MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

In recent times Table Tennis within Victoria has grown in both stature and popularity.

The domination of Australian Table Tennis by Victorian at all National Championships has created a sense of pride which should be felt by all Victorians whether a State representative, medium standard pennant player or social player who play simply for the pleasure of the game.

The introduction of the individual player registration scheme has seen an increase in numbers which is very pleasing however to truly unify Victorian Table Tennis as a whole, much more work still needs to be done.

Excellent performances at the National Youth, Junior and Senior championships netted Victoria six out of a possible 10 teams titles, not to mention the individual titles also captured by Victorians.

Victorian Veterans produced excellent results at the recent Australian Veterans Championships held in Canberra in both teams and individual events. A special thanks must also be extended to those who are responsible for the organisation of these teams. The manager, chaperones, non playing team captains, selectors and of course the work of Hua Jie Yang as State Coach. All of these good people deserve to be recognised, as without people such as these their performances of our teams would certainly not be of a similar degree.

The VTTA was once again fortunate enough to be considered worthy of maintaining its Victorian Institute of Sport Program which has certainly fostered the development of our aspiring young players under the guidance of Head Coach - Zhou Lan Sun and Assistant Coach Hua Jie Yang. The program is beginning to develop a more structured and scientific approach, and one which we hope will elevate Victorian athletes up the World rankings ladder.

The ongoing reciprocal arrangement with the Chinese Table Tennis Association was further strengthened with the visit of a team of 10 players and officials in late June, 1992. A series of matches and intense training sessions were certainly most beneficial to members of the V.I.S Team and other players who were able to learn from the expertise of the highly fancied Chinese. This arrangement has gone a long way in advancing the skills of Victorian players and we look forward to similar visits in future.

Nets 'N' Edges, the official VTTA Magazine has been a great success thanks mainly to the hard work of Val Bartolo. This of course is the members magazine and therefore to continue its success we encourage worthy articles to be sent in and if possible will be published in the following issue.

It was pleasing to see the support of the huge amount of table tennis players and other interested people register their names on a petition sent to HSV7 requesting table tennis be given more exposure at the Barcelona Olympics. As many of us would have seen our prayers were met with success, with the coverage of the ladies and mens final being screened. Unfortunately we didn't see any of our own Olympian Kerri Tepper, but at least it was a step in the right direction.

In the near future work will begin on restructuring the coaching and talent identification programs on a Statewide basis. The program will identify and attend to past shortcomings with respect to those country players who have found it difficult to further their table tennis in their local areas. This program can only work if it has the support of all affiliated associations and the potential benefits that can be gained certainly will warrant this support.

In line with local councils fire safety policies the Table Tennis Centre of Victoria at Albert Park underwent a few changes in the later part of the year. The most drastic of which was the proposal to demolish the centre court grandstand, but after some lobbying we were able to keep the stand, much to the delight of all those who have utilised this facility in one way or another over the years.

Finally, I would like to take this opportunity to thank the many people who have worked very hard in ensuring the development of our sport continues throughout Victoria. In particular I would like to thank the Board of Management, the Office Staff, Owen Davies and his helpers and the executives of all clubs and associations throughout Victoria for their continued support. I look forward to an exciting 1993 and one which I hope, will see the increasing popularity of our sport continue.

SPORTS DEVELOPMENT OFFICER REPORT 1991

During 1991 we continued our push into Schools as well as trying to serve our Affiliated Associations as much as possible. We were also able to get to places such as Albury/Wodonga, Kerang, Bendigo, Warrnambool, Kyabram, Shepparton, Kyneton, Mornington, Ballarat and Geelong.

The running of the Schools tournaments again took up considerable time, however things are running a little smoother with the streamlining of certain areas. This year the running of the Schools Singles Championships was made a lot easier thanks to the co-operation of the clubs and associations that held the zone finals. To these people I extend my thanks for lightening the load.

A special mention to Dot Sanders who helps whenever required in the running of all the Schools tournaments, her help and expertise in the organisation of these days is invaluable.

Other events of interest during the year were the Coca Cola Youth Expo, Ping & Pong Clown exhibitions. Exhibitions at the Treasury Gardens as well as a three day Professional Development Seminar in Geelong conducted by the Department of Sport & Recreation.

Finally a word of appreciation to the Department for the funding of this position, their support is vital to the future of our Sport.

SPORTS DEVELOPMENT OFFICER REPORT 1992

Schools were again a high priority this year with several school clinics and exhibitions being requested.

Two specific promotions were done in Geelong and Coburg, with Come 'N' Try days at the end of the promotion. On each occasion we visited between 5 to 10 schools advertising the Come 'N' Try days as well as the ongoing local coaching. There have been positive results with Geelong and Coburg having a regular Primary Schools Coaching Group as a result.

During the year we visited Traralgon, Mornington, Kerang, Geelong and Yarrawonga.

Aussie Sports Expo's were attended in Hamilton, Geelong, Diamond Valley, Horsham, Warracknabeal, Wonthaggi, Shepparton and Seymour.

FROM THE PRESIDENT

The past year has been very busy for both players and officials, and has included many high points for our sport. Our players, senior, junior and veterans have dominated the national titles and in the seniors, Victorians fill the top three rankings in the men's section and the top two spots in the women's section.

Dennis Makaling has been named player of the year (1992) and Shirley Zhou named Junior player of the year. Shirley also has the unique honour of being ranked No.1 in all four under aged (U21, U19, U17 and U15) women's sections.

Kerri Tepper represented our sport at the Olympics in Barcelona, (her second Olympiad) which is a great personal achievement and a just reward for all her hard work and dedication over the past years.

Our under aged players also acquitted themselves very well and filled fifteen out of the top twenty four positions in the various sections.

The above successes are not only a tribute to the efforts of the players concerned but also to the support of the Victorian Institute of Sport. The V.I.S has given our top seniors and juniors a wonderful opportunity to improve their skills at the table, and has provided the backup systems which are necessary for any athlete to reach the top. They have given our players the opportunity to play some of the world's best, by arranging visits of teams from China. These exchange visits are most important in the development of our players, and play a major part in lifting the standard of Australian Table Tennis.

Our Veteran players have had a successful year with player numbers increasing in both the Metropolitan and Country areas. At the National Championships they won nine out of the twenty individual finals played, a great effort from Victorian Veterans.

Congratulations to all players who helped maintain Victorias dominance in this sport.

In April this year Bob Ferguson resigned as Executive Director to take up a position with B.M.X Australia. We thank Bob for the work he has done over the past three years and wish him well in his new appointment.

Rohan Dwyer commenced duties as our new Executive Director late in April and after a very hectic few months is settling in nicely.

This year the player registration fee was introduced, and after the initial settling in period, is working well. A new insurance cover was also introduced for each registered player and official involved in table tennis. Although table tennis is not a dangerous sport, accidents do occur and it is comforting to know that we have that safety net in place.

The support table tennis has received from the Country and Metropolitan Associations has been very encouraging and the V.T.T.A Executive is most appreciative of their efforts. No longer can sporting bodies operate on their own and it is essential that table tennis players and officials support each other to help promote and expand our sport.

Table Tennis is not immune from the economic realities being experienced and like many other 'low profile' sports we have found it very difficult to attract commercial sponsorship. This has caused us to call upon some of our reserves in order to maintain our commitment to developing the sport. In order to develop we need to expand our fund raising base and this will be high on our list of priorities during 1993.

Earlier this year the A.T.T.A was successful in their bid to host the 1994 World Veterans Championships in Melbourne. This gives us a great opportunity to become involved in the biggest Table Tennis Tournament in the World, and as the time gets closer we will be asking for assistance from Victorian players and officials to help make this a successful event.

In closing, I would extend a special thanks to the many people who, over the past year have helped in many and varied ways. There are too many individuals to name personally, but I would like to bring to your notice the following groups:

The many Country and Metropolitan Association Officials who work tirelessly so that our game can be played throughout the whole of Victoria.

The V.T.T.A Executive Committee who put in many hours to ensure that we have a central base for our sport to develop.

The various sub-committees responsible for tournaments, junior activities, veterans pennant, Melbourne pennant, the coaches, the umpires and all other activities which form part of our game.

The office staff and all those who help in administration and maintenance of Albert Park, the home of the V.T.T.A.

OLYMPIC SOLIDARITY COURSE:

The VTTUL instigated a new Victorian umpiring qualification of Associate Umpire and eight people qualified between January 1991 and September 1992. Cameron Gething, Jan Tucker, Alan Hawkins, Mark Pauline, Peter Carmody, Justine Box, Gasey Baffsky, Frank Pye.

Also during this period, in addition to Graeme Ireland achieving National status, Janet Freer, Grant Everitt and Lothar Pilz became Probationary Umpires, the last two also becoming eligible for full State level, as did the 1990 probationaries, Graeme Ireland, Alan Peel, Ray Ring and Margaret Tonkin.

COACHING

COACHING FOR ALL

Group coaching is made available for adults and juniors of all standards, from beginner to intermediate level. Elite Coaching is conducted by Mr Zhou Lan Sun, State Coach and Mr Hua Jie Yang, assistant State Coach.

Senior Group Coaching is conducted Monday and Friday Nights and Junior Group Coaching is conducted on Saturday afternoons. These sessions are held in such a manner that interested players may attend every session or broken sessions as desired.

JUNIOR SQUADS AND TEAMS

Junior Squads are selected throughout the year, and State Teams are chosen from these squads to represent Victoria at National Championships.

The Teams for the the Riverina Trophy Tour which is Victoria vs New South Wales (junior competition) are also selected from these squads. This annual competition is used as grounding for future State Team players.

SCHOOLS

Coaching in Schools is done by our Sports Development Office Mr Alois Rosario or an accredited coach appointed by him to act on his behalf. The push into Schools has done an enormous amount of good for Table Tennis in that the number of juniors currently enjoying our sport has increased by quite a large number over the past year and a half.

The Sports Development Officer Scheme has been primarily funded by Sport & Recreation and has enhanced the Table Tennis Program in Schools to such a degree that many Schools now call upon these services on a regular basis.
