The major item of business related to "Future Directions of Table Tennis in Australia" and in particular a proposal by TTV in this regard and the formulation of a Task Force to consider the matter and the recommendations it made.

Other matters discussed were the proposed future membership structure viz. a one tier system; stadium conditions at MSAC; strategy plan progress; the inaugural TTV Gala Auction Dinner and the need for U12 events.

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PRESIDENT'S REPORT (Bob Tuckett)

1998 was a year of commendable performance in many areas including:

- membership: an increase of 168
- finance: a turn around from last years deficit of some \$3000 to an almost balanced result this year.
- playing: Victoria won team events in nine (9) age divisions at National Championships including the prestigious Mens and Womens Team events.
Victorian players won twelve (12) individual National Singles titles including Mens and Womens Singles (Mark Smythe and Shirley Zhou respectively)

At the 1998 Annual General Meeting, Marc Huinink was re-elected Vice President, Barrie Epstein was elected Director Finance and Josh Kay was elected to the Board of Management. Subsequent to the AGM Josh Kay and Jack Stiglitz resigned from the Board and during the year Greg Linwood and Phil Davis filled the Board vacancies.

TTV took an active interest in the TTA Taskforce restructure of table tennis in Australia being the proponent of the original proposal that initiated the creation of the taskforce. Principal features of the restructure are:

- policy and planning powers (including financial) would be transferred to the TTA Board
- the State and Territories become the only voting members at TTA Annual General Meetings and all other General Meetings
- five (5) Board Members - the President, Finance Director and three (3) other directors will be elected by he voting members
- the voting members (States and Territories) have the power to endorse or determine in conjunction with TTA the State levy, fees and financial imposition
- up to four (4) Board members may be appointed by the elected Board members
- the National Executive Director will no longer be a Board member
- the Finance Director must be a qualified accountant
- voting members review the TTA Board's performance in achieving its predetermined aims
- a contract would be negotiated between TTA and States and Territories regarding the implementation of policies

TTV is confident that the restructure will be beneficial to table tennis at all levels.

TTV celebrated our first anniversary as a Tenant of MSAC (Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre). Despite initial teething problems TTV has developed a sound working relationship with MSAC and have forged a commitment to work together for the mutual benefit of MSAC and table tennis. Over 2 million people visited MSAC during its first year of operation.

Many major table tennis events were staged at MSAC during 1998 including: Australian Open Championships, Australian Junior Championships, Australian Youth Championships, Australian University Games, Australasian Public Sector Games, Victorian Open Championships, Yasaka Easter Classic, Victorian Corporate Games.

During 1998 TTV through the efforts of Executive Director Graham Lockwood obtained increases in overall commercial sponsorship. A grant of \$20,000 from the Department of Sports and Recreation enabled TTV to promote table tennis amongst groups totalling more than 1300 people of Non English speaking background, Koori's and women. These factors contributed to an increase in registration numbers by 113.

An extremely successful Gala Auction fundraising dinner was held. This event was well supported by the table tennis fraternity and an amount of \$4800 was raised by TTV which was used exclusively for the Development of table tennis in Victoria.

At the Affiliates Meeting in November a one tier registration system was endorsed by affiliates for implementation in 1999. A bi-monthly newsletter named "Short Serve" was initiated to keep affiliates more quickly informed of issues and Board decisions. TTV's magazine Nets N Edges is still published three times a year.

On a sad note Table Tennis Victoria lost two stalwarts in the passing of Karol Javor and Alan Cleaves. Both made a monumental contribution to Victorian and Australian table tennis.

In conclusion I wish to thank the TTV Board members, staff and Affiliated Associations and Clubs who have all contributed greatly to the development of Table Tennis in the past year.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Part funded by Sport and Recreation Victoria.

As expected 1998 was one of further challenge for TTV and while not as tumultuous as the previous year which saw the closure of the old centre and our move to the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre it nevertheless saw some significant changes which I believe were managed to the benefit of the Association.

The year at MSAC has been one of consolidation of procedures relating to the effective management of the table Tennis stadium. Some areas of improvement remain relating to bookings, fee collection and operating procedures and we are constantly working with MSAC staff to improve in these areas and to optimise usage of the stadium which is to TTV's long term advantage.

It took some time during the year to obtain satisfactory lighting levels and a suitable table configuration for the front section of the stadium. These, together with the provision of tiered seating in the stadium so necessary for spectators at tournaments has improved the stadium for participants. The Tournament Control Room has proved to be not entirely satisfactory for the purpose and for best results a supplementary control has had to be set up outside the room for each tournament. Despite no in-stadium canteen and a established centre court there is no doubt that the stadium represents a more comfortable playing environment than the "Old Centre". The table tennis stadium at MSAC has seen around 150,000 players/visitors come through its doors since it opened at the end of July 1997, and as such, it has provided a great opportunity for the profiling of our sport. The usage of the stadium overall is showing a marked upward trend with table tennis providing a little over 70% of total usage. The major non-table tennis usage has been for Volleyball and European Handball in the rear section and for sporting goods events such as the Toyota Golf Show and the Bicycle Show. It is important to the stability and financial viability of TTV to maximise overall stadium usage preferably of course for table tennis activity.

During the Year TTV conducted some fourteen tournaments at MSAC including the Australian Youth and Australian Junior Championships, entries for which showed an upward trend compared with recent years. Finding the necessary sponsorship to support these tournaments has been a challenge. While it was not possible to secure sponsorship for all events, overall sponsorship for the year was nevertheless increased. The loss of the Tattersall's sponsorship for the Victorian Open however was a major set back. TTV is very grateful to its sponsors (whose advertisements appear throughout this magazine) without which, we would not be able to successfully conduct these events. In particular, the support of the Department of Sport and Recreation and VicHealth are essential to the support of the administration and the development of our sport. The support provided by our many volunteers is another form of sponsorship, without which, TTV activities would be seriously curtailed. TTV is very much indebted to those volunteers many of whom particularly at Board of Management level put in many dedicated hours to running our sport.

The year saw the inclusion of a Gala Auction Dinner on our calendar of events the objective of which was to bring the Victorian table tennis family together around a "social table" and at the same time raise some funds to use in developing the sport. It is planned to again hold a similar function this year on Thursday 27 May. Funds raised last year, along with a special SRV grant for the purpose were utilised for development work relating to the introduction of more Non-English speaking background people and Koori's into the sport. Considerable effort was also put into promoting the sport to females. This work resulted in an increase in participation numbers in table tennis in Victoria during the year of approximately 1300 of which some 400 were from Non English speaking background. We will be continuing to build on the foundations laid in these areas throughout 1998.

Sport and Recreation Victoria have approved a grant of \$20,000 for the conduct of an international training camp in conjunction with the 1999 Victorian Open 15-19 August which, precedes the Australian Open. This grant will be used to promote the status of the Victorian Open (including the Training Camp) as a major satellite tournament to the Australian Open and in doing so attract a large international entry which will benefit local entrants from a coaching and competition point of view and also the Victorian economy. Invitations have been sent to some 70 countries to enter the Victorian Open and to some 28 countries to participate in the training camp. Prizemoney for the 1999 Victorian Open Championships will be \$11,000.

In order to keep members better informed TTV has expanded its "Short Serve" newsletter which is sent to all affiliates including a copy for notice boards. The newsletter aims to include articles of interest and a summary of the major items from the previous Board meeting. Readers feedback on this newsletter will always be welcomed. The publication of Nets N Edges has continued (3 issues this year) and is seen to be particularly necessary in view of the cessation of TTA's magazine this year.

Opportunities have arisen over the last 12 months to promote table tennis by active involvement in the Public Sector Games, the Victorian Corporate Games, the University Games and in organising a Rotary Tournament, as well as providing assistance in the establishment of new clubs at Box Hill and Melton.

At the Affiliates Meeting on 25 October members were given the option of staying with the current 3 tier system of registration or moving to a one tier system ie a flat fee for all classes of membership, (other than social/non competition players). The meeting voted unanimously for the latter system adding a request to TTV to consider no offsetting increase in registration fees and also a lower fee level for new Affiliates members. The view of the meeting was that a one tier scheme with no increase could result in increased membership as well as being administratively simpler. The one tier system was adopted and members notified of this change which meant a relatively small increase in the annual registration fee to enable TTV's level of income from this source to be maintained.

While registered members increased in 1998 by 113 it was disappointing to note that some clubs again failed to organise themselves to ensure all player registrations were collected. Appropriate action has been taken to ensure that similar problems do not occur again in 1999 with the Clubs concerned.

TTV has received an additional grant of \$5000 from Sport and Recreation Victoria for a table tennis program for the Disabled to be conducted in early 1999.

A Development Plan for 1999 has been prepared as a basis for our activities during the year.

I would like to thank our Affiliated Associations and Clubs for their support and co-operation throughout the year and wish them a successful table tennis year in 1999. I also thank the staff of TTV for their continuing loyal, dedicated and enthusiastic support and in doing so offer the observation that it would harder to find a better or more harmonious team unit in sport management in Victoria.

DEVELOPMENT OFFICER'S REPORT (Alois Rosario)

Part funded by Sport & Recreation Victoria

The highlight of 1998 was the emergence of the TOPS Manual and the implementing of the program in schools. This was a follow on from the SEPEP manual that had been established in 1996. There was great acceptance of the program from schools and the Education system in general.

School clinics proved once again to be popular with some 78 general school clinics conducted, and 85 clinics conducted in conjunction with affiliates

During the year I visited and conducted sessions for Warrnambool, Yarrawonga, Mornington, Dandenong, Ballarat, Sunraysia, Hamilton, Eaglehawk / Bendigo, Horsham, Warracknabeal, Diamond Valley, Dandenong, Colac, Traralgon, Friendship, Kerang, Coburg, Werribee, Melton and Maccabi.

Thank you to all the helpful people from the Associations that made the year enjoyable. A special thanks to Sport & Recreation Victoria for their continued funding and support of the Sport Development Officer position. Thanks to the Education Department School sport unit especially Doug Sandiford and Keith Grainger in the Junior Sport department.

VICHEALTH PROGRAM REPORT (Joan Guggenheim)

We wish to acknowledge our appreciation to the Victorian Health Promotion Foundation for the funding provided for the Active For Life Program. Once again we joined with Arthritis Victoria as our Health Sponsor.

The Program covered the entire range of players - Juniors, Seniors and Veterans - with sponsorships for regional pennant, tournaments in the metropolitan and country areas, State League, Victorian Schools Singles Championships. Metropolitan Associations Challenge, TOPS, regional recruitment and coaching of juniors, seniors and veterans, visits to Retirement Villages and Associations, coaching camps and school coaching at both girls and mixed schools.

The Active For Life message is continually brought before the attention of all Table Tennis players and the public by signage, brochures, shirts, entry forms, posters and bags.

VETERANS REPORT (Joan Guggenheim)

The Veterans Pennant at MSAC continues to hold numbers, averaging 100 players competing per season. Ballarat, Geelong, Dandenong, Hamilton and Croydon all organise Veterans Pennants. Most veterans enjoy playing a veterans pennant as well as an Open event.

The Tournament circuit of Mornington, Geelong, Ballarat, Croydon, Victorian Open and Victorian Closed provides ample opportunity for all standards of play to compete at their own level. Dandenong did not run a tournament this year but will do so in 1999.

The International Day of the Elderly was conducted this year at MSAC with booths in the Gallery section. We joined with the Over 30 Club from Princes to set up our booth. They provided an electronic display which was eye-catching and we used the small table as an inducement to go into the Table Tennis Hall to play, where coaches were available. This was a good day to showcase our sport as approximately 10,000 people went through the Centre that day.

Senior Citizens Day saw a large group of players taking advantage of the offer of free tables and coaching. There are always some country players who like to take up the option of being coached.

Eight teams of various standards from Melbourne Veterans travelled to Traralgon for an enjoyable weekend of table tennis. The Monday Morning club at MSAC is beginning to take off. Though there is no restriction on age most players are over 40. Extra effort was put in at Albury/Wodonga, Coburg, Mildura, Warrnambool, Box Hill and Warracknabeal.

As usual Victorians competed strongly at the Australian Championships in Hobart with 3 players winning Singles Events - Igor Klaf the Over 50, Case DeBondt Over 60 and Joan Guggenheim Over 70. Arthur Kenne and Joan Guggenheim won the Swaythling Award (see further details under Australian Championships).

Veteran table tennis is in a very healthy state and if you are over 40 this is for you.

JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT REPORT (Graham Lockwood)

During the year the responsible Board member for Junior Development Jack Stiglitz from Maccabi TTC stood down and Greg Linwood from Albert Park TTC was asked to take on the role. Thanks to Jack for his efforts over the last two years. Greg immediately developed a plan, a key note of which was to market junior tournaments more extensively which he and his Committee vigorously implemented. Their efforts resulted in a large entry of 159 in the Victorian Open Junior Championships. A large entry for the Victorian Closed Championships followed.

During the year eight junior tournaments in all were conducted by TTV at MSAC. In addition TTV conducted the Australian Youth Championships during the Easter period.

Unfortunately, Greg resigned from the junior role which he filled most ably in October. During his relatively brief period in the position he organised the City of Melbourne Junior, Victorian Open and Closed Championships as well as the Junior Encouragement event all of which attracted record entries. In addition to his tournament work, Greg laid the foundations for a junior pennant program that has recently commenced at MSAC.

We were indeed fortunate that Phil Davis, a regular A Grade player from the Werribee TTA volunteered to accept the Boards offer to step into Greg's role. Phil is generally well known throughout the Association in Victoria having played at most centres. Phil has developed Greg's plan for the Junior Pennant and also assisted in the planning for MSAC "Search for a Star" promotion to be launched towards the middle of 1999.

We say a big thank you to Greg for his contribution to junior table tennis in Victoria he has given it a great fillip. A sincere thank you to other members of the junior committee Angelo Tabone, Helen Pottage, Keith Holley, Mike Kredinac, Rafal Pronobis and also to Rachel Saunders and George Maksacheff who assisted with database and computer related issues.

TTV will be focusing on Junior Development strongly in 1999 recognising the point made many times by Greg that the number of children involved in tournaments (and for that matter competitions and training squads) is a litmus test for the future of table tennis.

COACHING REPORT (Jim Montgomery)

In the year 1998 we carried out an extensive development program within the schools and other social groups i.e. females, non-English speaking backgrounds, Kooris, University students - to widen our "catchment area" of players. These varied from one off displays followed by a free coaching lesson, to ten coaching sessions per group within schools over the term.

Our strategies to improve the participation rates of females work where there is sufficient support from the particular club or association, while University participation rates rest almost wholly on organisers within the University community being pro-active and co-ordinating with Table Tennis Victoria or their local association.

At State Level, my 1997 report listed very strong and successful teams and an expressed concern that we would need to increase support and standard if we are to retain this position, as other states are developing an improved culture and more extensive coaching and training. This proved to be an accurate evaluation in 1998 with Victoria still winning in the seniors and Under 18 juniors, but losing in the Under 16 and Under 14 events. Since it was predictable that we need to improve the culture and training within the sport in Victoria and not blame the talent of participants, a new structure for the training and selection has been put in place. The Victorian team members will have made a very large time commitment of virtually every Saturday and many Sundays through the year, quite apart from local weekday training and playing in their associations.

The coaching will be intense and carried out by Peng Quach, Alois Rosario, Natsuko Yokoyama, supported by Phyllis Scales and myself along with numerous "specialist" helpers to cover physical, psychological and training aspects as well as most schooling subjects to Year 12 to retain parental support. Developmental training for the Under 12 age group which has been planned to slot in and feed this Victorian squad is expected to commence in early March 1999.

Several Level 1 coaching courses were proposed or run during the year with only reasonable responses so a target group of young State and National level players were invited to the last coaching course. This proved successful. I would also like to report that several coaches are in the process of completing their Level 2.

At an Association level, I am pleased to report a growing awareness of the advantage of coaching, not only on the individual player but on general participation within their group and the growing pride of the whole association. New coaching programs have been started in four associations and old ones have been upgraded quite extensively in many others. We have also been able to co-ordinate city and country areas to best enable the use of our coaches.

WOMENS REPORT (Graham Lockwood)

The vacancy on the Board of Management for this position was not filled in 1998.

Mary Le Gassick had formed a Womens Development Committee in 1997 and some plans were laid which, to some extent were implemented during 1998.

The major work in relation to increasing female participation in table tennis was that undertaken by Jim Montgomery and Brian Berry supported by the Sport and Recreation Grant to TTV for 1997/98. This mainly involved development work at schools with emphasis on female students and girls schools to build the foundation for their increased participation in the future. Obviously, this work will take time to gestate before we see increased numbers reflected in our membership.

Another initiative, was the formation of a Monday morning Social Club at MSAC which encourages women to take up the game. Some small success of this program is evident to date.

In the meantime, number of women members decreased by 32 members in 1998 to 632 out of a total membership of 3559 to some 18% of total membership.

The Board would welcome volunteers to assist in developing female participation in the sport.

SENIOR PENNANT/TOURNAMENT REPORT (John Mackey)

Pennant

In 1998, four pennant seasons were conducted (Summer, Autumn, Winter and Spring) which kept the players playing most of the year. Unfortunately in 1998 we saw a decline in the number of teams playing in the three a side Wednesday Pennant, whilst the two a side Tuesday Pennant showed continued popularity with a slight increase. It is clear that the market place prefers the earlier finish (Tuesday night 9.30pm) compared with 11.00pm Wednesday's, as most new players chose the earlier night pennant. Hopefully in 1999 we can turn it around and if anyone has any suggestions put pen to paper and drop me a line.

The 1998 State League was held in conjunction with the Winter Pennant, with the Croydon team of Mark Smythe and Trevor Brown defeating Dandenong Dream Team, Russell Lavale and Robin Moore in the Grand Final. The State League would not be possible without the support of all players and the continued support of the chief sponsor "VicHealth". Many thanks for your continued support.

Tournaments

Five tournaments were conducted in 1998 by TTV: Yasaka Easter Classic, Leader Newspaper Victorian Closed, McDonalds Victorian Open, Watch Glass City of Melbourne and Centra Victorian Affiliates. These were all well supported by all players. Albury/Wodonga, Ballarat, Croydon, Dandenong, Eaglehawk/Bendigo, Geelong, Mornington, Traralgon and Yarrawonga conducted successful tournaments.

Also in 1998 TTV conducted two major events, Australian Youth and Australian Junior Championships at MSAC. Both these Championships were an outstanding success and well supported.

Many thanks to the following people for their contribution to the successful running of TTV events during the year. BOB GRATTIDGE, HELEN POTTAGE, GRAEME IRELAND, BRIAN PETTET, LOIS MCCONNELL, CHRIS BABA, BILL MCMAHON, ARNOLD PUTS and not forgetting ANGELO TABONE who does an enormous amount of volunteer work. Thanks also to the many other volunteers who assisted throughout the year to help make these tournaments a success.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

1998 was the first full TTV financial year at the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre where TTV is a tenant and also a customer.

The year saw the introduction of an improved computerised (MYOB) accounting program. The program provides more financial information for management control compared with last years accounting however, does not enable a direct comparison with all items in last years accounts eg. tournaments and National Championships, as a new Chart of Accounts was established.

The result for the year was close to break even with a deficit of \$412. The year saw an increase in revenue from fundraising, sponsorship/advertising and interest on investments. Hire income was of course well down, but more than offset by income from pennant, tournaments and other fees.

SPECIFIC ITEMS

Wages and SDO increases were largely due to employment of additional part time Development Officers during the year as a result of special Government Future Directions Grant. This employment has now ceased.

Increase in office equipment was due to the purchase of an additional computer which will enable more effective administration and also establishment of a Website.

Investments with AGC were transferred to CBA during the year. Investment difference to last year was due to transfer to JB Were Cash Management accounts for operations draw down and other investment opportunities.

"Investment Other" of \$4354 consists of 1000 Telstra shares and 547 TAB NSW Shares which as at 31 December had a market value around \$10,000.

Junior and Veterans fundraising have been shown separately in the Balance Sheet whereas previously included under Sundry Creditors and Accruals.

Members Funds are at last years level.
