PRESIDENT'S REPORT (Bob Tuckett)

1995 was a year of progress in some areas and consolidation in others.

I am pleased to report continued improvement in the financial situation of the VTТА. A surplus of \$40,286 was achieved for the year ending 31 December 1995. Two extraordinary events contributed significantly to this surplus:

- the outstanding success of the 12th Australian Veterans Championships at Albert Park
- the realisation of a dividend from a long term investment.

These events are "once only" occurrences and as such will not contribute to our financial viability on an ongoing basis. Therefore it is apparent there is no basis for complacency and that financial prudence is still a prime concern of the VTТА Board of Management.

The VTТА is committed to continued financial growth to ensure the ongoing viability of Table Tennis in Victoria.

1995 saw the implementation of the Strategic Plan. The implementation of the Strategic Plan is ongoing and is itself a dynamic document which is constantly changing to meet new circumstances.

The essence of the Strategic Plan and the VTTA's vision for Table Tennis in Victoria is:

- professionalism at all levels of Table Tennis
- increased membership
- improvement in the profile of Table Tennis

There have been positive gains in the areas of professionalism and membership. The VTTA has made considerable progress in increasing professionalism in many areas. Our membership figures show an increase for 1995 which is a reflection of the diligence and enthusiasm of our Affiliated Associations and Clubs.

However in the area of "profile" only a minimal amount has been achieved at state level. This is a combination of various reasons:

- Australia languishing in World Rankings, ie not considered newsworthy by the media
- lack of resources (financial and personnel) to effectively promote the sport
- poor facilities at Albert Park not conducive to conducting major events
- lack of necessary flair and expertise to promote Table Tennis

In the years leading up to 2000, events such as the Sydney Olympic Games and the new Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre must be maximised in terms of profile generation. The VTTA Board of Management is committed to this task.

At the grassroots level many Associations and Clubs are generating good publicity and increasing the profile of Table Tennis in their own areas. They are to be commended on these initiatives.

The Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre is an issue of concern for all involved in Table Tennis. All the technical and functional aspects of the new stadium have been discussed and negotiated. I have endeavoured to keep members fully informed of ongoing developments through Nets N Edges. There will be 27 national sized courts (12.2m x 6.1m) in the new facility. It is anticipated that the new facility will be completed in mid 1997.

In the August issue of Nets N Edges I foreshadowed more substantive meetings would be held with the Trust. At the time of writing (some six months later) these meetings have not taken place. Mr Simon Weatherill has been appointed as Chief Executive Officer of the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre. The VTTA has formed a co-operative with badminton, basketball, squash and swimming in submitting a tender bid for the pro-shop in the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre. The members will be kept informed of developments in relation to this tender bid.

Table Tennis Australia has returned to the levy system for gathering funds from the States and Territories. The VTTA Board of Management decided to continue with the four tier individual player registration system. This decision was endorsed at the Affiliated Associations and Clubs meeting in November. The VTTA Board of Management is concerned that the levy system allows for states to fudge their player numbers in order to reduce the amount of levy payable. The VTTA has advised TTA that the VTTA will not be prepared to pay "significantly" more than the 48% paid currently. The other states and territories have a moral obligation to Table Tennis Australia to accurately present their membership figures and pay the appropriate levy amount. The VTTA will monitor the figures closely.

The Croydon and Districts Association successfully conducted the Australian Junior Championships and the Australian Senior and Youth Championships. The latter was an International event with teams from Japan, Malaysia, Russia and Slovakia. A high standard championship ensued - our players need more international exposure to reach their full potential.

The 12th "Move It or Lose It" Australian Veterans Championships were a magnificent success - not just from a financial viewpoint. Record entries, extremely efficient organisation and convivial atmosphere ensured the Championships were the best Australian Veterans Championships ever.

During 1995 Victorian players won National titles in junior, senior and veteran divisions. Congratulations to all our state team representatives on their success. Croydon Conquerors captured the National Table Tennis League title in an excellent advertisement for modern Table Tennis. Overall, Victorian players performed creditably at International Championships winning medals at the Commonwealth Championships and Finland Open Championships. Congratulations to those players - Jian Fang Lay, Kerri Pepper, Vivian Yang and Shirley Zhou.

1995 has been a year of modest progress and I wish to thank the VTTA Board of Management, Executive Director - Kerri Pepper, VTTA Office Staff, Affiliated Associations and Clubs, Volunteers and Sponsors for their dedication, diligence and support.

I look forward to your continued efforts and support in 1996 as we continue with the implementation phase of our Strategic Plan.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT (Kerri M Tepper)

Part-funded by Sport & Recreation Victoria

At this time last year, I reflected that 1994 had been a year of development and planning for the future. It is pleasing to see that twelve months later, much of our planning has been implemented and developments made.

A modest increase in registered members statewide shows promise for the future. A more structured approach to servicing of Affiliated Associations and Clubs by Alois Rosario (Sport Development Officer) and Keith Mundy (State Director of Coaching) has led to increased junior recruitment of players from schools in a number of associations. The re-introduction of VTTA conducted junior camps and squads are providing opportunities for juniors at all levels to improve their skill level and experience.

The VTTA has seen an increase in the activity, planning and development of Affiliated Associations and Clubs. To take two examples, the South Eastern TTA has developed a Strategic Plan for the future as a result of holding a planning evening involving contributions from all association members; and Sunshine and Districts TTA has celebrated its 50th anniversary by organising a number of exhibitions by elite and local players at shopping centres - involving a large local media campaign to increase numbers, followed by a large dinner/dance to celebrate the anniversary. These, and other initiatives by affiliates, are to be highly commended.

Visits by Bob Tuckett, Fran Keyhoe, Ron Carlton (TTA) and myself to meet the committees of Affiliated Associations and Clubs continued to be positive and valuable this year, and will continue in 1996.

A disappointment has been the quiet response to the 1995 Kingsway Motel Volunteer of the Year and Fairy Stork Chinese Restaurant Coach of the Year Awards. Whilst the quality of nominations this year has been excellent once again, the number of nominations has been extremely disappointing. Every Association and Club has highly committed, dedicated, non-paid volunteers who are vital to the success of the organisation. Don't they deserve some recognition? In 1996 the awards will be opened up to accept nominations from registered individuals who know a volunteer or have a coach who they would like to recognise. Please support these Awards in 1996.

I take this opportunity to thank Sport and Recreation Victoria and Victorian Health Promotion Foundation/Arthritis Foundation of Victoria for their ongoing funding of Table Tennis in 1995. A big thank you also to our corporate sponsors who have supported our many tournaments and development programs throughout the year.

I thank and congratulate the VTTA Board of Management for their extensive contribution in 1995. Volunteers from all Affiliated Associations/Clubs are to be thanked for once again MAKING TABLE TENNIS HAPPEN IN VICTORIA.

In conclusion, a big thank you to Donna, Alois, Joan and the Albert Park casual staff (John Corbett, Andrew Gilbert, Gary Ireland, Dianne Kilderry, Paul Langley, Mohamad Tog-dheer and Clare Yang) for their excellent work throughout the year. Despite the extra workload imposed on all staff members and Board members due to the ongoing vacancies of two Board positions, it has been a very positive year.

A very special thank you to Angelo Tabone who has devoted many, many hours on a daily basis assisting in many administrative and program areas in the VTTA Office.

I look forward to 1996 being a year of continued growth, stability and development in the areas of PROFESSIONALISM, PARTICIPATION levels and PROFILE.

VICHEALTH PROGRAM REPORT (Joan Guggenheim)

The "Move It or Lose It" Program was funded by the Victorian Health Promotion Foundation (VicHealth), and our health sponsor was the Arthritis Foundation of Victoria.

An extensive range of events were sponsored - State League, Victorian Secondary Schools Championships, Tabten, Coaching Camps, Expos, Exhibitions, Tournaments, Pennant, Inter Association Challenges, visits to Senior Citizens and Retirement Villages - covering the whole range of players from Juniors to Veterans in both metropolitan and country areas.

The health message was continuously promoted with "Move It or Lose It" Posters, Car Stickers, Shirts, Certificates, Entry Forms, Bags and Bag Tags. Most people now equate Table Tennis with the "Move It or Lose It" slogan.

VETERANS REPORT (Joan Guggenheim)

The VicHealth Australian Masters Games and "Move It or Lose It" Australian Veterans Championships, both held in October at the Table Tennis Centre of Victoria, Albert Park, were the major events for the year. Victorian players were outstanding in both events.

Victorians won each of the Singles in the Masters Games. The Australian Veterans Championships saw many records established - the largest number of players (248), 3773 matches contested, a B Team won a teams event for the first time, and Victoria won 7 of the 8 teams events contested. This will be a record that will stand for a long time.

Inter Association and Interstate challenges are now a yearly event.

Melbourne Veterans Pennant, played at Albert Park on Friday nights continues to be the largest veterans pennant in Victoria averaging over 100 players per season. Geelong, Traralgon, Hamilton, Albury/Wodonga, Croydon and Ballarat all cater for veterans.

Veterans were well catered for with tournaments held at Mornington, Croydon, Ballarat, Geelong and Dandenong, as well as the Victorian Open and Victorian Closed held at Albert Park.

AFFILIATED ASSOCIATIONS/CLUBS REPORT (Fran Keyhoe)

1995 saw the introduction of a four tiered registration system, with very good results. We had an increase of 306 registered members.

This year the team events of the Sportscover Victoria Country Championships were all played at Albert Park. The individual events were merged with the Central Highland Championships which were conducted at Ballarat. For 1996, it has been decided to conduct all the Country Championships events at Albert Park.

During the year Bob Tuckett, Kerri Tepper, Fran Keyhoe (VTTA) and Ron Carlton (TTA) visited many Associations, and were guests at their Committee Meetings.

Three affiliate meetings were held in the past 12 months, the first the Annual Meeting of the Country Associations, the second a meeting at Ballarat to discuss the future of the Country Championships and the last was a meeting in November of all Affiliated Associations/Clubs to discuss current issues and the registration fees for the next 12 months. It is disappointing to note that not many Associations attended these meetings.

In 1996 greater emphasis will be placed on identifying and visiting unaffiliated Associations/Clubs throughout Victoria, encouraging affiliation.

SPORTS DEVELOPMENT OFFICER'S REPORT (Alois Rosario)

Part funded by Sport and Recreation Victoria

There were some great successes in Table Tennis during the year with the targeting of Associations and Clubs in the recruitment of Juniors. The more direct approach and dealing directly with Associations proved much more effective during 1995. This will be the blueprint for Association/Club visits during 1996.

There was some major success at Diamond Valley and Albury/Wodonga. At Diamond Valley their Junior Competition increased a Grade after the good work of their Junior Committee in recruiting players through school promotions and a Come 'N Try day.

At Albury/Wodonga Bill Mitchell, Steve Dainton and a band of keen helpers have had great success in recruiting new young players and also achieve results by having four players from Albury/Wodonga in the Riverina Trophy Team. Steve Dainton himself was selected in the Under 17 Boys 'B' team. The first representative from that Association to do so.

This year has seen the emergence of several people working through Association/Clubs to better their Junior programs. Brian Berry at Mornington has put in many hours to lift the standard and numbers. Keith Mundy, Nicole Freeland and Ross Ferris have done the same at Ballarat. Pat Clarke and Michael Jeffrey have continued their enthusiastic work at Yarrowonga. Other Associations too have put in concerted efforts to increase their Junior programs which augers well for the growth of Table Tennis.

During the year Keith Mundy (State Director of Coaching) and I, attempted to visit as many Associations as possible. We reached a large percentage of them. We aim to visit everyone in 1996.

On the down side school tournaments continue to be poorly patronised. We will have to take a good hard look at the format of these in future years. Perhaps a solution is to localise these events. Schools are finding it more difficult to travel distances.

A big thanks to all those hard working people in Associations and Clubs right around Victoria that I have dealt with during the year. All those people share the ideal of our sport receiving the recognition it deserves as the greatest sport around. I hope this can spread during 1996.

Thank you also to Sport & Recreation Victoria for their continued financial and administrative support through the year. Thank you also to Doug Sandiford and Kathy Tessier at the Aussie Sport Teacher Education Unit for their support and organisation.

JUNIOR REPORT

An official report is unavailable due to the vacancy of the Junior Portfolio position on the VTTA Board of Management.

Junior Pennant was conducted during the summer season, but was not continued due to a lack of continuity in numbers participating. The VTTA is grateful for the efforts by Brian Berry during this season.

VTTA Junior Squads were reintroduced in September 1995, with twice weekly coaching conducted by Nela Bran and Rod Carlyle, providing ongoing training opportunities for our elite juniors.

Victorian junior teams were once again a strong force at the Australian Junior Championships, bringing home two teams titles (U/17 boys and U/15 girls) and eight individual titles, including all singles titles up for grabs. Trevor Brown was awarded the Michael Szabados Award for the 1995 Australian Junior Player of the Year.

Outstanding Victorian junior Shirley Zhou continued her impressive international performances representing Australia successfully at a number of international events.

COACHING REPORT

State Director of Coaching Keith Mundy vacated his role and position on the VTТА Board of Management in November 1995 to take a part time coaching position with Ballarat Table Tennis Association. The VTТА thanks Keith for his many years of service and is pleased that he will continue to be active in Victorian Table Tennis in many areas.

Level One NCAS coaching courses were conducted this year in Horsham and Albert Park, with a total of 16 participants.

As a benefit of affiliation with the VTТА, all Associations and Clubs are entitled to one free coaching development visit, incorporating coaching opportunities in schools and the association/club. In 1995, a more structured provision of this servicing was coordinated by Keith Mundy and Alois Rosario, proving more beneficial for affiliates. A large number of affiliates utilised this opportunity available, but it is hoped that all Associations and Clubs take advantage of this service in 1996.

WOMEN/MARKETING REPORT (Maxine Miller)

WOMEN

The Womens Table Tennis Program conducted at Albert Park was organised by Ruth Singer with the support of coach Keith Keane attracting a small number of women, who then joined the veterans competition. However, it was discontinued in the last half of the year due to lack of participants. The VTТА has applied for government funding to investigate the lack of female participation and drop out rate in Table Tennis.

The allocation of womens funding received from Sport and Recreation Victoria included the funding of five women to complete a Level One Coaching Course, and for Claire Dillon to attend the Australian Olympic Academy Victorian session.

In order to attract more girls to Table Tennis, it seems appropriate that high profile women players be utilized in junior development programs in schools. The 1996 Atlanta Olympic Games avails an opportunity to raise the profile of Table Tennis and the participation of our elite players may attract publicity and media attention.

MARKETING

Corporate support of Victorian Table Tennis continued in 1995, with the securing of Tattersall's as the major sponsor of the 1996 Victorian Open for the tenth year, a major highlight. In addition they have doubled their contribution to \$5,000 and are keen to continue supporting Table Tennis.

Corporate sponsorships are being reviewed with sponsorship packages being developed to try to attract new areas of support.

An innovative new logo is being developed and with the change of name to Table Tennis Victoria and Mini Tab during 1996.

Promotional products (eg t-shirts, drink bottles) have been investigated and will be commissioned for production following the approval of our name change.

SENIOR PENNANT/TOURNAMENTS REPORT (Robert Grattidge)

PENNANT

The VTТА conducted the usual three pennant competitions - Summer, Winter and Spring - during 1995. Coburg were successful in winning the A Grade premierships for Winter and Spring. Summer A Grade was won by Albert Park. Player numbers were unfortunately down on the previous year. Hopefully with the expected move to the new Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre in 1997 a new era will begin for Table Tennis.

TOURNAMENTS

1995 saw the introduction of a point rating system for all tournaments. This appeared to create new enthusiasm amongst the players and as a result most tournaments were well attended. Albert Park conducted the usual Easter, Moomba, Victorian Closed, Victorian Open and City of Melbourne. Other Open Tournaments were held at Traralgon, Geelong, Ballarat, Mornington, Dandenong, Croydon and Eaglehawk/Bendigo. All tournaments appeared to be well conducted.

Move It or Lose It State League

The State League was held on Wednesday nights at Albert Park commencing 3 May with Grand Finals on 16 August. Teams competing were Albert Park, Caulfield, St Kilda Cricket, Middle Park, Coburg and Geelong. Cash prizes were presented on Grand Final night.

TABLE TENNIS CENTRE OF VICTORIA - ALBERT PARK

The Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre, at the time of writing, is due to be completed by May 1997, with a verbal guarantee that the existing facility will not be demolished until the new facility is completed (ie no down time).

The formation of a Trust to oversee the management of the new facility was announced late in 1995 and Mr Simon Weatherill has been appointed as Chief Executive Officer. Negotiations throughout 1995 have continued to be on the functional and technical aspects of the new facility. It is of great concern to all sports involved (Table Tennis, Basketball, Badminton, Squash and Water Sports) that negotiations are yet to begin on the crucial financial and management aspects of the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre, with the facility due to open in less than 18 months time.

The VTТА has been advised that access to the Table Tennis Centre of Victoria will not be available from midnight 4 March to midnight 11 March 1996 due to the staging of the Australian Formula One Grand Prix at Albert Park. The VTТА will submit a log of claims seeking compensation for this period.

FINANCIAL REPORT
1 JANUARY 1995 - 31 DECEMBER 1995

The following financial reports are unaudited. The financial accounts are with the auditors at present and no changes are expected. The reports are enclosed to allow perusal prior to the Annual General Meeting.
An audited report will be available at the Annual General Meeting.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL INFORMATION

We have continued to keep a close oversight on expenditure and to maximise income wherever possible. The surplus of \$40,286 for the current year is very pleasing and has resulted in Accumulated Funds being returned to a positive figure earlier than expected.

However the surplus is due to several items of a non-recurring nature, as detailed below. With the imminent departure of Table Tennis Australia from Albert Park and the ensuing reduction in rental revenue, a break-even budget has been prepared for the 1996 financial year.

1. Interest income increased by \$13,585 due to interest of \$11,600 on a long term compound interest investment, with the remainder as a result of higher funds on deposit.
2. A turnaround of \$12,507 in Championships due mainly to a surplus from the Australian Veterans Championships held at Albert Park last October, a closer oversight of costs involved in sending teams to Championships, and the fact that all three Championships were held in Victoria last year, thus resulting in a smaller outlay.
3. Table Tennis Australia changed its method of billing from a set amount for each registration to a levy for each State based on the total number of registered players. This had some initial problems in obtaining the correct figure, and the amounts initially advised were later revised. As a result the provision made in the 1994 accounts was overstated by approximately \$3,500. Thus the 1994 surplus should have been that much more, with the 1995 surplus correspondingly less.

Specific Items

Total staff costs for the year, including wages, superannuation, Workcare, expenses of Executive Director and S.D.O., were \$94,175. This has been allocated towards tournaments, pennant, newsheet preparation, championships and development and promotion.
