly associated with the Gala Auction Dinner for the year resulted in a net gain of \$8125.

Office equipment was increased by \$5680 being for the two new computers.

Income from registrations and levies was down by \$3750 on last year.

Sponsorship obtained for the year was in line with that received last year.

The increase in fees from MSAC of \$5873 over last year is due to a fee increase to cover rental to MSAC.
