## PRESIDENT'S REPORT

1994 was a significant year in the history of Victorian Table Tennis.

I am pleased to report an improved financial situation for the year ending 31 December 1994. A surplus of \$9,209 was achieved for this period. The major reason for this turnaround was the implementation of wide ranging expenditure cuts. I must add that these costs did not impact on the provision of services to Affiliated Associations and Clubs. At this juncture I pay tribute to the Board Members who volunteered to perform the duty officer role at Albert Park. Thank you for your willingness to sacrifice your time and contribute positively to the well-being of Table Tennis in Victoria.

Although a good financial result was achieved in 1994 there is no room for complacency as there is virtually no further expenditure cuts possible. Further improvement in V.T.T.A. finances will only be possible through revenue generation and continued prudent financial planning. The V.T.T.A. Board of Management is committed to achieve financial growth and viability.

As foreshadowed in my report last year a Strategic Plan has been developed and circulated to all affiliated clubs and associations. The general direction of the Strategic Plan was unanimously endorsed by a meeting of affiliated clubs and associations held in November 1994.

In simple terms the V.T.T.A.'s vision for Table Tennis in Victoria comprises;

- professionalism at all levels of the sport
- improvement in the profile of the sport
- increased membership

I was heartened by the sense of purpose, positive approach and general unity of the Affiliated Associations and Clubs in their support of the V.T.T.A. Board of Management's direction and policy for the forthcoming years. The development of the Strategic Plan, whilst an important initiative, is only an initial step. The implementation of this plan is crucial and the Board of Management looks forward to a close and harmonious relationship with Affiliated Associations and Clubs in the successful implementation of the Strategic Plan.

The player registration fee is an ongoing issue of contention. 1994 was the first year the V.T.T.A. used the three tiered individual player registration scheme as devised by T.T.A. Our player numbers for 1994 were only slightly down on the previous year, a pleasing result considering the initial resistance to the individual player registration scheme.

After close consultation with affiliated clubs and associations, the V.T.T.A. has introduced a four tier system for 1995. This four tier system with appropriate fees has been overwhelmingly endorsed by Associations and Clubs and the Board is enthused by the display of support demonstrated.

The Melbourne Sports and Aquatic Centre to be built in Aughtie Drive by the end of 1996 is an excellent opportunity to increase the profile of Table Tennis. When this new facility is completed the current centres at Albert Park (Badminton, Basketball, Squash and Table Tennis) will be demolished. As with any new facility there are inherent problems involved. The V.T.T.A. Board of Management is negotiating with the State Government to eliminate these problems in order to provide an international standard Table Tennis centre for our members and the general public.

Currently there appear to be four viable options for the V.T.T.A. Board of Management to pursue:

1. Lease the new facility at a cost of \$150,000 (the current rental being proffered by the State Government)
2. Hire out time at the new facility at "commercial rates" for our tournament, pennant and coaching programs.
3. Seek out an alternative venue in the vicinity of Albert Park.
4. Run the business of the V.T.T.A. out of an office and not conduct tournament and pennant programs. A considerable loss of revenue is inherent in this option, which would need to be recouped by other means.

During 1994 our players performed magnificently winning National Titles in junior, senior and veterans divisions. Congratulations to all our worthy State team representatives on their achievements and playing demeanour.

Table Tennis Australia are to be congratulated on conducting a truly magnificent 7th World Veterans Championships at the Royal Exhibition Building. Victoria's own Van Chat Mai excelled in winning the O/70 Mens Singles crown. Congratulations Van Chat Mai!

1994 has seen a significant turnaround in the fortunes of the V.T.T.A. This has been due to the selfless dedication, concerted efforts and support of:

- V.T.T.A. Board of Management
- Executive Director - Kerri M. Tepper
- V.T.T.A. Office Staff
- Affiliated Clubs and Associations
- Volunteers
- Sponsors

I look forward to your continued efforts and support in 1995 as we move into the implementation phase of our Strategic Plan.

The V.T.T.A. Board of Management looks forward to continued close communication with Affiliated Associations and Clubs in 1995.

# EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR'S REPORT (KERRI M. TEPPER)

Part-funded by Sport & Recreation Victoria

1994 was a year of development and planning for the future.

The V.T.T.A. Strategic Plan was completed, with endorsement from Affiliated Clubs and Associations. With the implementation phase beginning in 1995, it will provide clear direction and focus for the future. This plan is headed by its challenging and exciting mission:

"To make Table Tennis the most popular, entertaining and high profile sport and recreational activity in Victoria."

A valuable meeting of Affiliated Associations/Clubs was organised by Fran Keyhoe (Affiliated Associations Portfolio) in November. Many developments and advances are being made at association/club level, a reflection of the commitment and hard work of the many volunteers at this level.

Visits have been made to a number of affiliates' Annual General Meetings and committee meetings in 1994. The V.T.T.A. feels that this communication has been both positive and vital in the development of our great sport throughout the state. Visits to associations/clubs will continue in 1995.

V.T.T.A. staff have continued to work well above and beyond what is required to ensure the smooth running of the office and Victorian Table Tennis. Administrative Manager Donna Griffiths has continued to run the office efficiently and with dedication that is to be admired. A special thank you to Donna for many hours of work on this Annual Report. Sport Development Officer Alois Rosario - part funded by Sport and Recreation Victoria, has continued to service more affiliates, schools and the community. In line with the Strategic Plan, Alois' role has become more focused in developing a link between exposing the sport to new people and recruiting those people into Affiliated Clubs/Associations. The benefits of such will show at Association/Club level.

The "Move It... or Lose It..." Table Tennis Program, led by Joan Guggenheim has continued to grow and develop into new program areas, whilst improving and expanding ongoing projects. Joan continues to effectively convey the importance of a healthy lifestyle through the "Move It... or Lose It..." message and the promotion of Table Tennis. Justine Bell started work in the V.T.T.A. office in October this year as a six month Jobskills placement (funded by the Department of Employment, Education and Training). Justine has settled in quickly with her willingness to learn and contribution being an asset to the Association.

Thanks also to the following duty officers who have worked in the V.T.T.A. reception at Albert Park during 1994: John Corbett, Andrew Gilbert, Dianne Kilderry, Glenn Pearse, Mohamad Tog-dheer and Clare Yang.



At this time it would also be appropriate to thank the V.T.T.A. Board of Management members who have all given up much of their precious time to volunteer as weeknight duty officers over a three month period. This saved the V.T.T.A. a significant amount of money and has contributed to the V.T.T.A. recording a surplus in 1994. Thanks again to the V.T.T.A. Board for their leadership, guidance and sheer hard work in their portfolio areas.

The many volunteers in our Affiliated Associations and Clubs throughout Victoria are to be thanked for MAKING TABLE TENNIS HAPPEN in our state. Your support and dedication is invaluable. Many, many thanks.

In 1995, Victoria will host three major national events - Australian Junior Championships (Croydon T.T.A.); Australian Youth and Senior Championships (Croydon T.T.A.); and the Australian Veterans Championships (V.T.T.A.- Albert Park). These events will no doubt be run to an excellent standard and we look forward to Victoria's continued domination on the table at these events.

May I once again close by encouraging all involved in Table Tennis to work together in improving our PROFESSIONALISM, PARTICIPATION levels and PROFILE.

I look forward to working with you all again in 1995.

#### **VICHEALTH PROGRAM REPORT (JOAN GUGGENHEIM)**

The "Move It.. or Lose It.." Program was once again funded by the Victorian Health Promotion Foundation (VicHealth), and sponsored by the Arthritis Foundation of Victoria.

Events sponsored covered an extensive range from State League, Victorian Secondary Schools Championships, Primary Tabten, Coaching Camps, Expos, Exhibitions, Tournaments, Pennant - covering the whole range of players from Juniors to Veterans in both metropolitan and country areas.

The health message was extensively promoted with "Move It.. or Lose It.." Posters, Car Stickers, Shirts, Certificates and Bags.

#### **AFFILIATED ASSOCIATIONS REPORT (FRAN KEYHOE)**

During 1994 we managed to hold the numbers of Affiliated Associations and the number of registered players.

However with the new four tiered system for Player Registration it will be easier to find a level for everyone - the number of registered players should increase.

In the later part of 1994, Bob Tuckett and Kerri M. Tepper visited many Associations and were made most welcome. I hope this continues in 1995.

In June the Country Championships was conducted, and a great weekend of Table Tennis was once again enjoyed by all.

## SPORT DEVELOPMENT OFFICER'S REPORT (ALOIS ROSARIO)

Part funded by Sport & Recreation Victoria

This year our emphasis was again on servicing our affiliates to the best of our ability. We set about to do this through several programs. The major one was the "Be Your Best" Expo program run by Sport and Recreation Victoria and Aussie Sport through the Department of School Education. In conjunction with this we have serviced Affiliated Associations and Clubs by linking the local schools with the Clubs and Associations and by providing coaching programs at the Association/Club after the Expo days.

We conducted Expos at Hamilton, Warrnambool, Wangaratta, Castlemaine, Geelong, Warracknabeal, Horsham, Nhill, Wodonga, Ballarat, Wendouree, Albert Park, Sunshine, Westgate and Pakenham. During the Expos we conducted clinics for the Primary school children as well as providing a practical teacher in-service session.

School clinics were conducted around the State. The most worthwhile clinics were those conducted through the Associations and Clubs that were followed by a Come 'N Try session.

Physical and Sport Education (PASE) courses were conducted during the fourth term. These were run by ACHPER to assist in the training of non Physical Education trained staff to conduct clinics in schools. This has been brought about by the Moneghetti Review into Physical Education and Sport and the implementation of compulsory Phys. Ed. time in schools and the need for more teachers to conduct sessions.

Specific Association visits were conducted offering school visits followed by sessions at Associations with Junior and Senior players.

I feel that to service the needs of Table Tennis throughout the State effectively we will need Associations and Clubs to be pro active in recruitment through the school system. I am keen to see each and every Association increase their numbers and see our sport thrive.

A big thank you to the many people who assisted throughout the year with the conduct of the programs. This assistance came in the form of anything from organising clinics to helping with the set up of halls to running schools tournaments to approaching local councils for assistance as well as several other varied duties.

A special thank you to Sport & Recreation Victoria for their continued funding of the program as well as their assistance with Professional Development and general support of the position.



## VETERANS REPORT (JOAN GUGGENHEIM)

The World Veterans Championships, held in May at the Royal Exhibition Buildings in Melbourne, was the focal point of the 1994 Calendar. Victorian players performed remarkably well with Van Chat Mai winning Gold in the Over 70 Mens Singles, Stan Wynack Silver in Over 80 Singles and Doubles and Wal Henry Bronze in Over 80 Doubles. In Consolation Doubles, Joan Munn (with a German partner) Gold in Over 50, Leo Marcen and Warren Woolcock Gold in the Over 40, Joe Noble Silver in Over 70. Which just proves that our Veterans are world class, and improving all the time!

More associations are providing their veteran players with their own pennant, and finding that an ever increasing number are availing themselves of this opportunity. Dandenong and Albury/Wodonga commenced this year.

Inter Association and Interstate challenges are now a yearly event.

Melbourne Veterans Pennant, played on Friday nights at the Table Tennis Centre, Albert Park continues to average over 100 players per season.

Veterans Tournaments held in Geelong, Dandenong, Mornington, Ballarat, Croydon, Victorian Open and Victorian Closed were all well attended.

All in all veterans Table Tennis is alive and well.

## JUNIORS REPORT (MIKE KREDINAC)

1994 was a very good year Victorian Junior Table Tennis players. A lot of success was achieved at all levels, including some excellent international performances.

Domestic tournaments were very well attended and competition was of a very high standard. Junior pennant on Saturdays was again played and quite successful.

Junior coaching after the pennant matches was regularly conducted by competent coach Hua Jie Yang. Coaching was open to all level players including beginners.

Victorian teams at the Australian Championships again won almost every team event. In individuals we have some outstanding players. In girls, there is Shirley Zhou and Yvonne Li, while Trevor Brown has everything to his own keeping in boys.

Youth Championships were also dominated by Victorian Players. Darren Webb, Rafal Pronobis, Vivian Yang and Shirley Zhou were winners all over these Championships.

Further success was achieved by Shirley Zhou in Oceania titles where she managed to win the junior events and then surprisingly the senior as well.

There's no doubt that the Australian Table Tennis Academy has helped Victorian players a great deal. We hope that this trend will continue into future years, so that Australian Table Tennis players can achieve even greater success.



## WOMEN/MARKETING REPORT (MAX COULTHARD)

### Women

Advancing Womens Table Tennis Seminars were conducted on 24 September and 15 October. These seminars were funded by Sport and Recreation Victoria. Topics included:

- Strength and Conditioning for Women in Table Tennis

- Nutrition for Table Tennis Women

- The Importance of a Balanced Lifestyle  
Speaker Deidre Anderson
- Being an Elite Athlete

We look forward to running similar seminars in 1995. Suggestions of topics are welcome.

There were three Womens Competitions conducted during 1994. Coaching was included free of charge for competition players for half an hour prior to competition each evening. This competition and coaching will continue at Albert Park during 1995 providing demand exists.

We have received \$1000 funding from Sport and Recreation Victoria which will be used to encourage women to take up Table Tennis as a sport for fun, health and fitness.

In 1995 a committee of three women will be formed to advise the V.T.T.A. Board of Management on women's issues.

### Marketing

As part of the Strategic Plan, the six regions in Victoria have been finalised. Each six months a region will be targeted for intensive support and development on a rotational basis. Each region will be advised of the range of services available and will be encouraged to take advantage of them. These services are also available to other regions as required.

A new affiliation package is being designed which will list all V.T.T.A. services and contact points. A promotional support kit will also be included to assist Associations/Clubs in advertising their activities.

The V.T.T.A. includes as a new service Strategic Planning and Marketing advice on a fee for service basis. Other services will be added as resources become available.

# SENIOR PENNANT/TOURNAMENTS (ROBERT GRATTIDGE)

## Pennant

The V.T.T.A. conducted its usual three pennant competitions: Summer, Winter and Spring during 1994. The three major clubs shared the prized "A" Grade Premierships, St Kilda Cricket winning Summer, Coburg Winter and Albert Park Spring. Playing numbers show a slight drop in the players participating. However it is hoped in 1995 we can achieve an increase.

## Tournaments

1994 tournaments at the Albert Park centre were Moomba, Easter, Victorian Closed, Victorian Open and City of Melbourne. Computer run events were introduced during the year, however a few minor problems did occur. It is hoped in time this can be rectified and computer run events will be a regular in the future. Successfully run tournaments were also held in Traralgon, Geelong, Ballarat, Eaglehawk/Bendigo, Dandenong and Croydon. All the tournaments were well conducted with a good entry.

## "Move It or Lose It" State League

The State League, contested by Albert Park, Croydon, St Kilda Cricket, Coburg, Ballarat and Geelong was played at the Table Tennis Centre of Victoria from May 4 to August 24. The Grand Finals were played at the same time as Winter Pennant finals.

The new centre proposed to be completed by the end of 1996. The V.T.T.A. has been provided a guarantee that the existing facility will not be demolished until the new facility is completed (ie. no "down time").

The V.T.T.A. Board of Management appointed a New Centre Sub Committee, comprising Robert Tuckett (Chairman), Ron Bayly, Kerri M. Tepper, Max Coulthard, Graham Ireland and Angelo Tabone. This committee has been negotiating with Sport and Recreation Victoria on a large range of issues, particularly functional and technical matters to date. Financial issues will be negotiated with the Trust. The Trust, which will oversee the management of the centre, will be appointed in approximately March 1995.

Members will be kept informed of all progress, particularly regarding the financial implications of the new centre.

## NOTES TO FINANCIAL INFORMATION

As indicated in last year's report, actions were taken to reduce costs significantly, increase income where possible and a break-even position was budgeted for. Due to very close oversight on expenditure, utilisation of existing stationery and stocks, and board members volunteering to assist instead of paid duty officers, we have achieved a much better result than expected with a surplus of \$9,209 for the year.

Comparative figures for July 1993 as well as December 1993 are included as this is a 12 month period (rather than a 5 month period to December 1993) and provides an easier comparison with 1994 figures.

We have again budgeted for a break-even position in 1995, however if registration numbers can be increased whilst maintaining costs at current levels another small surplus may be expected.

### Specific Items

Total staff costs for the year including wages, superannuation, Workcare, Executive Director and SDO expenses was \$89,614. This has been allocated towards tournaments, pennant, newsheet preparation and development and promotion.

The BIG event of the year, the 7th World Veterans Championships, was held in April at the Exhibition Building in Melbourne. Two V.T.T.U.L. International Umpires, Fran Keyhoe and Ruth Singer, were Deputy Referees (the Referee, Ian Finlay, and the third Deputy, Phil Males, were both from NSW). Umpires came from all over Australia (and one from Austria) to help with the mammoth task, including several "retired" umpires who volunteered their services during this period. Thanks go to all who helped in making the Championships such a success.

During the Championships, Russell Glasson heard of his upgrading to International Umpire, and later in the year Lindsay Drummond, Alan Peel and Lothar Pilz, qualified as National Umpires. Resulting from umpiring courses conducted by Fran Keyhoe, Victoria also gained four new Probationary State umpires - Brian Baker, Ward Leydon, Bill McLennan, and Richard Mielczarek.

Referees and umpires were provided for all V.T.T.A. conducted tournaments (Senior, Junior, Veteran), including the annual Country Championships (in Melbourne), for State League Finals, and for mid-week pennant competition. Also for some Affiliated Association conducted tournaments and for all National League matches held in Victoria, i.e. at Coburg, Croydon/Lillydale (Kilsyth) and Geelong, including the Finals which were held at Kilsyth.

The Ron Chadband Memorial Trophy was presented at the Yasaka Easter Classic to Kerri Tepper (1993 winner). Named in honour of a long-serving and dedicated Life member of the V.T.T.U.L., this trophy is awarded to the player receiving the highest number of referee votes, based on sportsmanship, ability, manner, dress and general demeanour, shown by a Victorian competitor in senior open events.

Four umpires (Fran Keyhoe, Ron Keyhoe, Ruth Singer, Angelo Tabone) attended and passed a Level One course as part of the National Accreditation Scheme for Sport Administrators (NASSA) conducted by the Australian Society of Sport Administrators. Lindsay Drummond had previously passed Level Two.

Internationally, Ron Keyhoe umpired at the Global Youth Championships in Tokyo, Japan (January) and received a special award ("Most Excellent Umpire"). Fran Keyhoe was referee for the Oceania Championships in Tahiti later in the year. Whilst there she conducted an Umpires Course from which three people qualified at State Probationary Umpire level.

### 3. VICTORIAN TABLE TENIS COACHES ASSOCIATION (KEITH MUNDY)

#### Coaching Development

The Regional Director of Coaching program continued this year throughout metropolitan and country Victoria. This program provides access to quality coaching programs to all players across Victoria. The Regional Directors of Coaching were involved in various V.T.T.A. and Government coaching programs in their region, including coach education courses and various squads for all levels and age groups.

Level 1 N.C.A.S. courses were held this year in Albury/Wodonga and Warrnambool by Keith Mundy and in Mornington by Keith Mundy and Bob Pappalardo. An Orientation to Coaching course was held in Traralgon by Keith Mundy. A total of 33 participants took part in these courses.

#### Riverina Trophy

Under 14 and Under 12 squads for the 1994 Riverina Trophy were conducted by the Regional Directors of Coaching at the following centres: Albert Park (Bob Pappalardo), Ballarat (Nicole Freeland), Croydon (Bob Pappalardo), Dandenong (Bob Pappalardo), Horsham (Geoff Stewart), Traralgon (Rob Thompson) and Warrnambool (Keith Mundy).

The training and series of selection trials involved approximately 180 players from the following Affiliated Associations/Clubs: Albert Park, Albury/Wodonga, Ballarat, Croydon, Dandenong, Diamond Valley, Geelong, Horsham, Moe, Mornington, North East Country, Orford, Shepparton, Traralgon, Warrnambool and Yarrawonga.

The 1994 Riverina Trophy was held at the new Albury/Wodonga Table Tennis Association stadium in November. Thanks must go to the Albury/Wodonga T.T.A. for the contribution they made to a very successful weekend. Thanks also to Angelo Tabone who was referee for the weekend. Team captains for the trip were Nicole Freeland (Ballarat), Bill Mitchell (Albury/Wodonga), Julia Morriss (Shepparton), Keith Mundy (State Director of Coaching), Bob Pappalardo, Geoff Stewart (Horsham), Wendy Stewart (Horsham), Kerri Thompson (Traralgon) and Rob Thompson (Traralgon).
