The major issue for discussion related to the change in name to Table Tennis Victoria and the updating of the Constitution. Surplus for the 1995 year was announced as \$40,286. The following persons were elected to the TTV Board of Management: Mr Dan Elliott (Vice President). Joan Guggenhein (3 year term); Maxine Miller (1 year term); Jim Montgomery (1 year term) and Jack Stiglitz (3 year term).

PRESIDENT'S REPORT (Bob Tuckett)

1996 was a year of consolidation and in the important financial area a surplus of \$14,180 was achieved.

This surplus was achieved despite significant legal costs involved with the ongoing negotiations regarding the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre.

At the 1996 Annual General Meeting Dan Elliott, Jack Stiglitz and Jim Montgomery were elected to the Board of Management. Dan was elected to the position of Vice President and took up the communications portfolio whilst Jack and Jim were appointed to the Junior Development and Coaching/Technical portfolios respectively. For the first time in a number of years all Board positions were filled.

At this stage I would like to pay tribute to Angelo Tabone for his contribution to Victorian Table Tennis over a period of twenty five years. Angelo served on the Board in a variety of areas and on behalf of Table Tennis Victoria I thank Angelo for his dedication to Victorian Table Tennis.

Also at the Annual General Meeting our Constitution was amended to provide a more workable, up to date constitution. A new name was also instituted, this being Table Tennis Victoria and together with a new logo our aim is to present Table Tennis as a dynamic sport.

The crux of our Strategy Plan is:

- professionalism at all levels of Table Tennis

- increased membership

- improvement in the profile of Table Tennis

Small gains were made in the areas of professionalism and improvement in the profile of Table Tennis during 1996. However a reduction in our membership is a cause for concern. It appears the larger Associations for the most part have retained or increased their numbers whilst there seems to be a reduction in numbers for many smaller Associations. The Associations and Clubs that recruit in an aggressive and positive manner are proving to have considerable success with these methods. An increased player base will ease the financial burden at all levels - Association/Club, State and National - and will help lift the standard of our players. An increase in standard is essential if we are to improve the profile of Table Tennis.

It is pleasing to see our umpires and referees achieving success at international level and it was especially pleasing to see an improvement in player behaviour during 1996.

1996 was an Olympic year and coupled with the perseverance of our communications portfolio holder Dan Elliott this contributed to a significant increase in media interest in Table Tennis. In the lead up to the 2000 Olympics in Sydney, Table Tennis must take advantage of every opportunity to promote, market and develop our sport. Congratulations to our Victorian representatives in Atlanta - Shirley Zhou, Mark Smythe and Russell Lavale. Also to Russell Glasson and Ron Keyhoe (International Umpires).

During 1996 TTV also attempted to increase the profile of Table Tennis by having eight half hour programmes of State League televised on Channel 31. Due to various technical problems this endeavour was not as successful as originally envisaged but there is truth in the maxim - "nothing ventured nothing gained".

The inception of the Victorian Junior Academy was a significant event in 1996. In conjunction with Table Tennis Australia, Table Tennis Victoria is utilising the services of former Australian Champion, Nela Bran and the players participating in this program are now reaping the benefits of their dedication and commitment. It is pleasing to see major Associations employing coaches to improve the standard of the players at regional level.

The Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre is an issue of concern for all involved in Table Tennis. At the time of writing TTV Board of Management is confident of moving into the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre on at least a "no worse off" basis as exists currently. It is hoped that the Board of Management will be able to bring to the Annual General Meeting a negotiated position for the endorsement by members.

During 1996 Victorian players won National titles in junior, youth, senior and veteran divisions. Congratulations to all our State Team representatives on their success. Croydon Conquerors retained their National Table Tennis League crown and are the benchmark for National League teams to measure themselves by.

Kerri Tepper resigned as Executive Director to enable her to focus completely on her playing and business career. The Board of Management and myself in particular wish to thank Kerri for her efforts in improving Table Tennis in Victoria during her tenure as Executive Director.

After a rigorous selection and interview process Graham Lockwood was appointed to the role of Executive Director. Graham is a former senior executive with the AMCOR Group with extensive sales, marketing, profit management and corporate affairs experience. He is a Bachelor of Commerce and a Certified Practising Accountant. Graham brings to Table Tennis a wealth of experience in business and community service and a strong empathy with all ball sports.

It is with regret that I bring to the attention of members the recent attempt by "vested interests" to undermine the Board of Management. To succeed, Table Tennis must be united as a sport with all members supporting the democratically elected Board and respecting the constitutional and democratic process.

In conclusion I wish to thank all TTV staff and those Board members who have worked unstintingly over the past twelve months to ensure the future of Table Tennis in a selfless and devoted manner. I ask all Associations and Clubs to unite behind the newly elected Board of Management for the further development of Table Tennis in Victoria.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS REPORT (Graham Lockwood - appointed 13/1/97) Part funded by Sport and Recreation Victoria.

The past year has in many ways been a year of change and new events with a major restructuring of the Constitution of the association; a change of name of the Association to Table Tennis Victoria: beneficial changes at arising from the Strategy Plan adopted at the 1995 Annual General Meeting; World University Championships at Geelong; an International Referees Seminar in Melbourne; the new format Australian Closed Championships at Albert Park; the Australian and Oceania Olympic Qualifying Tournaments at Coburg; and towards the end of the year the resignation of Executive Director, Kerri Tepper. 1996 also saw the return of Formula One Grand Prix racing to Albert Park which resulted in the Albert Park Stadium having to be closed for a week in early March.

With the change of name to Table Tennis Victoria Inc. early in 1996 a new logo was adopted - a new image that reflects speed, action and fun. Table Tennis Victoria is a more succinct clear name that is customer friendly, easy to remember and is in line with the approach that other sports are taking. It is an announcement of a new approach and image for Table Tennis in Victoria.

During the year considerable effort was put into implementing many of the Strategy Plan recommendations. Considerable attention was given to continuing junior development and coaching initiatives. In addition. significant gains were made with the expansion of the Veterans competitions and a start made towards developing womens participation in the sport. In 1997 there will be continuing emphasis on increasing the sport's profile and the establishment of new venues and clubs.

Positive role models are essential in all sports for others to emulate and planning is proceeding to promote our elite players in the school environment and general community in 1997.

The introduction of Table Tennis into the Olympic program in Seoul in 1988 meant that our sportsmen and women have the opportunity to strive for the Olympic Dream. Three of our young Victorian Table Tennis players from the Croydon & Districts Table Tennis Association were selected for the Atlanta Olympics in 1996. They were Shirley Zhou at seventeen, the youngest person to represent Australian in Table Tennis at the Olympic Games, Mark Smythe and Russell Lavale. Shirley represented Australia in the womens singles and doubles. Mark in the Mens Singles and Russell in the Mens Doubles with Paul Langley of South Australia. All involved in Table Tennis in Victoria congratulate Shirley, Mark and Russell and also Russell Glasson and Ron Keyhoe (International Umpires) on achieving Olympic status and wish them further success in the future.

The year saw the gradual development of plans for the relocation of Table Tennis Victoria to the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre (where the Table Tennis stadium along with other dry sports will be largely managed by MSAC). The management of the retail outlet at MSAC was awarded to Swimming Victoria rather than a cooperative of all the sports involved. As at the end of 1996 the Licence Agreement with MSAC had still not been finalised nor, had it been with the other "dry" sports. At the time of writing this report the MSAC facility is scheduled to open on Sunday 27 July with the present stadium in Albert Rd to be demolished within two week thereafter.

In 1996 the awards for the Volunteer of the Year were opened to accept nominations for the awards from registered members who wished to nominate someone, and as a consequence, the number of volunteer nominations increased which was pleasing.

Many thank you's are appropriate. These relate first and foremost to the continuing hard work above and beyond "the call of duty" from Joan Guggenheim, Donna Griffiths and Alois Rosario. They are an exceptional team who are multi-skilled to meet the varying needs of the association. Members should also understand the heavy workload undertaken by the Board of Management in addition to the effort contributed by them at their own club level. While no longer on TTV's Board of Management, Angelo Tabone has continued to work tirelessly for both TTV and TTA. His expertise and knowledge has been of immeasurable assistance with regard to the technical facility at MSAC.

A most important thank you goes to the Department of Sport and Recreation and the Victorian Health Promotion Foundation/Arthritis Foundation of Victoria without whose continuing funding support would not enable TTV to service the needs of Table Tennis in Victoria.

A final but by no means least thank you goes to our corporate sponsors who graciously support our many development programs and tournaments.

1997 will be a year of even greater change with the move by TTV from its present location at Albert Road and the closure of the Albert Road stadium. It is expected that negotiations with the MSAC Trust will be satisfactorily resolved to enable a smooth transition to MSAC with a no "worse off" situation for Table Tennis. Such a move presents a significant opportunity for Table Tennis to increase its public profile with a consequent increase in interest and membership. All Associations/Clubs should ensure they take advantage of the impetus to table tennis that will flow from the MSAC facility, and the Sydney 2000 Olympics to promote the sport in their area.

With this downward trend in registered players a major thrust of TTV's activities in 1997 will again be membership development and a heightened Table Tennis profile.

DEVELOPMENT OFFICER'S REPORT (Alois Rosario)

1996 saw an upturn in the demand and servicing of affiliated Associations and Clubs. This is due in large part to the increase in dedication and energy of affiliates to development. With the increasing demands their needs to be further training of volunteers to cope with the varied tasks required to be performed by Associations and Clubs.

The year also saw an increase in the demands from schools for development services. This was due to the increase in compulsory Sport Education in secondary schools. With Table Tennis establishing itself as one of the recommended sports for secondary schools, many more have introduced Table Tennis into their Sport and Physical Education program. With the increase in Table Tennis as a school sport, Teacher education was also increased, with over 60 new teachers receiving basic coaching training for Table Tennis.

On the down side, TTV conducted school tournaments have declined and are to be revamped in the coming year. Schools are more willing to compete in competition run by their governing Sports Association such as VSSSA, EIS, AGS and APS competitions.

The big push for primary schools for the year was the establishment of the Sport Education in Physical Education Program (SEPEP) model for Table Tennis. As we were the first sport to produce the sport specific manual, several primary schools have taken up Table Tennis in their Physical Education curriculum. Due to the success of Table Tennis manual, it has been used as a model for several other sports.

The SDO scheme has established itself in the school and community as being efficient and reliable and a source of information and resources for teachers and sports coordinators.

Once again this year it was encouraging to see so many motivated volunteers in the Associations and Clubs, looking to better Table Tennis. These people will always require further assistance, however the tasks they are performing to push Table Tennis ahead is exemplary.

Thank you to all those people from affiliated Associations and Clubs who assisted me during the year, from the work of coordinating and running school and Association clinics, to the friendly advice of how best to reach the next town.

Thanks also to Doug Sandiford and Kathy Tessier from Aussie Sport, Teacher Education for their unending support of the SDO position and to Sport and Recreation Victoria for their continued funding and administrative support.

VICHEALTH PROGRAM REPORT (Joan Guggenheim)

Once again the Victorian Health Promotion Foundation funded the "Move It or Lose It" program with Arthritis Victoria being our health sponsor. The continued funding from VicHealth ensures that we are able to continue and expand our various programs.

These included sponsorships of Tournaments, Coaching Camps, State League, Victorian Secondary Schools Championships, Tabten, Women only events including coaching and tournaments, Inter Associations Challenge, Pennant, visits to Retirement Villages and Senior Citizens, Inter State and Association visits. Events which cover the whole range of players from juniors to veterans.

The "Move It or Lose It" health message is continuously promoted with posters, brochures, shirts, rulers, car stickers, entry forms, bags and bag tags.

VETERANS REPORT (Joan Guggenheim)

Dandenong commenced a weekly Veterans Pennant and Croydon restarted theirs. The Melbourne Pennant continues to draw new players - especially women who have come back into the game or who just want to try a sport in later life. The lowest grade is 98% women. This is what veterans is all about. Keeping fit and having fun. Geelong, Traralgon, Hamilton, Albury/Wodonga, Mornington and Ballarat all cater for veterans.

Inter Association and Interstate Challenges are now a regular occurrence.

Much has been done this year to interest Senior Citizens and Retirement Villages in participating in their local competition or at least using the facilities that they have. Special programs were carried out at Bendigo, Traralgon, Croydon and on the Mornington Peninsula. Programs were run during Senior Citizens week with Exhibitions and Coaching at the Melbourne Town Hall and "Come and Try" days at various venues.

One of the biggest events where we showcased our sport was the International Day of the Elderly at the Caulfield Racecourse where 8,000 people attended and our two tables were never without a line of participants eagerly waiting their turn.

The Tournament circuit certainly covers the needs of all participants with tournaments in Croydon, Ballarat, Geelong, Mornington, Dandenong as well as the Victorian Closed and Victorian Open.

Once again Victorians were outstanding at the Australian Veterans Championships in Adelaide being ranked No.1 in 7 of the 9 categories in the Order of Merit, winning 4 out of 8 Teams events. In the Singles events Brian Berry won the Over 40's breaking Paul Pinkewich's hold of 5 straight wins; Igor Klaf won Over 50's for the 5th time; Bill Bates the Over 60's for the 5th time; Prisca Rosario the Over 60's for the 2nd time; Wally Poole the Over 70's for the 1st time; and Stan Wynack the Over 80 for the 3rd time (see details under Australian Championships results).

While it is healthy to see the expansion of veterans in the larger associations, it is perhaps time to concentrate our energies on the smaller groups.

COACHING REPORT (Jim Montgomery)

The Victorian Academy was formed by Table Tennis Victoria (TTV) in conjunction with Table Tennis Australia (TTA) to service Victorian juniors and at the same time the Victorian Squad was formed independently by TTV to service another group of juniors. A general mixed age coaching group was also formed at Albert Park and managed by Hua Jie Yang.

Sports development and coaching at all levels has been expanded considerably in the Ballarat district and Traralgon continues to improve its regional system of coaching and is well established in the schools. An integrated coaching system is being trialed and developed in Geelong to cover primary and secondary schools and pennant nights as well as several more advanced levels leading to TTA Academy participation. The in-school program of 9 x 2 hour clinics per student has had over 1100 participants in 1996.

We believe coaching awareness and its relationship to both number and quality of player has improved, yet realise much more must be done in the future.

To name just a few areas not discussed above, Croydon and Dandenong have placed even greater resources into coaching, while Dandenong, Diamond Valley, Mornington and Albury/Wodonga have started effective programs.

A much closer relationship with the National Coach, Jerzy Grycan, and his program has been both sought and offered so an enhanced Victorian Academy is being actively pursued. The Victorian Squad was very successful, and while having a lower time commitment will continue to strive for excellence.

The Riverina Trophy procedure; ie coaching, district selection trials, Victorian selection trials, State competition etc. was successful. Coaching used as one criteria for selection to inter-association or interstate selection is proving successful in gaining quality teams.

Level I coaching courses have been conducted in several regions with success. An ambitious program of coaching development has been planned for 1997 so we will need to ask all members for their help and co-operation in achieving our common aims.

SENIOR PENNANT/TOURNAMENTS REPORT (Bob Grattidge)

Pennant

The introduction of the two person team into TTV competition on Tuesday's proved a winner. This now gives a choice to all players keen to play in pennant.

TTV held their usual three competitions during 1996 Summer. Winter and Spring. Players numbers were slightly down on the previous year, but with the expected move to the new Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre in 1997 it is hoped we can attract lots of players to compete.

Tournaments

TTV conducted five major events during 1996; Moomba, Easter Classic, Victorian Closed, Victorian Open and City of Melbourne. Other open tournaments were held at Traralgon, Geelong, Ballarat, Mornington, Dandenong, Yarrawonga and Croydon.

All tournaments were well received and supported by the players particularly at the higher level, the major concern would be smaller entries from women players and B Grade and below. It is hoped this can be turned around in 1997.

The point rating system is to be continued during 1997. It is felt this is proving popular with the players.

JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT REPORT (Jack Stiglitz)

Junior Table Tennis in Victoria has plateaued over the last couple of years and much effort has been expended during the year to stimulate growth but, with little success to date. The year saw no increase in tournament numbers which was disappointing and we all need to consider how we can improve this situation.

TTV has only certain mechanisms it can use to do this. It can stimulate and modify tournaments so that they can run smoother and there is more value for participants and therefore not discourage entry in these events. TTV has modified tournaments so that children can have more games in a shorter period of time. Because there are less events it is therefore less expensive, ie., it is necessary to enter special events and/or consolation events.

The job of TTV is to create training camps for elite juniors, coaching groups for all possible Victorian team members. It is the role of association to nurture, and encourage juniors in their area. TTV will provide extra help such as coaches or exhibitions if asked.

During the year an Under 12 carnival was introduced to stimulate junior competition and next year it is planned to introduce an Under 10 category.

A Victorian Junior Academy was initiated in 1996 and plans are in hand to upgrade that program in 1997. TTA have obtained funding from the Australian Sports Commission for a coach for this program. Next year certain other initiatives are planned that will place less demands on juniors, make it more convenient for them to participate, teach them how to play tournaments and generally provide more assistance to them.

Three juniors from Victoria have been accepted in the Olympic Training program, Trevor Brown, Simon Gerada and Yvonne Li. Trevor Brown and Yvonne Li were the top ranked juniors of 1996.

AFFILIATED ASSOCIATIONS/CLUBS REPORT (Fran Keyhoe)

1996 saw a reduction in player registrations to 3577 from 3875 in 1995.

Whilst this is very disappointing, some Associations and Clubs were very industrious and increased their numbers. Maccabi, Nottinghill, Melbourne Red Devils and St Kilda Cricket were the clubs which increased. The Associations were Dandenong, Eastern Suburbs, Hamilton, Leongatha, Mornington, Myrtleford and Traralgon. Well done and keep up the good work.

Many associations were visited during 1996 by Bob Tuckett, Kerri Tepper and myself. Whilst we were unable to visit all the Associations, I believe we covered all who invited us. Associations/Clubs have been encouraged to contact us with a date suitable for a time to visit them. Those that responded were visited during the year.

The Sportscover Australia Country Championships were well supported by 17 Associations submitting 80 teams. All matches were played at Albert Park, including the individual events.

An Affiliated Country Associations Annual General Meeting was held in June and an Affiliated Associations Meeting in October. I hope that all members who attended benefited by these.

I would like to thank all those who gave of themselves to make 1996 a successful year and would like to think that many more will channel their energy and expertise to work together for the better of Table Tennis. With the new Table Tennis stadium presently under construction at the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre and the attendant publicity this will generate together with the approaching Sydney 2000 Olympics, all Associations and Clubs need to fully utilise these events to assist them in promoting Table Tennis in their areas.

WOMENS PORTFOLIO REPORT (Marlene Bronstein)

I was pleased to take over the important womens portfolio in 1996 from Maxine Miller to do what I could to develop participation by women in Table Tennis in Victoria. In 1996 we gained funding from Sport and Recreation Victoria to prepare and conduct a womens survey to ascertain what action was necessary to achieve the goal to involve more women in the sport.

Preparation of this survey is underway, with a view to its completion, establishment of a plan and implementation thereof in 1997.

Womens Coaching program was conducted at Princes TTC, Traralgon TTA and Ballarat TTA. Princes TTC has continued on a regular basis.

Girls only coaching at Traralgon, Geelong and Hamilton continued during the year with good results.

During 1997 it is intended to establish a more comprehensive database of women in Table Tennis.

The move to the Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre in 1997 with its creche facilities for children should provide an excellent opportunity to promote greater womens participation in the sport in the inner south and eastern suburbs of Melbourne.

As usual, the VTTUL provided referees and umpires not only for the many events held within Victoria, but also a few for inter-state and overseas. An ITTF Referees Seminar, attended by Australian National Referees (all international umpires) and some overseas international umpires, was conducted in Melbourne by Colin Clemett (Chairman, ITTF Rules Committee), following which he selected for the World University Championships (Geelong) the Referee (Graeme Ireland) and four Deputy Referees, two from Victoria (Fran Keyhoe, Angelo Tabone) and two from NSW (Stephen Lee, Maurie Poole). As a result, Graeme Ireland became an International Referee, as did Stephen Lee and Maurie Poole. Both Fran Keyhoe and Angelo Tabone were required to complete the practical portion. Since then, Fran Keyhoe became an International Referee following her role as Deputy Referee at the 4th Global Youth Championships (Chiba, Japan - February 1997). During the year and as a lead up to this, Lindsay Drummond, Graeme Ireland, Fran Keyhoe, Ron Keyhoe, Ruth Singer and Angelo Tabone achieved National Referee status. Graeme Ireland, although initially appointed an umpire for the Asian Championships in Singapore, was one of the two Deputy Referees.

Russell Glasson and Ron Keyhoe umpired at the Olympic Games in Atlanta (Russell umpired the Mens Singles Final). Fran Keyhoe umpired at the Oceania Championships in New Zealand (umpiring the Womens Finals). Ruth Singer umpired at the World Veterans in Lillehammer, Norway (umpiring the Womens 40 Singles Final).

The Australian Veterans (Adelaide) was refereed by Fran Keyhoe. The Commonwealth Bank Australian Open Championships and ITTF Pro Tour (Brisbane), was refereed by Graeme Ireland, one of the two deputies was Lindsay Drummond, and umpires from Victoria - Russell Glasson, Fran Keyhoe, Ruth Singer - officiated. TABLE TENNIS CENTRE ALBERT PARK

The Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre at Albert Park is now scheduled to open on Sunday 27 July some two months later than originally scheduled and the present stadium in Albert Road is planned for demolition along with the other sports stadiums in the same area within two weeks thereafter.

At the time of writing there has been no final resolution with the Trust established to manage the MSAC facility on all the terms of the License Agreement required to be signed by all the sports concerned. There are several technical and licence agreement issues still to be resolved to TTV's satisfaction.

The Table Tennis Centre was not available from midnight on 4 March to midnight on 10 March due to the staging of the Australian Grand Prix. For this, disruption TTV was compensated \$5000 by the Grand Prix Corporation. During this period the Table Tennis Stadium is used as an assembly area for Grand Prix staff. Police and the Victorian Ambulance Service etc. Because of this, there is a requirement for caretaker to be provided by TTV.

FINANCIAL REPORT

1 JANUARY 1996 - 31 DECEMBER 1996

The following financial report are unaudited. The financial accounts are with the auditors at present and no changes are expected. The reports are enclosed to allow perusal prior to the Annual General Meeting. An audited report will be available at the Annual General Meeting.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL INFORMATION

We have continued to keep a close oversight on expenditure (as evidenced by the reduction in building maintenance costs) and to maximise income wherever possible. The overall surplus of \$14,180 for the current year is slightly better than anticipated.

During our negotiations with MSAC it became apparent that the income and expenditure allocation between the general activities and the table tennis centre in the past had not revealed the true contribution which the centre has made towards TTV's general financial position. When TTV no longer has use of the centre then the large majority of both income and expenditure items shown will no longer be applicable. Accordingly the figures for 1996 have been prepared, and the 1995 figures recast, with this in mind.

Specific Items

Total staff costs for the year, including wages, superannuation, Workcare, expenses of Executive Director and S.D.O., were \$92,239. This has been allocated towards tournaments, championships, pennant, newsheet preparation, and development and promotion.

There has been an increase in sundry costs which relates to legal fees associated with the revised constitution which was passed at last year's meeting, and costs involved with contract negotiations with MSAC.
