MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT (Phillip Carruthers)

2006 has been another successful year for TTV, both on the and off it.

On the playing front our membership has increased from 3,523 to 3,779. Some clubs and associations which had been reluctant to join the table tennis community, in part or in full, have embraced membership. The CEO, Dale Gilson, has been able to produce another sound financial performance for TTV. We welcome Simon Gerada to the staff as our Club Development Officer and as Coach for our National Training Centre.

On the table we have enjoyed our traditional success at a national level in junior, senior and veteran competition. I would like to congratulate every player on their achievements.

Once again I want to take this opportunity to thank the volunteers who make Victoria the showcase of table tennis in Australia.

Finally I would like to thank the Board of TTV for their efforts in the past year.

CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS REPORT (Dale Gilson)

2006 was always going to be an exciting year for Victorian table tennis with the Melbourne Commonwealth Games table tennis component to be staged at the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre. A number of TTV Board members such as Phil Davis and Alan Hopkins were employed by M2006 to run the event with the remaining Board and many of our traditional volunteers offering their services to guarantee the event ran smoothly.

Victoria was proudly represented by Trevor Brown, Brett Clarke, Russell Lavale, David Zalberg, Miao, Stephanie Sang, Jian Fang Lay, Cathy Morrow and Jane Wallis at the Games. Congratulations to the Women's team on their Silver Medal and Jian and Miao who won a Silver Medal in the Women's Doubles. Congratulations must also go to William Henzell for his efforts in the Gold Medal match which generated a great deal of excitement rarely seen at such a level in Victoria.

Significant publicity for table tennis was generated in the lead up to and after the Games finished. This combined with the employment of Victoria's No 1 player Simon Gerada as TTV's Club Development Officer guaranteed player numbers continued to grow in 2006. New clubs are in the process of being formed in Victoria's population growth areas and TTV expects to continue to see significant growth at the grassroots level in 2007, and also in our very popular KeenAgers program for players only wishing to play recreationally.

As part of TTV's growth strategy we have achieved a more reliable and consistent financial result enabling more money to be spent on marketing to grassroots players. As part of this TTV produced the 2006 Player Handbook which was provided to Associations, Councils, schools and to any individual interested in playing table tennis. In 2007 we aim to increase this program further.

At the 2006 TTV AGM Keith Mundy was welcomed to the Board and became the Coaching portfolio holder. The Board and members took the opportunity to thank Jim Montgomery for his nine years of consecutive service on the TTV Board.

The Board of Table Tennis Victoria would like to thank all the volunteers, staff, officials, sponsors, Government agencies, such as VicHealth and the Department of Victorian Communities, for their support in 2006. 2007 will be an exciting year with the Table Tennis Victoria Super League to be launched and new clubs and Associations starting up across Victoria to cater for the increased demand for table tennis.

OPERATIONS PORTFOLIO REPORT (Phil Davis)

The TTV website continued to develop and by the end of the year had attracted over 87,000 hits. It has become the key repository of information for our members and is accessed by many. All TTV pennant results were processed and available for viewing through the website, as were those of our largest club, Croydon and Districts TTA.

The TTV Player Points system provided regular excellent performance tracking of our players, although some minor adjustments were proposed and implemented at the end of 2006 (essentially to provide encouragement towards increased participation in tournaments). The system enabled comprehensive consolidated reports for our selectors that they welcomed.

MEMBERS PORTFOLIO REPORT. (Bill Sheehan)

The news couldn't be much brighter – our total registered players now are 3779, the highest for 11 years. With the efforts of our CEO Dale Gilson and our recent Club Development Officer Simon Gerada, we aim to increase that figure to over 4000 for 2007.

In recent times we have taken on board Wangaratta, Portarlington, Sale, Moe/Newborough, Lakes Entrance and Corryong, all part of the growing KeenAgers program. Additionally, we've been successful in having more players become registered and insured and there is an increase in players in the Junior and Veteran ranks.

Dale and Simon are currently working on assisting new Clubs, particularly in the outer suburbs and country, to get up and running. In 2007 we expect Kew Junior Table Tennis Club and the City of Casey Table Tennis Club to be operating.

Anyone who feels there is a strong need for a Club or Association in their area is encouraged to contact the TTV office at any time for advice or assistance.

VETERANS PORTFOLIO REPORT (Fanny Ho)

2006 has come and gone quickly, and our players once again managed to demonstrate their fine skills in pennants and local, National and International Championships. Congratulations to all players.

Our regular Friday night pennant at the Melbourne Sports & Aquatic Centre was interrupted by the staging of the Commonwealth Games. However, the resourceful Veterans Committee was able to relocate the Spring Pennant to another venue to cater for those players who wished to continue with their weekly ritual.

In the New Zealand Open Championships over Easter, Victorians brought home more than 30 Gold, Silver and Bronze medals from teams and individual events.

Victorians who took part in the World Veterans Championships in Germany in May performed well over all. Players who deserve a special mention include Igor Klaf and Buddy Reid who won Silver in the Over 65 Mens Doubles and Joan Munn and Pam Tait who won Bronze in the Over 65 Womens Doubles.

The last major event for Veterans was the National Championships in Hobart in October. The Teams won 4 Gold, 5 Silver and 1 Bronze in Mens and Womens events in different age categories. In addition, Victorian players won numerous medals in the individual Singles and Doubles events.

In order to ensure Victoria has continual success in future years, the Veterans Committee has been actively recruiting 'young' Veterans – players who are turning 40 in 2006 – to join. As a result, we have seen a number of new players who now regularly participated in either pennants or tournaments.

We are only able to achieve these results and enjoy the achievements through the commitment of players and the tireless efforts of an enthusiastic and dedicated Veterans Committee. Thank you for a job well done.

SENIOR PORTFOLIO REPORT (Phil Davis)

2006 was quite possibly the biggest year for table tennis in Victoria, with elite athletes and volunteers taking centre stage. The year opened with the Commonwealth Games held at MSAC in March. The Australian Team was dominated by Victorians, with Jian Fang Lay, Miao Miao and Stephanie Sang in the Women's Team, Trevor Brown, Brett Clarke, Russell Lavale and David Zalcborg in the Men's Team and Cathy Morrow and Jane Wallis as our athletes with a disability representatives. Jian and Miao won Silver in the Women's Doubles and our Women's Team also got Silver. Miao and Russell Lavale were beaten in the play-off for Bronze in the Mixed Doubles, as did Miao in the Women's Singles. This was the first time such play-offs had been held. In previous Games we would have had two more Bronze Medals.

The Games were also memorable as a large contingent of TTV members assisted with the running of the Games. Yours truly headed up the team as overall Competition Manager, TTV Treasurer, Alan Hopkins, was the Field of Play Manager, Graeme Ireland was the Referee, Fran Keyhoe the Chief Umpire and approximately 100 hundred other members assisted as either Technical Officials or volunteers. The whole table tennis playing part of the Carruthers' family were involved with Phil leading the Field of Play marshals and Vicki and Caitlin in key roles with Sports Presentation (court announcing etc). The Games was heralded as a great success and the entire TTV community can take a bow for their key role.

A valuable legacy of the Games was the donation by the Victorian Government of all the sports equipment to various Associations and clubs around Victoria. This was widely welcomed as it injected thousands of dollars into our facilities.

Miao, Stephanie Sang and David were our only representatives in the Australian Team at the World Championships in Bremen, Germany. All three played critical roles in their team, with David recording a career win against Segun Toriola from Nigeria.

Robert Frank, Chamara Fernando and Melissa Tapper represented Australia at the Golden Racquets Tournament in Ho Chi Minh City in Vietnam in June but all found the going tough in a very strong field. Others chose to stay behind and compete for honours in the first leg of the national 3 tournament series. When the series was completed Simon Gerada came in second behind Commonwealth Games Silver Medalist, William Henzell, with Kyle Davis in 3rd. Stephanie Sang won the Women's series with Miao in 3rd.

Our Men's and Women's Teams won the State titles at the Australian Open in Perth, but were not able to beat the strong Singapore teams who took Gold in both teams events. Singapore also dominated the individual events, with the only Australian finals appearances by Miao and Stephanie in the Women's Doubles and Kyle and Simon in the Men's Doubles. Unfortunately neither were victorious. The highlight for our squad was the coming of age at senior level by 16 year old Robert Frank and 17 year old Kyle Davis who stepped up to lead Victoria in the key matches along with coach Simon Gerada.

At State level we noticed a slight reduction in tournament participation, although the regular absence of key athletes, the retirement of Brett Clarke and Russell Lavale, and the long term injury of David Zalcborg often robbed our State tournaments of top players of recent years. This may have been a blessing in disguise as it encouraged the emergence of the next generation.

Late in 2006 we established the Victorian arm of the National Training Centre at MSAC. Simon Gerada was selected as Coach and a strong program began in November. This programme is already looking excellent and we look forward to it playing a key role in keeping us on top of the other States.

We had eight representatives in Australian (Senior) Teams for the Oceania Championships in Geelong in June. Jian, Miao and Stephanie were again in the Women's Team, with Melissa Tapper in the C team. Kyle and Chamara were in the Men's Team, and Trent Carter and Robert in the B team. Between them they won a swag of medals, which is covered in more detail in the High Performance Report.

JUNIOR PORTFOLIO REPORT (Chris Horwood)

2006 represented another successful year for junior table tennis in Victoria. Despite the interruptions to the usual program with the staging of the Commonwealth Games at the Melbourne Sports & Aquatic Centre in the early part of the year, the results that have been achieved have been outstanding.

2006 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

Victorian junior players achieved outstanding results during the 2006 Australian Junior Championships in Melbourne. The teams captured gold medals in every age group, with minor medals gained by B teams as well. Victorians captured five of the six available singles gold medals, as well as a number of medals in doubles events. This outstanding result came about from the reinvigoration of the coaching programs and application of the players to their own continuing improvement.

TOURNAMENTS

With the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre closed to us early in the year due to the Commonwealth Games, a number of clubs took the opportunity to stage junior tournaments earlier in the year. These events gave clubs located away from the centre of Melbourne the chance to have outstanding juniors at their events.

INTERNATIONAL EVENTS

Victorian players took part in a number of overseas tournaments during the year and these are covered in detail in the High Performance Report.

TEAM SELECTIONS

Table Tennis Australia recently amended the age categories for the Australian Junior Championships. Players will now compete in Under 13, Under 15 and Under 18 age groups. These categories comply with the groupings in use in ITTF sanctioned international competitions. As a result of these changes, the Board has determined that selections for teams events will now be based mainly on results in competitions within the particular age group. The TTV points scale has been restructured so that age group rankings now only reflect the rankings in that particular category.

THE FUTURE

In common with many other sports, table tennis faces a struggle to attract and retain players in its competitions. The junior training camps, held in January each year, play an important role in exposing young players to the training requirements to succeed at an elite level. The ongoing group coaching sessions conducted by Brian Berry each Saturday and Monday is also instrumental in introducing new players to the sport. The schools competitions also allow us to seek new players who may already have an interest in the sport and who could develop further under experienced coaching.

Despite the challenges we face in attracting more players to the sport, Victoria continues to hold its place as the most powerful table tennis in the nation. Our players continue to make up the bulk of junior teams selected for international competition, and with the establishment of the National Training Centre based at the Melbourne Sports & Aquatic Centre, our future as a dominant force in the national scene seems set to continue.

HIGH PERFORMANCE PORTFOLIO REPORT (Joe Gerada)

Victorian players continued their domination in Junior and Open categories during 2006. Our junior players dominated the Junior Championships and Victoria won both National titles at the National Open Championships in Perth. A number of Victorian players competed in the Oceania Championships and World Junior Circuit event in Geelong and the junior boy's team qualified for the World Junior Championships held in Egypt in December 2006.

NATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE:

The most significant step in the High Performance area has been the establishment of a National Coaching Centre based at the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre. The Centre, which is initially funded by Table Tennis Australia for 2006/2007, provides a comprehensive training program for the Victorian Athletes chosen as part of the Table Tennis Australia high performance, development and youth/junior squads. Simon Gerada has been appointed as coach for the program and has developed a structure that caters for the elite athletes as well as providing an opportunity for selected players outside the nominated squads to join the program to speed up their progress towards the higher levels of the sport.

2006 OCEANIA CHAMPIONSHIPS – GEELONG:

The 2006 Oceania Championships were staged in Geelong with Victorian players achieving significant results. Chamara Fernando made the final of the Men's Open singles while Kyle Davis reached the semi finals. Trent Carter claimed gold in the Under 21 Mens singles, with Kyle Davis taking silver and Robbie Frank bronze. Kyle claimed the gold in Under 18 singles with Trent Carter taking bronze. David Powell took the Under 15 gold with Bun Tha Ung a bronze. In the women's competition, Miao Miao claimed silver in the Open singles, with Stephanie Sang taking a bronze, while Stephanie took gold in the Under 21 singles. Victorian players also claimed a number of medals in the various doubles and consolation events. Altogether, an outstanding result for all those involved.

2006 WORLD JUNIOR CIRCUIT EVENT – GEELONG:

The Australian Juniors faced far tougher competition during the Australian leg of the World Junior Circuit, held immediately after the Oceania championships. Australia finished second in its group in the Boys singles but was eliminated in the first knock-out round. Both Kyle Davis and Trent Carter advanced from their singles groups and the first knock out round while Kyle Davis & Robbie Frank progressed to the quarter finals in the Boys doubles. The outstanding skills and abilities of the overseas players who dominated all the events showed the size of the task facing Australian table tennis if we are to develop players capable of competing successfully at this elite level.

2006 WORLD JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS:

An Australian team comprising Kyle Davis, Trent Carter and Robert Frank from Victoria and Wade Townsend from New South Wales competed in the 2006 Junior Championships. In the teams event, Australia finished 10th out of the 16 teams entered. In the singles events, Kyle Davis reached the round of 16 before being eliminated, while the other players did not advance from their groups in an extremely strong field. Kyle combined with Trent Carter to reach the round of 16 in the Boys Doubles. I believe that this represents the best result that an Australian junior team has achieved at a World Junior Championships

JUNIOR TRAINING SQUADS:

The training squad based at the Melbourne Sports & Aquatic Centre continues to provide a pathway for young players to the elite levels of the sport. Programs are being developed with specific goals in mind to ensure that players peak at the right time to achieve the goals that they have set. The satellite squads at Croydon, Dandenong and Ballarat continue to deliver high quality programs that are reflected in the results achieved by individuals from those squads.

THE FUTURE:

Table Tennis Victoria is committed to providing the best quality coaching programs that it can to enable all Victorian players to achieve the elite goals that they have set themselves. These are particularly aimed at junior players, as a well grounded program focused on improving a sound level of basic skills will enable them to develop at the advanced level necessary for national and international success.
