**NATIONAL INTEGRITY FRAMEWORK POLICY**

**Version:** as ratified on 15 December 2022

## **Name**

1. This By-Law shall be referred to as the **National Integrity Framework Policy By-Law**.

## **Source**

2. This By-Law is made pursuant to rule 33 of the Constitution of Table Tennis Victoria Incorporated.

## **Scope**

3. This By-Law is intended to implement a *National Integrity Framework Policy* to govern the participation of all members in table tennis activities in Victoria.

## **National Integrity Framework Policy**

4. Table Tennis Australia's [\*National Integrity Framework Policy\*](#) applies to Table Tennis Victoria by virtue of regulation 3 of the said Policy.
5. As part of the National Integrity Framework implementation, there are now six associated policies in place:
  - National Integrity Framework
  - Competition Manipulation and Sports Wagering Policy
  - Improper Use of Drugs and Medicine Policy
  - Child Safeguarding Policy
  - Member Protection Policy
  - Complaints, Disputes, and Discipline Policy

## **Victorian Child Safe Standards**

6. To ensure compliance with the Victorian Child Safe Standards, Table Tennis Victoria will also develop strategies that specifically address the Commission for Children and Young People Compliance Indicators.

## **Application of Policy to TTV members**

7. Without any derogation to the coverage of persons under Table Tennis Australia's *National Integrity Framework Policy*, such Policy shall also apply, by virtue of this by-law, to all members of Table Tennis Victoria with any incidental amendment as required.
