MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT AND VICE PRESIDENT

President: Phillip Carruthers

Vice-President: Phil Davis

Two thousand and three was a difficult year for TTV in many respects. A major legal action brought against us consumed much of the management effort of both the Chief Executive Officer and the Board and diverted our attention from our major strategic goal of building the sport. A number of new initiatives were, however, commenced and these will be built on in the coming year.

A relatively new partnership with Combined Sports Traders has resulted in far greater penetration into the school system and methods of converting this activity into membership numbers will be pursued in 2004. At TTV's initiative the national body has agreed to remove financial impediments to TTV and other states recognising a "schoolkid" membership. The registration of all the school program players will enable us to boost our membership considerably, and ultimately boost our ability to attract both government and private sector funding.

A strong relationship with the Chinese Association Victoria was developed, leading to the establishment of a scholarship fund to enable elite Victorian table tennis athletes to train overseas leading up to the Beijing Olympics.

A marketing/development committee has been established, drawing upon members with specific expertise in business, marketing and public relations, and is promoting a number of exciting new initiatives. A grants committee has also begun to look at ways that our clubs and associations can access the range of federal, state and local government grants which are available.

An initiative of John Gale, from Bairnsdale, to establish "Keenager" clubs across the state has been supported by TTV. These clubs allow older people to participate in a more social but regular table tennis environment.

On the court we have enjoyed our traditional success, and this will be addressed elsewhere in this report. The Board's challenge is to have in place a structure and systems which will allow us to maintain and improve our leadership of the sport in Australia.

We would like to formally thank all the volunteers who have assisted TTV throughout 2003. The energy and selflessness of these people continues to astound me. We wouldn't be able to operate without them.

CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS REPORT (Martin Vink)

Due to the absence of the Chief Executive there is no Chief Executive Officer's report this year.

DEVELOPMENT OFFICER'S REPORT (Alois Rosario)

Part funded by Sport & Recreation Victoria

The position of Development Officer once again took on many challenges in 2003

- Coordinator of the VIS Table Tennis program coaching
- Conducted Teacher education for both Secondary and Primary Teachers and pre-service teachers
- Conducting school clinics and exhibitions on demand from schools and sports districts
- Resource development for Teachers
- Program coordination of Seniors Social Group
- Coordinator of Victorian Seniors Festival activities
- Coordinator of Victorian Schools Championships involving over 70 schools and 1800 students
- Coordinator of Victorian Singles for Players with an Intellectual Disability
- Development and maintenance of the database of schools and coaches
- Coordination and presentation of Level 1 Coaching Courses
- Conducting Development visits to affiliates
- Liaising with various disability groups (including VICSRAPID and Wheelchair Sports Victoria)
- Liaising with School Sport Victoria regarding Table Tennis Program
- Liaising with Australian Council for Health, Physical Education and Recreation (ACHPER)
- Coordinate Universities Program and conduct of Victorian Universities Challenge
- Conducting Training Camps for players

There was a continued interest shown by representative school teams especially from private schools to employ coaches to assist with the development of their school teams.

During the year we visited Ballarat, Bellarine, Bendigo, Dandenong, Hamilton, Mornington, Orbost, Orford, Portland, Shepparton, Sunraysia, Terang, Warracknabeal, Warrnambool, and Yarrawonga.

Thank you to all the coordinators in the association who spent many hours of coordination for the visits and the School Singles championships. Thanks also to Sport & Recreation Victoria for their funding and support of the Sport Development Officer position. Thanks to the School Sport Unit, ACHPER and Vicsport for their support and to the many teachers who put in their own time to assist the growth of table tennis in schools.

VICHEALTH PROGRAM REPORT (Alois Rosario)

The VicHealth program entered a new round of funding and continues the initiatives of Healthy Food Choice and Smokefree.

Table Tennis Victoria gained continued support from the Heart Foundation especially Nicky McKeown through the Healthy Food Choices program and Quit through Emma McKirdy with Smokefree in the first half of the year.

The new funding period sees the introduction of new programs such as the "Adopt-a-School Program", the Corporate Ladder and the All Students Encouragement Program. Along with these we will continue to promote the Healthy Environments Scheme commenced in the previous funding period.

Table Tennis Victoria greatly appreciates the continued support and funding from VicHealth.

These include Jean Humphries (Hamilton), Helen Wright (Yarrawonga), Jim Furness (Mornington), Bruce Harmer (Wonthaggi), and Mark Donohue (Leongatha).

Membership Cards - It is particularly pleasing that all registered players now have a plastic membership card. Our thanks to Worldwide Sports Insurance and Martin and Laura at TTV's office. Registered members can use the card to obtain a 10% discount on equipment purchased from AAA Table Tennis, Butterfly Australia, Combined Sports Traders, Gerada Table Tennis Equipment and Double K Table Tennis Sales.

A copy of the Affiliated Associations and Clubs is also attached. You will notice that whilst our paid numbers are the same, some have not yet paid last year's fees.

With regard to our registered members, we are down from 3386 to 3175, some 6%. I am very confident that this will be reversed during 2004.

JUNIOR PORTFOLIO REPORT

The Juniors Portfolio encompasses a wide range of table tennis activities pertaining to junior players within this State – however, there is no doubt there is a tremendous emphasis placed upon tournaments conducted throughout the year. However, it is very important to remember that it is the affiliated associations and clubs which provide the nurturing ground for many of our juniors, particularly in the organisation and playing of junior pennants and other like competitions. Furthermore, throughout the State, there are a number of other competitions conducted involving junior players such as the Junior Regional Competition and the Schools Championships. On behalf of the Board of Management I would like to take this opportunity to thank all volunteers and workers at the various associations, clubs and schools who tirelessly contribute to ensure that competition table tennis is played in this State.

Turning to tournaments, there were 16 Junior Tournaments held in 2003 and it was pleasing to note that overall the number of entrants has slightly increased from 2002. Thanks are extended to Ballarat, Eaglehawk/Bendigo, Dandenong, Geelong, Mornington, Sunshine, Traralgon, Warrnambool and Yarrawonga who all conducted junior tournaments in 2003. Overall the tournaments were conducted in a professional manner and it is pleasing to see so many volunteers who are willing to assist in holding such competitions for the benefit of junior players.

In terms of patronage at tournaments it would be somehow remiss if a special mention was not made of the enormous contribution one association made in particular to juniors in 2003 – and that is of course, Dandenong. This Association clearly provided the most number of players to each and every tournament and as consequence often dominated. The standard of their players, particularly in the lower age groups, and their large number of ranked players, is outstanding. Naturally, it comes as no surprise to learn that Dandenong again won the Junior Regional Championships for the sixth consecutive year, which is an unparalleled achievement.

In terms of the major tournaments, once again the Victoria Closed, Victorian Open, Easter Classic and the Moomba Tournaments dominated in player numbers and strength. In the Victorian Closed Championships, the winner of the U/18 Boys was Matthew Mazurkiewicz and the winner of the U/18 Girls was Mimi Lee. In the Victorian Open Championships, the winner of the U/18 Boys was Kyle Davis and the winner of the U/18 Girls was Mimi Lee.

The Australian Junior Championships was held in Sydney in 2003 and Victoria sent teams in all age divisions and several teams in B divisions. Victoria won gold in the teams events in U/18 Boys, U/16 Boys, U/14 Boys and U/14 Girls; silver in the teams events in U/18 Girls, U/16 Girls and U/14 Boys (B); and a bronze in the teams events in U16 Girls (B). Thanks are extended to all Team Managers and Captains and parents who contributed to the success of the various teams.

In the individual events, Kyle Davis won gold in 5 events including the U/18, U/16 and U/14 Boys Singles, which is a marvellous effort. Likewise is the effort of Melissa Tapper who won gold in the U14 Girls Singles and Doubles events. There were many other sterling achievements, far too many to mention, but in summary the players performed wonderfully well in an interstate environs.

COACHING REPORT

Victoria has again improved its position at the national titles relative to the other states.

There are now divisions where we have received a second medal for a “B” team performance.

Much of this progress is due to the intensive coaching programs in place within various progressive Associations and TTV itself.

We should not, and are not, resting on these recent performances, as internationally we have few competitive players. We have to work towards a much larger pool of highly competitive players to sustain and then improve our long term position. While this may seem obvious, it will require a great effort from the clubs and associations themselves to improve coaching availability. On a longer term basis, everyone should accept that without this effort in development, our sport will wither.

VTTUL members refereed and/or umpired at many tournaments (senior, junior and veteran) including the Australian Youth, Open Top Twelve, Victorian Open, VicHealth Easter, Victorian Country Championships, Javor Cup, City of Melbourne, Victorian Closed, Junior Top Ten, Australian Corporate Games and Victorian Singles for Players with an Intellectual Disability (a new event), all of which were held at MSAC. They also officiated at tournaments held at Ballarat, Eaglehawk/Bendigo, Croydon, Dandenong, Geelong, Mornington, Sunshine, Traralgon, Warrnambool and Yarrowonga/Mulwala. Victorian officials also covered the "Melbourne" pennant competition and State League matches, as well as Monday evening pennant at Croydon.

Upgrades

Eight people – Julie Guest, Fanny Ho, Verna Ho, Alan Hopkins, Helen Pottage, Theo Rosmulder, Ely Rosmulder and John Wright - passed the examinations for Level 2 umpires. The previous step of one year as Probationary Umpire has now been replaced and successful candidates immediately become full State Umpires subject only to completing 20 hours of official umpiring, culminating with two hours umpiring supervised by a recognised tester.

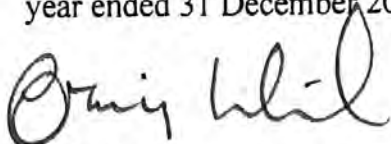
