EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS REPORT (Kerri M Tepper)

In writing this report, I am a relative newcomer to this position, having commenced my work as Executive Director on April 19, 1993 following the resignation of the previous Executive Director, Rohan Dwyer.

1993 was a year of financial turmoil, with several submissions for funding from the corporate sector being unsuccessful. The VTTA was also recently informed that Table Tennis shall cease to be fully funded as a Victorian Institute of Sport team program as of December 1993. We are however fortunate that a limited number of athletes who meet the results and dedication criteria, shall be awarded individual scholarships for the first six months of 1994. I am thus faced with the huge challenge of seeking funding, which I shall attack diligently.

The area of sponsorship shall be a key element in a new five year development plan which is currently being devised. This plan, to be implemented in January 1994 shall focus strongly on the three P's - PARTICIPATION, PROFILE, PROFESSIONALISM.

The recruitment of youngsters into table tennis will be taken on more aggressively in 1994 with the implementation of a new 'Coaching Development Plan' devised by State Director of Coaching, Keith Mundy. This is an exciting plan that begins with Tots Table Tennis as a base and caters through to the senior elite level. This development plan will greatly increase the participation base of Victorian Table Tennis and push our elite players to a higher level of performance on the international stage.

In his role as Sports Development Officer, Alois Rosario has continued to work competently and conscientiously, dedicating many long hours to the development of table tennis in schools. The 1993 Victorian Secondary Schools Singles Championship, held at the Table Tennis Centre of Victoria - Albert Park was a great success despite current problems in the Education System. I thank teachers and parents for their time and support in making this event a success.

The "Move It or Lose It" Arthritis Awareness Program has continued to expand its support into more areas under the steady guidance of Executive Officer Joan Guggenheim. The Arthritis Awareness Program has sponsored events such as the "Move It or Lose It" Girls of All Ages Tournament, the reactivated "Move It or Lose It" Womens Competition, Ballarat Tots Table Tennis Program as well as the many and varied programs ranging from junior to veterans.

The Victorian Institute of Sport Table Tennis Program has once again been a vital component in the development of our elite athletes. The program, under the guidance of head coach Mr Lansun Zhou, has provided athletes with access to services such as nutrition counselling, sports sciences, fitness testing, sports psychology, sports medicine,

strength and conditioning, career and education counselling. These factors are now commonly recognised as vital contributors to elite performance. All scholarship holders have benefited greatly from this program, with the group as a whole showing improvement in both performance and attitude.

Our elite players will now have to fully dedicate themselves to their table tennis in order to seek readmission into the full VIS Program in the future.

1993 was a successful year for Victorian Table Tennis at a National level. Victorian representatives continued to dominate in winning the majority of both individual and teams events at the National Junior, Youth and Senior Championships. It was also very positive to see our younger players performing very strongly at the National Senior/Youth Championships, providing great promise for the future.

Finally, I must thank the Board of Management and staff for assisting me in settling into this position, and I look forward to their continued support into 1994. Thanks also to those who have served on the various sub-committees during the year. Without the work of this generous group of individuals I would find my task much harder.

Special thanks must go to Val Bartolo (Office Manager) for her hard work in compiling this Annual Report.

I greatly look forward to the challenges ahead in 1994 and I ask for all table tennis officials, players and administrators alike to represent our great sport with pride and a positive attitude. Let us together achieve..... PARTICIPATION, PROFESSIONALISM and PROFILE.

SPORTS DEVELOPMENT OFFICERS REPORT (Alois Rosario)

During 1993 we continued our push into Schools and also managed to serve our Affiliated Associations as much as possible. With Schools being a very high priority this year we conducted a number of clinics and exhibitions in various areas.

The running of Schools Tournaments was quite disappointing, with the reduced funding and closure of so many schools. In most cases, the schools were unable to spare the necessary staff to travel to sporting venues with students. However, we were most happy to have the number participate that were able and hope to expand again throughout 1994. Unfortunately the Tabten event for schools teams this year was extremely disappointing with only 78 teams entering the competition as opposed to 200 plus in 1992.

EXPOS

During the year we attended several "Be Your Best" Aussie Sport Expos. These Expos are funded by VicHealth, sponsored by the Australian Drug Foundation and administered by the Directorate of School Education, Sport & Recreation Victoria and the Australian Sports Commission.

SCHOOL HOLIDAYS

Approximately 500 children participated over 6 days at a clinic conducted at the World Trade Centre from January 12 to 19. Each participant was given a flyer informing them of their nearest club or association. During School holidays later in the year we conducted clinics for approximately 1,200 children.

The program was once again conducted at the World Trade Centre in conjunction with Tennis Australia and the VFA Care for Kids campaign. The use of the spacious Galleria area was provided for us by the Port of Melbourne Authority through Mr Rick Lavale. During the week of clinics we gave basic instruction to 950 children aged from 5 to 12 years old. The children came in with various council school holiday programs. The participants were all given a list of their local clubs and/or associations as well as a poster.

During the year I made visits to the following Affiliated Associations: Albury\Wodonga, Eaglehawk/Bendigo, Edenhope, Geelong, Horsham Kerang, Myrtleford, Shepparton and Yarrawonga.

All in all this has been a very busy, fruitful year. I would like to offer my sincere thanks the many people who assisted in all of the above. Finally, thankyou to the Department of Sport & Recreation for their ongoing financial support as well as their support in most aspects of the job.

THE TABLE TENNIS CENTRE OF VICTORIA

The decline in the number playing VTTA Pennant and Tournaments is slowly being pegged back. This alleviates some of the problem of membership and cash flow. As was seen by the Annual Report 1991/92 the Association suffered a loss of revenue due to varied circumstances, the Board are making every effort to rectify this situation.

The Board of Management are endeavouring to bring the Centre up to a higher standard but the age of the building is a limiting factor which is very hard to overcome. The Centre Court floor has been sanded and finished with a gloss non-slip surface. The three courts which comprise the Victorian Institute of Sport area were also re-surfaced after being lightly sanded.

The Centre Court lighting has been upgraded to the required standard. The Tungsten Halogen lights have been replaced with Metal Halide, with the new lights using far less power and giving off additional light. The Board are giving consideration to upgrading the lighting throughout the Centre at some time possibly in 1994.

The Victorian Public Service continue to use the facility on a regular basis. VTTA Veterans Pennant is always extremely well entered. The Veterans Tournament circuit is also booming and looks like going to even greater heights with the World Veterans Championships being held in Melbourne in April 1994. This event will be of great benefit to Table Tennis in general with the resulting publicity hopefully giving the sport a major boost in Victoria.

Leon & Susan Lau have once again done a superb job of running the combined snack bar and equipment shop. Leon and Susan have decided to retire after having been with us for 13 years. All who know these two wonderful people wish them a very happy retirement, these will be an extremely hard pair of shoes to fill. Best wishes are extended to the incoming lease holders Mrs Ivy and Mr Lan Sun Zhou.

The proposed re-development at Albert Park is no further advanced than it was 12 months ago. The scale of the project is not only huge, but quite unique in that it must cover all four sports that currently inhabit this area as well as incorporating an additional number yet to be determined. The desired end result will be that all will be in harmony with the parkland and the newly refurbished lake.

The Australian Table Tennis Association have taken up residence within the Table Tennis Centre of Victoria - Albert Park. The area that was the VTTA Board Room has been refurbished and is now the National Office. Rod Lindroth (Exec. Director), Sharon Graham (Administration Manager, Anne Oakley (National Dev. Officer) and Ron Carlton (World Veterans Championships Organiser) are all working out of this office.

STAFF

The staff employed by the Victorian Table Tennis Association have once again shown their dedication and ability throughout what has been a very hectic year. With the introduction of the new ATTA registration system, an extremely full tournament calendar, the resignation of our Executive Director, Rohan Dwyer who chose to travel and the appointment of Kerri Tepper to the position, the staff have been required to give all their energy and expertise to keep up with the changes.

The Sports Development Officer, Alois Rosario has had to spend a considerable amount of extra time out of the office due to the heavy demand on his time to conduct clinics at school holiday camps, schools throughout the State and many other venues including an elderly citizens rest home.

Last but certainly not least, our thanks are extended to every Duty Officer mentioned above for without their cheerful disposition and helpful manner the VTTA would be hard pressed to maintain the good public profile that we currently enjoy. Also thanks to Claire Yang who left us in June, her happy attitude and ready smile made her an asset to the front office. Hopefully Claire will return to us at some time in future.

AFFILIATED ASSOCIATIONS & CLUBS

Our Associations and Clubs were all to become affiliated due to the changes in the Player Registration/Insurance Scheme that was set in motion prior to 1993. The pre-requisite being that to take advantage of the Insurance Scheme the major Clubs and Associations must affiliate. This is a worthwhile contribution to Table Tennis as all sports are taking up this most important option so that players are insured against accident while competing.

State and Federal Governments are now expressing the need for all sports to contribute to their own financial well being and not to rely heavily on funding for development. We gained North East Country (Rutherglen area) and Croxton Club (Northcote area) as new affiliates. Wonthaggi have re-affiliated for the first time since 1982 and we welcome them back. Many associations are finding it increasingly hard to find dedicated officials who are willing to put in the time and effort required to run an association.

The VTTA are doing everything in their power to maintain a good coaching/umpiring base by conducting coach education and umpires courses throughout the State. This effort being made now will have far reaching consequences in future as having registered coaches and umpires within each association will ensure that the juniors who are to be our future seniors will remain in the sport at either playing, coaching, umpiring or administration level.

VICHEALTH PROGRAM (Joan Guggenheim)

The Move It. or Lose It.. program, which is funded by VicHealth and sponsored by the Arthritis Foundation of Victoria, has been an outstanding success.

Many innovations have been tried this year. A tiny tots group of pre-school children has been commenced in Ballarat; the State League saw the introduction of an extra girl into each side; all- girls camps were conducted; tours to the country areas by our elite players, who visited schools and associations giving exhibitions and coaching sessions; Victorian Schools Singles Championships and Tabten Schools Teams Championships were organised; and a Girls of All Ages Tournament was introduced very successfully.

These are just a few of the initiatives that have been conducted within the Program.

The Move It.. or Lose It.. message was distributed throughout Victoria via the media, pamphlets, car stickers and posters.
