Presidents Report

Table Tennis Victoria (TTV) has had a very successful year on all fronts. Our elite athletes have continued to perform at high levels, with clear improvement across a number of senior athletes and rapid development of many of our junior players. Our veterans continue to contribute at the highest level, on and off the court.



Financially TTV has performed well above budget, reflecting both leadership by the Board and outstanding performance by the CEO, Anne King, and her team of Brinnen Reiss and Brad Clements, along with the many volunteers who assist the office. Particular thanks for financial performance go to Mark Taylor, who managed the financially substantial junior team attendance at the National Championships this year, and to the TTV Country Championships committee that provided a stable financial model for this year and for future championships.

TTV has made a number of changes in the past year, adopting a more corporate approach. The Board has focused more on strategy, in full confidence that the CEO and her team manage the effective and efficient operations of the organisation. The former Board portfolios have become committees, reporting to the CEO, with the exception of the Finance and Audit Committee, which reports directly to the Board. In a further change, the Finance and Audit Committee includes two non-table tennis playing finance professionals, from major accounting firms, along with the President, CEO and Alan Hopkins, a former treasurer of TTV.

These structures have been established to allow the organisation to focus on the four pillars of its strategic plan - participation, membership, club capacity building and development of coaches and officials.

The Board and management of TTV are conscious that TTV only achieves results through its clubs and associations, so the focus on club capacity building has commenced with efforts to strengthen the relationships with clubs, and well over 30 clubs across Victoria have been visited by the President and/or CEO in the past year, with the remainder to be visited in 2013. Frank exchanges with clubs and associations have helped TTV to provide better services to its members and to develop its value proposition for members. We are already seeing an increase in membership and participation, and significant work on coach and official pathways will be undertaken in 2013.

This year, TTV took great pleasure in inducting Vicki Parr (nee Woodward) and Leigh Pascoe into the Victorian Hall of Fame at a function where all past Hall of Fame inductees were invited, along with club Presidents. The inductees join a list of highly credentialed players who have performed at the highest level for Victoria and Australia. The induction took place during the Victorian Open, and followed a meeting of club and association Presidents, a model that will continue into 2013. The meeting of club Presidents was a forum to discuss and share best practice and ideas.

In early December, TTV took the opportunity to formally thank many of its volunteers at an end of year cocktail party conducted for that purpose. While a cocktail party is not normally the topic of a President's Report, the formal recognition of volunteers is indicative of the new approach underway. Without volunteers, we would be unable to offer the levels of support to the game that are needed to continue to build our great sport, and the (short) evening was a resounding success.

Chief Executive Officer Report

Having started in September 2011, there was little time to make any real changes in the last three months of that year as I was still finding my way and learning about the business and sport of Table Tennis. However, the Olympic year of 2012 promised so much and I was excited by the challenges, knowing that it was the start of an operational change.



A refocus on Board role and objectives, independent members, and a leap of faith by the Board to move away from

portfolios holders to committees, saw a new direction emerge. Together with the Board, we had already started to identify the pillars of our new Strategic Plan. This approach was strengthened by the support of the Victorian Government via Sport and Recreation Victoria and their endorsement on the direction we were taking over a number of fronts from speaking at our Board meeting, to endorsement with a 3 year Victorians More Active grant, and other smaller grants for Volunteers, Coaches and Officials. I believe good decisions have to start at the top and I would like to thank President Phillip Carruthers and Board Members for their support and counsel. They have individually worked on various projects, tournaments and committees far above the expectation of any Board member.

Our long time sponsor Affordable Table Tennis renewed and expanded their relationship with TTV, and the first benefit was a new membership card distributed to all members, along with an online club shop. We will see further initiatives expanded and rolled out over the next few years, which we hope will provide benefits to members and associations. I would like to thank Robert and Andrea Katsipis, for their commitment, passion and the easy relationship we share. We also had three new sponsors come on board; Cyngler Kaye Levy Lawyers, Acland Travel and Winning Edge and the Parkview remained our long-term accommodation partner.

We strengthened our involvement in a number of programs associated with the Australia Sports Commission's Active After School program, with VicSport, the Victorian Olympic Council, Sport & Recreation Victoria and the Victorian Institute of Sport with each organisation contributing to the support of our sport. Further developing our alliances with Table Tennis Australia and Oceania will see more opportunities for competition and program funding for our associations.

One of my first priories was to visit our Associations, to get to know how they operated, what their challenges were and importantly to seek their views. I was able to undertake the roadshow with Phillip Carruthers and with the financial support from SRV.

I am truly grateful for the time and courtesy extended by the different Associations, who operate out of wide, varied and sometimes challenging facilities. I was humbled by their dedication, and in most cases decades of commitment. These volunteer club administrators are the backbone of our sport and their contribution cannot be measured.

Following on from our visits, we introduced a Presidents Forum, which had 18 Presidents attend in the first year, and provided an opportunity to share ideas and exchange best practice. Members of our Board attended, and it was an opportunity for our Board and administration to listen and engage with its member affiliates, so that decision making can better reflect member needs. This day was combined with the Hall of Fame induction and lunch. It was wonderful to bring together the current administrators with the past Hall of Fame legends and Honorary Life Members, some of whom had not been seen for a long time.

Distinguished Service Awards have been introduced to provide an opportunity for Associations and Clubs to recognise their long-standing valuable volunteers. Whilst we announce these awards at our AGM and these are reflected in the Minutes, they can also be awarded throughout the year depending on the situation. It is my pleasure to record that Angelo Tabone and Wolf Nimmervoll (posthumous) were nominated by TTV and SETTA respectively and recognised in 2012.

I am fortunate to be supported by two professionals, effectively my right and left hand of Brinnen Reiss and Brad Clements. We are a tight team, and their dedication, support and work ethic has seen us deliver on some initiatives earlier than expected. Even under pressure, it is a pleasure to come into the office within a valued environment.

Our elite athletes performed well at the London Olympics, with a special mention of Robert Frank, Miao Miao and Melissa Tapper with their performances both on and off the court. A special mention also goes to Anna Du being named Australian Table Tennis Junior Athlete of the Year. Congratulations to all our athletes young and older, who aspire to complete at the highest level whether that be the Olympics or in their local pennant competition.

A special thanks to our State Team Managers, of Mark Taylor – Junior, Claire Montgomery - Senior and Nick McConnell – Veterans (replacing Bill Sheehan due to injury). I don't believe the role of Team Manager is appreciated until you actually do the role to understand the considerable pre work and long hours during competition required. The Junior Team requires a special mention due to the budget, challenge of looking after teenagers and satisfying the expectation of parents. Mark Taylor was appointed as part of encouraging new people and providing a sport development opportunity. Mark took on all the challenges and came away with the respect of his team.

Along with our established committees of Junior, Senior and Veterans, we also established two new committees of Information, Communication and Technology (ICT) and an independent Finance & Audit Committee reporting directly to the Board.

The Finance & Audit Committee was able to assist with some changes to the accounting procedures, input into the 2013 budget and the analysis of human resource requirement. The 2012 Financial report reflects a good financial result and a first ever-unqualified audit report. A special mention and thank you to the Chair - Rafael Morillo-Maldonado for his guidance, and to Alan Hopkins who has assisted in the monthly reporting.

After some membership decline in the last few years, I have pleasure to report the there was a 6% increase in membership. We also started to move to online payment and registration for our competitions. To deter payment on the day, we introduced a small levy, which has seen a successful transition to a future model of all payments being made prior to an event, which will bring us into line with other sports.

Thanks also go to our Junior, Senior and Veterans Selectors who at times have a difficult task, as well as our Vice President Phil Davis who diligently runs the points system.

Our Country Executive and Country Associations have a lot to be proud of, totally turning around a financially successful, break even, 61st Country Championships with a record number of 103 teams entered. Country Week as it is affectionately known is the biggest regular Table Tennis event in the Southern Hemisphere and a special mention to Jennifer Mee for all the work and effort she has put in over many years.

The VTTUL and its members under the Chair of Len Powell provide great support to our tournaments and competitions, and give us the confidence that we are in compliance with ITTF and TTA rules. A special mention goes to Neil Montfort for his work in accrediting new umpires.

The yearly calendar reflects the many tournaments that are run throughout the year. At our home base at MSAC we cannot do without our long serving volunteers who give up their precious weekends. A special mention of Bob Grattidge and to Tournament Directors; Peter Cathcart, Jeff Plumb and Nick McConnell along with their respective committees and thanks to Helen Pottage, who we have come to know as 'the voice', to guru Angelo Tabone who has diligently run our not so modern competition software and to Graeme Ireland for running some of the others.

Whilst I believe, we made good progress on a lot of fronts; I would be remiss to not acknowledge that it was also a difficult year. Threats of any kind and particularly litigation are taken seriously and require a lot of time. This only detracts from the real work that needs to be undertaken and can serve no positive purpose.

Whilst, I have not named them all, we have 55 volunteers who assist to run the operation that is Table Tennis Victoria. It was a pleasure to introduce our Christmas cocktails for volunteers, which provided an opportunity to say thank you and get together in a social environment. Whilst not compulsory, we introduced a dress code and the stand out was Bill Sheehan in a suit with runners!

I would like to acknowledge our 48 Associations for their work within their local community. Whilst clubs compete against each other in competition, off the court, we are united in our values and purpose to promote and build the sport of table tennis.

Finally, I would like to thank the members, clubs and associations who have assisted when asked and taught me so much, even though I am a very ordinary table tennis player!

Junior State Team Report

Team Manager: Mark Taylor

In September/October the Victorian Junior team competed in the national championships in WA. The squad of 62 consisted of 47 players, 14 volunteer NPCs and team management and CEO TTV Anne King.



Significant time and effort went into planning and preparing for this tournament, with information distributed to players and parents via 2 newsletters informing them of expected costs, accommodation, travel arrangements etc.

The cost per player was high (\$2050 including approximately \$100 for team management and \$310 for NPCs plus individual entry and uniform requirements) but provided the infrastructure to ensure the team was well placed to meet the challenges of a long week and ensure as team management we had the resources to cover usual but undesirable events like sickness.

Victoria came away from the Australian Junior Championships with two Australian Singles Champions, both winning over international opponents - Anna Du in the U18 Girls who won in 7 hard fought sets over Korean S A Han and Ivan Sulfaro who won the U15 boys in 5 sets over Korean W T Oh.

Victorians also won 3 bronze medals - Dillon Cathcart (U18 Boys), Dominic Huang (U15 Boys) and Atul Shrestha (U13 Boys).

In the doubles Victorian pairs won two Australian Championships with Kevin Luong and Bobo Zhang winning the U13 Mixed doubles and Kevin Luong and William Zheng winning the U13 Boys doubles. Victorian pairs and partners also received many Silver and Bronze Medals in the 9 doubles events.

In the teams, conducted over the first 5 days, Victoria brought home 4 Gold medals (runner up in U18 Boys to Korea, runner up in the U18 Girls to Korea, Winners in the U15 Boys and U13 Girls) as well as Silver medals in the U13 Boys and U15 Girls.

A highlight of the closing function on Saturday night was the announcement of the teams to represent Australia at the World Junior Championships – an all Victorian Junior Boys team Heming Hu, Dillon Cathcart, Nathan Van der Heiden and Ivan Sulfaro and special congratulations to U18 Junior Girls representative Anna Du who was also named the Junior Player of the year.

Congratulations to all the junior players from Victoria who took part in the National Championships – you were all very good ambassadors for your State. The parents, NPCs and team management should also be congratulated on all aspects of the trip, which went about as smoothly as I could have hoped for.

It was terrific to have both Anne King CEO TTV and Phil Carruthers President TTV present for the tournament, particularly as Victoria is hosting the tournament in 2013. Their support throughout the entire process of organising and executing this Team journey has been excellent.

Senior Committee Report

2012 was another year of trying to adjust the format of senior competitions, as well as the development of online entries and payments for events. Initiatives such as paying prior to competition saw entry fees paid in full before competition rise from 2% in 2011, to 41% in 2012.



There were a few notable competition omissions from the traditional tournament calendar in 2012, with the committee trying to open up the calendar for our Affiliates to give them better opportunities to schedule their events, as well as to allow flexibility for our Affiliates to introduce some new competition ideas.

The Victorian Open Senior Championships was a successful tournament that was hosted at the same time as the Presidents forum. Special awards were presented during the tournament and there was a good atmosphere during the finals with plenty of spectators watching the action. A Distinguished Service Award was presented to Angelo Tabone for his outstanding commitment and contribution to Table Tennis Victoria

Several other tournaments hosted at MSAC had disappointing entries, Including the Victorian Closed Senior Championships. The tournament committee will investigate further the possibility of holding fewer tournaments at MSAC such as the Victorian Open and Closed and concentrate on making these events bigger and more prestigious.

Junior Committee Report

A new junior committee was formed after the commencement of the tournament season. Due to logistics most meetings were conducted by phone.

Financial Report

Jennifer is confident that the tournament is running as per budget. 104 teams should generate revenue of \$15600 Inc. of GST, although revenue from the individual is expected to be down slightly on last year. Other cost will be built into a more detailed report when known.

Tournament Directors Report

Jennifer is pleased but surprised with the increase in the number of teams entered this year. The spreadsheet format of the teams entry form has proven to work well and reduce the tournament director's workload in tournament preparation. The accuracy of entering results still requires some work. Assistance from TTV staff on the Friday before the tournament was very welcomed and they are to be commended. A full tournament report will be prepared after the tournament.

Venue for future year's Championships

A discussion was conducted regarding the substantial increase in team fees. It is becoming a concern in that an increase between 10% and 20% is forecast over the next year or two. A number of clubs are finding it increasingly difficult to manage the cost of sending teams to the CC's. Some have asked players to make a contribution towards the cost of team fees for the first time this year. Albury, Shepparton and Ballarat have indicated that their players have a preference for the event to continue at MSAC, others would prefer a more cost effective option. Mark Kilinski advised the meeting that Geelong could host the event next year for \$50.00 per team.

Gary Warnest moved – For Geelong TTA to conduct a feasibility study on conducting the Country Championship at Geelong, then (country executive) to approach all country associations requesting them to advise the Country Executive as to whether their players/officials are in favor of relocation for 2013. The motion was second by Craig Archman, all were in favor, motion carried.

A meeting of the Country Executive will be scheduled for a date in October in Geelong to review the feasibility study and make plans for 2013.

MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING:

The Minutes of the 2011 Annual General Meeting were presented to the meeting. There was discussion on the accuracy of the minutes and the departure of the former Chief Executive Officer. Those who had attended that meeting agreed that the overall Minutes provided an accurate record of the meeting proceedings however excluded some comments relating to the former CEO.

CARRIED

ADOPTION OF THE 2011 ANNUAL REPORT:

Joan Guggenheim raised that there are still adjustment that need to be made to the 2010 Annual Report. Phillip Carruthers acknowledged and stated that these adjustments will be made. Ron Bailey also raised the need for adjustments and questioned why the usual list of life members was excluded. Phillip Carruthers advised that a complete list will be available on the website but will no longer be featured in the printed report.

THE 2011 ANNUAL REPORT WAS ADOPTED.

MATTERS ARISING:

Simon Gerada queried the process of appointment for Independent Directors and Denis Makaling queried the appointment of the Chief Executive Officer. The President advised that the vacancy of the first independent director was advertised via Women's Sporting networks, as it was desirable to have females on the Board. The appointment of the Board member to CEO was due to the high caliber of the candidate and the same procedure followed of the two previous CEO's.

AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION CONSIDERED:

Proposed Amendment to reduce the number of Board Members from 6 to 4 voted members. With 2 independent Board members, this would reduce the total size of the Board from 11 to 9. Gary Warnest raised concerns that with less Board Members, TTV will not be able to offer the same services or reach the strategic goals that were in the strategic plan. Philip Carruthers outlined that the Board reduction is a viable option. With new committees they are able to complete the tasks that extra board members would have performed. Philip Carruthers explained that this was the preferred model for all sports by the Australian Sports Commission and the Victoria Government. Sport & Recreation Victoria had funded a governance review, which recommended a smaller board as it operated more efficiently. To be well placed in the future to receive grants this reduction must be implemented, as it is a government requirement.

To resolve that Part IV – Board of Management Clause 16.2 Board Constitution and Clause 16.2.1.4 which currently reads 'six other Board members (who shall be Registered Individuals) with such duties or portfolios as shall be determined from time to time" with the following "four other Board members (who shall be Registered Individuals) with such duties as shall be determined from time to time".

If successful it is intended the Board comprises of:

- 16.2 Board Constitution
- 16.2.1 The Board members shall be:
- 16.2.1.1 a President

16.2.1.2 a Vice President

16.2.1.3 a Treasurer, who shall be officers of the Association, and:

16.2.1.4 four other Board members (who shall be Registered Individuals) with such duties as shall be determined from time to time.

16.2.1.5 two other Independent Board members (who are appointed by the Board)

Philip Carruthers ran through the outgoing board members and thanked them for their contributions. He then went through the new nominations which did not exceed the number of vacancies thus they were elected unopposed.

GENERAL BUSINESS:

- a) Max Coulthard raised that there needs to be a communication strategy for the future. Philip Carruthers acknowledged this and stated that while the strategic plan has not been finalised the new database which we are trying to implement, will be able to utilise the contact details that are stored within it rather than the current system of manually copying each contact, this should allow for better communication.
- b) Gary Warnest would like to thank Anne King and Philip Carruthers for the time and effort they spend in visiting each country association and hearing our views. Gary also asked if we had solved the issue of the poor PA System at MSAC. Anne King responded, explaining that we had raised the issue with MSAC but they did not feel like the system was inadequate. We may need to apply for an equipment grant to get our own system. Gary Warnest enquired with respect to the donated artwork in the office by Herman Pekel.
- c) Max Coulthard highlighted Horsham's poor facilities. Philip Carruthers responded saying that their facility is our highest priority throughout all associations and we will assist them to fix this issue.

Philip Carruthers declared the Annual General Meeting closed at 12.35 p.m.

TABLE TENNIS VICTORIA 5-YEAR MEMBERSHIP COMPARISON 2008-2012


