## MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT (Phillip Carruthers)

### Business

TTV had a successful 2002, recording a small profit, which was a significant improvement from our large loss in 2001. Credit for this must go to both Dale Gilson, who set the budget and managed it for the first half of the year, and Martin Vink who managed it for the second half of the year. We are working hard to ensure that the 2001 loss will not be repeated.

### Operations

TTV successfully hosted the Australian Youth, Junior, and Veterans championships and the World Masters Games in 2002, in addition to its large existing tournament schedule and day to day operations. Congratulations must go to the TTV staff and our incredible volunteers for their enormous efforts to support these major events.

### Philosophy

Competitive table tennis participation can be characterised as an equilateral triangle. If we broaden the base then the peak will rise. Equally, if we push the peak up then the base will broaden. Unfortunately our table tennis pyramid in Victoria has been shrinking. New initiatives have recently been approved to build both the base and the peak.

In January a recruitment drive pilot was successfully run which showed enormous promise for future years and has also introduced a new sponsor to table tennis.

An expanded schools competition also shows the promise of introducing thousands of new juniors to our ranks.

At the peak level we are reintroducing the Victorian Senior Squad Training Program and have just negotiated a small program for selected players with the Victorian Institute of Sport. We plan to expand that program next year, 'piggy-backing' the Commonwealth Games preparatory funding. A keystone of the new philosophy for elite players will be the professionalism of our athletes and accordingly we have attracted a significant new uniform sponsorship to help our athletes look the part as they proudly represent Victoria.

At the same time we can't forget those people in the middle of the pyramid, the players who turn up week after week to pennant or social competitions. Some of the services these people receive, such as the Nets and Edges magazine, have not been as regular as they should have been. The board takes responsibility for this and assures members that these basic services will be improved. A new membership card which gives members access to a 5% discount on goods at Rebel Sports is being issued now. The TTV web page has been simplified and now contains current material.



## CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S REPORT (Martin Vink)

*Three years to Melbourne 2006!! Let us all share in the quest for gold.*

In my short experience with Table Tennis Victoria, it has been my pleasure to witness a most vibrant and enthusiastic network of volunteers. I cannot imagine that any sport in Victoria would have greater human resources than Table Tennis. I really appreciate being given the opportunity to serve as Chief Executive Officer.

2002 was a turnaround year financially. From a significant loss in 2001, we managed a small profit in 2002. This was largely due to the hosting of national championships at MSAC, the hard work of Victorian volunteers such as Angelo Tabone and the cooperation of our interstate volunteers such as Brian James.

In 2002, the Annual Gala Auction Dinner Dance was reinstated at the Bentleigh Club. It is important to get together on occasions such as this to meet socially and to reflect on the achievements as individuals and as an organisation. The Dinner Dance in 2003 will be at the same location on 22 November. I hope to see all of you there to let your hair down.

Staff turnover in 2002 posed a new challenge for the Board and other volunteers. Renee McHugh took over from Donna Dennis in the beginning of the year. I replaced Dale Gilson in August and the next month Laura Fleming replaced Renee. Despite these challenges, most of the work has been caught up and we look forward to a vibrant 2003. Worldwide Sports Insurance will sponsor a new series of membership cards and members will soon avail themselves of some new member benefits. All our regular distributors of table tennis equipment have pledged their support. Please have your membership card with you at all times because being a member is a privilege.

The TTV office is a user-friendly place for volunteer committees to meet. We will soon have a new computer environment available for volunteers to become even more productive. All basic office functions will improve to boost our service to all affiliates.

Being rather new has given me the advantage of being tolerated for asking basic questions. Questions such as: "where is every club and association listed in the telephone directories?" How will new members look for us? It is quite possible that there are still many opportunities for improving our interface with the public.

At MSAC there are bound to be opportunities for joint programs where table tennis can enhance its image through its association with a world leading sporting facility. Many members have suggested that the public image of table tennis should change. I hope to have the answers to some of these questions in next year's Annual Report. In the meantime, please read my suggestions for marketing your club and association.

To get us started, I have been concentrating on developing the resources we have rather than looking for new resources. Besides enthusiastic volunteers and a great office environment, our members have many talents. As you renew your membership, please let us know about your areas of expertise or let us know about your contacts. It should not be difficult to continue to save more money and to raise more funds. Every table tennis player would have been thrilled to see that Sunshine has a \$10,000 tournament. Dandenong has a junior program that is causing accommodation problems. All we need to do is to clone these efforts and soon we will have a table tennis circuit that can compete with Europe.

Australia has many sporting resources. It is just a matter of reallocating some of them to table tennis! To get the ball rolling, we are establishing new relationships with the Victorian Institute of Sport and other organisations. As members, please don't hesitate to share your suggestions on how we can better approach City Councils for grants, etc. Any potential resources can be explored until it becomes part of our nature to see ways to apply such resources to table tennis.

I see it as my function to collect and disseminate information in order to allow table tennis to reach its full potential in Victoria. There are probably well over a million Victorians who would love to play a little more table tennis – if we just let them know where we are. To move this along, we have updated the table tennis website. Please make it your website. Tell us how to improve it and how to better link it to your activities.

## CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS REPORT (Continued)

I will leave it to the Board members to discuss our performance during 2002 in greater detail. I would like to thank all of them for welcoming me to TTV and for helping me to get my feet wet. They have displayed great confidence in me to introduce new ideas and to keep questioning the established traditions. I have also enjoyed the warmth of volunteers all over Victoria and I look forward to making a real contribution to the operations of every affiliate. It is also proper for me to acknowledge the strong support and loyalty of Alois Rosario and Laura Fleming in the office. Matty Padley from Table Tennis Australia was a wonderful sounding board for me. I'm sorry to see her go. It has been quite an adjustment phase and we still have a long way to go but table tennis in Victoria is definitely on the move.

In 2003 I look forward to accepting more invitations to the Board meetings of all affiliates all over Victoria. Let's find some people to play with. Let's get some medals in 2006.

### DEVELOPMENT OFFICER'S REPORT (Alois Rosario)

(Part funded by Sport & Recreation Victoria)

2002 was a challenging year with the undertaking of several duties listed below:

- Conducted Teacher education for both Secondary and Primary Teachers and pre-service teachers
- Conducting school clinics and exhibitions on demand from schools and sports districts
- Resource development for Teachers
- Program coordination of Seniors Social Group
- Coordinator of Victorian Seniors Festival activities
- Coordinator of Victorian Schools Championships involving over 70 schools and 1800 students
- Coordinator of Victorian Singles for Players with an Intellectual Disability
- Development and maintenance of the database of schools and coaches
- Coordination and presentation of Level 1 Coaching Course
- Conducting Development visits to affiliates
- Liaising with various disability groups (VICSRAPID, Vicswish and Wheelchair Sports Victoria)
- Liaising with School Sport Victoria regarding Table Tennis Program
- Liaising with Australian Council for Health, Physical Education and Recreation (ACHPER)
- Coordinate Universities Program
- Conducting Training Camps for players

Schools were once again a major focus of the development program. We tried this year to reach more students through working with sports districts and further teacher education.

There was a continued interest shown by representative school teams especially from private schools to employ coaches to assist with the development of their school teams.

During the year we visited Albury/Wodonga, Ballarat, Bellarine, Hamilton, Mornington, Warrnambool, Shepparton, Sunraysia, Portland, Warracknabeal and Yarrawonga.

Thank you to all the coordinators in the association who spent many hours of coordination for the visits and the School Singles championships. Thanks also to Sport & Recreation Victoria for their funding and support of the Sport Development Officer position. Thanks to the School Sport Unit, ACHPER and VicSport for their support and to the many teachers who put in their own time to assist the growth of table tennis in schools.



## **ASSISTANCE TO AFFILIATED ASSOCIATIONS/CLUBS (George Gardoz)**

From the onset may I offer my apologies in respect to the fact that for two periods since taking on the portfolio I was not in a position to apply myself to the task. In one instance subject matter with which TTV had to deal with conflicted with my position, and it was best that I stay in the background; while the other was a trip overseas.

Happily, may I state that other Board members, and the administration personnel handled matters tactfully and with due diligence. I express my sincerest gratitude to them.

Correspondence to affiliates in regard to dates and times of their committee meetings resulted in a very small number of responses. However, my latest contacts have resulted in some meetings and have others on the agenda.

The purpose of these visits is to be able to act as a go-between the Board and the administration, and the affiliates. Concerns, and even just plain information, should easily pass between associations and clubs, and matters should be sorted out by mutual acceptance and cooperation.

While I wish to take an interest, many matters of concern to affiliates also are subject to other portfolios. Thus the Board as a whole becomes involved. This is a perpetual thing.

This year has not been any different to others, with the issues and concerns of one group having ramifications elsewhere and affect others.

Some matters which I have personally attended to, are:

### **2002 Country Championships**

#### **(i) General**

With the approval of Mr. D. Gilson, previous Executive Officer, I undertook to assist in the organization of the event. As it is one of the largest table tennis tournaments in the land, and as such I felt that it should appropriate the support from the most capable personnel available. I did not hesitate to ask Mrs. Fran Keyhoe for her support by nature of her own preference in the event, but also because of her undoubted skills, knowledge and personality. Further to that we asked for the services of Mr. Angelo Tabone and Mr. Graeme Ireland to share duties of referee.

TTV's staff assisted in obtaining sponsorship, issuing entry forms, making draws and preparing medallions. The tournament ran fairly much as usual, and the majority of individual events were contested. Presentation to winners was conducted as near as possible to when team matches were concluded. This is always done in such a rush, as people wish to get under way, that something is invariably overlooked. It occurred that while recipients were being called, one match was still in progress, thus putting a bit of pressure on one player. Also, due to the fact that some teams have more than three players, there was a shortfall in medallions. I followed that up on a couple of occasions to see that the office staff forwarded them on.

One of the highlights of the tournament was undoubtedly the performance of Mark Smith, Ballarat, in securing his 5<sup>th</sup> consecutive singles title.

#### **(ii) Board meeting**

TTV's Board decided to conduct one of its meetings on Sunday afternoon to enable interested country delegates and members to attend. The opportunity to hear deliberations, and to ask questions was offered. The number of observers was low and just a few questions were asked. We will attempt to advertise the meeting earlier and more widely in the future.

## ASSISTANCE TO AFFILIATED ASSOCIATIONS/CLUBS (George Gardoz) (Cont'd)

### (iii) Country Delegates' Meeting

The meeting was chaired by Mrs Fran Keyhoe upon my request. Representation was poor even though it was scheduled for Sunday evening in contrast to having one when the individual events are, as has been the case in the past. The meeting:

- Approved the introduction of a \$3.00 per team levy to be introduced in 2003 to help with expenses incurred by touring country representative teams.
- Accepted to retain the 11-point game system introduced in 2002.
- Re-elected Messrs W. Freeman (Eaglemont/Bendigo), B. Wright (Yarrawonga), and G. Gardoz (Ballarat) as country selectors.

### Victorian Country Championships Rules

Two documents of that title exist. The first one, most likely the original, was found by Mrs Fran Keyhoe. The second was given to me last year by a previous Country Selector. It was accompanied by a short, hand-written note and addressed to "Bill" (i.e. Mr. W. Freeman), and carried the date of 1-4-91. Attached to the letter is a version of the rules with hand-written amendments as apparently approved at a delegate's meeting.

The present Country Selectors examined this, and as there have been discussions in regard to "bringing the rules into line with current trends", considered that the proposed alterations were appropriate.

The new document was subsequently submitted for consideration by TTV.

### Taraflex floor covering

TTV consulted with the management of Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre on a number of occasions with respect to laying some Taraflex coverings within the precincts of the stadium, but ultimately it resulted that, while it might be welcome by table tennis players, the practical aspects made it less appealing.

The idea has been abandoned, and new ways of deploying the coverings is being investigated by TTV.

### Tournaments, rankings and seedings

Over recent years there has been a need to review the process by which associations/clubs receive payment for events conducted during tournaments.

There was a practice to route payments via TTV as it assumed the responsibility to produce event-seedings. The process broke down somewhat when there were last minute additions or withdrawals, and eventually with the transfer of the sums concerned.

With the advent of TTV's new record-keeping of tournament results, up-to-date rankings will be available to tournament directors, and thus last minute changes may be more easily accounted for. With event fees going directly to the clubs/association, matters should be better.

I would like to add, that while much of the responsibility in running events falls entirely within the scope of affiliates, it is bestowed upon them to maintain constant dialogue with TTV in order to keep pace with trends and developments, and hence help to maintain a uniform approach, which has important and helpful ramifications for the sport as a whole, not only amongst the state, but within Oceania as well.

In conclusion I trust the report to the Board of Management and members alike, renewing my gratitude for their tolerance, respect and patience during a somewhat difficult period of time.

## **JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT (Lindsay Drummond)**

My challenging and exciting year did not eventuate because I was unable to put in the time and commitment that this area requires.

The number competing at junior tournaments was down on last year. We also have such a small number of girls competing not only at tournaments but also at club level. Both these issues are a matter of concern. Do we need to look at the way we promote and market our game especially towards females? Is it necessary to appoint a Women's Development Officer? Do we try to organise a junior pennant at state level? On a more positive note, Victorian depth at the Nationals was marked.

Thanks must go to Phil Davis, for the tremendous amount of work he has and is doing in the junior area; Angelo Tabone, Helen Pottage, Claire Dillon, Graeme Ireland and the band of Referees and umpires who work tirelessly to ensure the tournaments run smoothly.

It would be well worthwhile organising rules seminars and/or courses for parents and players and coaches so that they become more familiar with this aspect of the game. All too often, there are situations where lack of knowledge of the rules and regulations has led to misunderstandings and sometimes disputes. A better understanding would give parents and players more confidence when they are called upon to umpire and allow the parents to participate in the sport with their children. It may also lead to more people wanting to become qualified umpires, which can only be good for our sport.

Congratulations to all major championship winners. It takes hard work and dedication to reach the top level. Keep up the good work.

## **COACHING (Phil Davis)**

### **Juniors**

The Junior State Squad training program at MSAC, Dandenong, Ballarat and Croydon provided a great building block for success at the 2002 Australian Junior and Under 18 Championships. Overall numbers in the program remained at about 60, with 42 of these at MSAC. The younger juniors demonstrated greater dedication, commitment and effort towards training than some of the older boys in the program. As was expected, their results at the nationals were reflective of their efforts. We dominated the younger age groups and recorded reasonable results at the older levels. All our teams won a medal, with three Gold Medals (U16 Boys, U14 Boys and U14 Girls), three Silver Medals (U16 Boys B, U14 Boys B and U14 Girls B) and three Bronze Medals (U18 Boys, U18 Girls and U16 Girls).

Home-grown Victorian juniors hadn't won an individual Gold Medal since Kamalesh Tharmasuthan in 1999. While we are still a long way from dominating the sport at the national junior level as we have on occasions in the past it was very pleasing to see five individual events come our way, with a total of 22 players winning an individual medal of some type. Our best performers were:

- Kyle Davis, 3 Gold (U14 Singles, Doubles and Mixed), 1 Silver (U16 Doubles) and 1 Bronze (U16 Singles), Stiga Best Under 14 Boy Player Award.
- Derrika Nheng, 3 Gold (U14 Singles, Doubles and Mixed) and 1 Silver (U16 Doubles), Stiga Best Under 14 Girl Award.
- Miles Gyuricza, 1 Gold (U14 Doubles), 1 Silver (U14 Singles) and 1 Bronze (U14 Mixed)

### **Junior Road Trips**

The Sunraysia Challenge, was run for the second year. Bruce Carter ran a successful weekend in Mildura involving some of our juniors that missed state selection, some South Australians, local Mildura players and players from Robinvale. A mixture of training and matches over the Melbourne Cup weekend was well received again.

Bruce Carter and Phil Davis ran a Junior Vic Squad training session in Hamilton. The Melbourne juniors joined in with locals and others from nearby Warrnambool in a day of hard training and fun. The exposure of the locals to our leading juniors was welcomed in return for some great country hospitality.

### **Youth**

Although no specific 'Youth' training squad eventuated in 2002 we still tasted success at this level. Our Under 20 'Youth' players were strongly supported by some of our leading juniors at the Australian Youth Championships. The Men's team taking Gold and the Women's team taking Bronze. Our best performers in individual events were:

- Kamalesh Tharmasuthan, Silver in the Men's Singles
- Caitlin Carruthers, 2 Bronze (Doubles and Mixed Doubles)
- Kyle Davis, 2 Bronze (Men's Singles and Doubles)

## Seniors

A Senior State Squad program did not eventuate in 2002 but remains a priority. None-the-less our strong Men's team dominated the Australian Championships, but Miao Miao's efforts alone couldn't lift our otherwise very inexperienced Women's team to the level hoped. Our best performers in the individual events were:

- Miao Miao, 2 Gold (Women's Singles and Mixed Doubles) and Bronze in Women's Doubles
- Simon Gerada, Silver (Men's Singles) and Bronze (Men's Doubles)
- Russell Lavale, 2 Gold (Doubles and Mixed Doubles) and Bronze (Men's Singles)
- Trevor Brown, Gold (Men's Doubles) and Bronze (Mixed Doubles)

## Oceania Representatives

Our leading juniors and seniors were given the opportunity to represent Oceania at international level. Although they didn't bring home any medals their performances were a credit to themselves, their state and their country. Our four that represented Oceania were:

- Miao Miao and Russell Lavale at the Women's World Cup in Singapore and the Men's World Cup in China respectively, and
- Derrika Nheng and Kyle Davis at the inaugural World Cadet (Under 15) Challenge and the World Youth Festival in Hungary.

## National Representatives

We had many players in the junior, youth and senior ranks represent Australia in 2002, with outstanding results, particularly at the Commonwealth Games in Manchester. Victorians in our Commonwealth Games team were: Jian Fang Lay (Silver Women's Team and Mixed Doubles), Miao Miao (Silver Women's Team), Trevor Brown and Russell Lavale.

Victorians in Australian teams for the Oceania Championships in Fiji were: Jian Fang Lay, Miao Miao, Russell Lavale, Trevor Brown, Kamalesh Tharmasuthan and Kyle Davis. This group brought home a bundle of medals, with honours for Gold Medals in Singles events to Jian Fang Lay (Women's), Russell Lavale (Men's) and Kyle Davis (Under 14 Boys).

Megan Bishop and Caitlin Carruthers represented Australia at the World Youth Festival in Hungary; and last but not least, Kyle Davis rounded out his year by representing Australia yet again in the Australian Junior Commonwealth Games Squad for training and Test matches against the Kiwis in New Zealand.

## Coaching

Two Level 1 Coaching Courses were conducted during the year, with a total of 13 participants. Parts of the Level 2 Course were also conducted during 2002 in conjunction with TTA, with significant numbers of Victorian attendees.

Two of our leading coaches, Alois Rosario and Peng Huy Quach wore the 'green and gold' with honour again this year. They coached our Men's and Women's teams respectively at both the Commonwealth Games and the Oceania Championships. The success that both teams experienced was a tribute to the knowledge and skill of these two fine coaches.

## **COACHING (Cont'd)**

### **Volunteer Support**

I'd like to acknowledge the support of a number of volunteers who played key roles in supporting the activities yet again, particularly as coaches at Australian championships. It is oft repeated how much we rely on volunteers; their contributions remain invaluable. Vicki Carruthers (Geelong), Bruce Carter (Oak Park), Zoltan Gyuricza (Sunshine), Simon Gerada (Sunshine), Debbie Hawke (Dandenong), Michael Belot (Dandenong), Chris Horwood (Werribee), Bob Scarborough (Warrnambool) and many others - thanks for the help!

## **VICHEALTH INITIATIVES (Alois Rosario)**

The VicHealth program entered the second year of its funding period with the initiatives of Healthy Food Choice and Smokefree as the two health areas assigned to table tennis. Table Tennis Victoria gained continued support from the Heart Foundation especially Nicky McKeown through the Healthy Food Choices program and Quit through Emma McKirdy with Smokefree. These agencies assisted with the establishment of a two year work plan in each area as well as assisting in the implementation.

Nineteen of our affiliates completed Healthy Food Choice and Smokefree written policies to be implemented.

Our participation projects were in relation to University students in assisting Universities to run table tennis clubs and establishing a challenge program. We also conducted the Victorian School Singles Championships successfully with over 70 schools and 1800 students involved from around Victoria. We received great assistance from VicSport through Julie Crothers in the running of these participation programs.

This funding period will finish in June 2002 when we hope to gain further 3 year funding.

## **VICHEALTH GRANT**

The sponsorship and support of the Victorian Health Promotion Foundation has enabled Table Tennis Victoria to continue to make progress towards a development plan. It is this organisation and its staff who keep us honest and help us to think of sharing our sport with the general public.

Thank you to VicHealth in particular Shelley Maher for her guidance and assistance throughout the program. We also wish to acknowledge the strong support of Nicky Lowe of The Heart Foundation, Emma McKirdy of Quit and Julie Crothers of VicSport.



## VETERAN PLAYERS (Alan Hopkins)

2002 saw yet again a change in the chairperson of Veterans Table Tennis. Val Crumbie who had held the position since September 2001 had to stand down for health reasons. I was asked by both the existing committee and the TTV Board of Management to assume the role. 2002 was an eventful year for other reasons also.
