2009 has been another exciting year for table tennis in Victoria. Our membership has grown from 3820 to 3892 an increase of around 2%. This maintains the steady increase in membership numbers generally experienced over the past 6 years.

The Board has worked hard this year across a wide range of activities and I would like to thank them for their dedication and their efforts. Similarly, I would like to thank the CEO, Chris Horwood, and the staff, Shelley Snow and, more recently, Anthea Bonew.

This year has been challenging on the court. While we are still clearly the most successful state, other states have initiated programs which have been very successful in the lower junior age groups. This success will flow through older age groups in time and we must be vigilant in ensuring that we continue to foster excellence.

I would like to congratulate the Veterans Committee on 25 years of service. The success of the Friday night pennant competition now at MSAC is ample evidence of their dedication.

Finally, I would like to congratulate all the volunteers at TTV and at club and association level who work tirelessly to provide all of us with the sport we love.

FROM THE CEO

The past year has been one of significant achievement for Table Tennis Victoria. Under considerable stress, we have maintained our high competitive standards and established new athlete pathways into elite programs. Despite staff turnover, the office has continued to function efficiently and we have been very fortunate to attract high quality replacements whenever a vacancy has occurred. We can take pride in the fact that TTV office staff are actively recruited by others as they see the all round skills that are developed here as extremely valuable in larger organisations.

The Board continues to focus on its Strategic Plan for the next three years and establishing operational objectives for the next 12 months. The plan guides TTV's activities and determines where our resources need to be allocated. The current operational plan concentrates on building partnerships with schools sports associations and teachers colleges, attracting new players, especially females, into the sport, developing media profile and relationships and recognising volunteers appropriately. A policy for volunteer recognition has been developed and circulated to clubs and associations.

There has been significant turnover in our Administrative staff during the past 12 months. Sarah Gray, who had replaced Aimee Dundon, left to return to full time study. She was replaced by Shelley Snow, who had worked with us as a student volunteer organising the Victorian Schools Singles Championships. She was head hunted by Tennis Victoria, and accepted a position there. Anthea Bonew, our current Administration and Events Officer, then joined the office and has proved to be a valuable team member.

We continue to be fortunate to have the services of a number of student volunteers from a number of tertiary institutions who have assisted us in a number of ways. Students from the Sports & Recreational Management department at Victoria University continue to assist by organising and running the Schools Singles Championships. We have made contact with Deakin and Latrobe Universities and suggested to them a number of activities that might be suitable for practical placements with TTV that would also assist us in our activities. Recreational students from Kangan TAFE College are also lending assistance to us in carrying out some surveys.

The establishment of table tennis programs at regional sports academies has been a significant achievement. The value of these programs has been demonstrated by the selection of 4 players from the South West Academy of Sport squad, based at Warrnambool & Hamilton, in Victorian B teams or Presidents teams at the 2009 Australian Junior Championships after only 12 months existence. The recently established program at the Gippsland Sports Academy looks likely to achieve the same results. The objective of these programs is to provide elite level coaching at a local level for players based outside Melbourne. The results clearly show the depth of talent outside the Melbourne metropolitan area.

OPERATIONS

The TTV website continued to provide our main communication medium, with more contributors providing a wider range of news. Considering Super League did not run in 2009 website hits continued to rise.

TTA's membership database and tournament results system, introduced in 2008, failed to evolve into a workable system during 2009. We await developments from the new TTA CEO in 2010.

The athlete points/ranking system continued to evolve with over 1,200 on the lists. The Points Sub-Committee continued its good work; and for this I thank Michael Brown and Phil Boyle for their support. While the model on which our system is based continues to be a topic of divided opinion, the system provided excellent objective data for selectors and athletes throughout the year.

SENIOR

Tournaments

Thirteen Open tournaments were successfully conducted during the year, in addition to the three Australian Championships conducted by TTV on behalf of TTA. Starting in mid-February with the Open event at MSAC, events were conducted at Bendigo, Ballarat, Albury-Wodonga, Geelong and Mornington in addition to those held at the Sports & Aquatic Centre. A maximum of 30 events made up each of these tournaments, in accordance with TTA policy, including Over 30 and various grades.

Australian Championships

Under 21 and AWD Championships.

This event was conducted at MSAC in April with 66 men and 33 women taking part in the Under 21 championships and 44 disabled athletes taking part in the AWD championships. In the Under 21 event, Victoria was successful in the men's teams, with the State team claiming gold and the B team the bronze. The women's team took silver. In individual events, Victorian players claimed silver and 2 bronze in the Under 21 men's singles, gold and silver in the women's singles, gold and silver in men's doubles, silver and 2 bronze in the women's doubles and gold & 2 bronze in mixed doubles. The AWD championships had medals more widespread, although Victorian players enjoyed a fair share of success.

Australian Open.

This championship was staged at MSAC in July 2009, attracting 68 men and 30 women to the tournament. In teams events, The women claimed gold and bronze, while the men's team suffered an unexpected loss to NSW, with a silver medal and the B team claiming 4th place. In the Over 30 teams event, Victoria took gold and silver. In individual events, Victorian players swept all medals in the women's singles, as well as gold in the women's doubles and men's doubles. In over 30 events, Victorians were successful in the women's singles, men's doubles and women's doubles and claimed minor medals in men's singles and mixed doubles.

Australian Closed.

This event was staged by Croydon and District Table Tennis Association at the Kilsyth stadium with an elite field of 41 players taking part in the tournament which had only individual events. Victorian players took gold medals in the women's singles, women's doubles and mixed doubles, with minor medals in men's singles, men's doubles and mixed doubles.

The staging of three Australian championships in Victoria in the one year imposed a considerable strain on our volunteer resources and TTV appreciates the efforts of tournament director, Bill Sheehan, tournament director Graeme Ireland and their able assistants, especially Bob Grattidge and Penny Unthank.

TTV Pennant Competition.

Another year has passed and the TTV pennant has a solid foundation to build future growth. Whilst the team number entries for 2009 year were constant, there have been some encouraging developments throughout the past year.

Towards the end of 2009 season, a pennant sub-committee was established to help with both, the administration and growth of the competition. The sub-committee consists of Mark Harrington (senior portfolio), Bob Grattidge, Brian Berry, Robert Katsipis, David Pui and Greg Robbins (pennant portfolio). The establishment of the sub-committee is a positive development and provides greater resources and skills necessary to rebuild the TTV pennants.

In another positive development, a meeting was called in November by St Kilda Cricket Club to discuss the issue of declining participation by elite players in the competition. At this meeting, the concept of a Premier League was considered for introduction in 2010 year. The concept was to invite Olympic players, and players of similar standard, to participate in the League and to be paid for their participation. Premier League was only made possible from the sponsorship provided by MSAC, who agreed to provide free table hire for the competition. I also wish to thank Brian Berry for his efforts in signing up elite players for the competition and arranging sponsorship to secure the services of William Hanzell for the League. Elite players expected to play next season's premier league are William Hanzell, Simon Gerada, Miao Miao, Kyle Davis, Robert Frank, David Powell, Ravi Ganapathy, Dennis Makaling, Brian Berry and Eric Tan.

There are other encouraging signs for the Metro League competition. Simon Gerada is entering 4 new Melbourne teams primarily consisting of HWTT junior players, in next season's pennant. Simon's support of the TTV pennants is much appreciated. The MSAC centre is expected to be fully booked for the summer season of Premier/Metro League and the future looks bright.

Player Awards

The formula that TTV has adopted for the French and Coburg awards, which includes weighted consideration of the various criteria that have been established, has lead to the nomination of worthy recipients to the Board. The winners of these awards are listed elsewhere in this report.

JUNIOR

Victoria enjoyed continued success in junior ranks over the past 12 months, although other States are challenging our pre-eminent position. New South Wales and South Australian in particular have developed programs drawing on young players who will steadily advance through the age groups to challenge Victoria's dominance in the future.

Our results at the recent junior championships were not as good as we expected, due to an outbreak of gastroenteritis in the Kingston area of Tasmania that affected all teams in the competition, but seemed to affect Victorian teams and players at vital moments during the competition. Despite this, our players achieved some good results and all players gave of their best during the week. The Under 18 men's and

women's teams both claimed gold,, with the Under 15 girls team and Under 13 boys team also successful. The Under 15 boys team took bronze, as did the Under 13 boys B team, while other B teams just missed minor placings. In individual events, David Powell, Heming Hu and Jesse Bricknell filled the podium, while Lily Phan claimed gold in the Under 15 girls and Heming took gold in Under 15 boys, with Dillon Cathcart taking silver. Mitchell Ong-Thomson won silver in Under 13 boys, with Steven Phan claiming bronze. Wendy Li won bronze in under 13 girls singles, while Kathy Nguyen was a bronze medalist in Under 15 girls.

A number of junior tournaments were conducted, with large entries received. Heming Hu proved to be the outstanding player in Under 15, capturing both Victorian and national titles and under 18 titles as well. In the girls, Lily Phan has been challenged by young Wendy Li, but has emerged triumphant on most occasions. Anna Du showed outstanding form in a restricted number of appearances as she seeks to improve her skills overseas.

The development of the sports academy program at Warrnambool has increased the number of players vying for State selection and it was pleasing to see four players from their squad compete in B & President's teams at the 2009 Junior Championships. The establishment of a program in Gippsland in late 2009 will bring another group into the elite pathway, and in all probability, provide members for State teams in 2010.

TTV continues to watch with interest the developments at Maribyrnong Secondary College, where we are assisting them to establish a table tennis program and lobby government for funding for the second stage of their sports facility which will include the new table tennis centre. We would encourage potential students to contact the school to find out more about their program and the benefits it can bring for their sports development.

MEMBERSHIP & DEVELOPMENT

It is pleasing to report that our membership numbers continued a modest but steady growth over the past 12 months. Given the current financial circumstances, this is a very pleasing outcome. It is especially gratifying that many country clubs and associations increased their membership numbers substantially, despite the twin pressures of drought and finance. Albury-Wodonga, Bairnsdale, Ballarat, Orbost & Warrnambool were noteworthy examples, while Geelong almost doubled its membership in the past 12 months. The table below lists comparative membership numbers over the past 10 years

There have been a number of enquiries about the establishment of new clubs in a number of areas. To assist in this process, TTV has developed a new club information kit, which includes a draft constitution, by-laws and codes of conduct, along with relevant TTV policies. These will assist new clubs through the incorporation process and affiliation with TTV.

There are a number of issues of concern to clubs and associations regarding their access to facilities. Local government authorities do not seem to appreciate the need for certainty of access and the availability of appropriate facilities. Discussions are on-going with local government agencies to ensure that table tennis associations are able to develop programs and expand their activities in response to the demands from local communities.

2 local government authorities, the Cities of Manningham and Yarra, both have plans to implement new table tennis programs in the future. The City of Yarra, having surveyed their community, determined that there was a need to develop a table tennis facility within the city, and have commenced planning for a new stadium to include a table tennis facility within an existing hall close to the old Collingwood Town Hall. Manningham City has just completed a major Active for Life recreational survey and, among the items included within their plan is the establishment of 2 new table tennis programs within the city in the next 5 years. TTV has indicated its willingness to support both these new initiatives to the local government authorities involved.

2010 promises a bright future for the sport. With table tennis increasingly a sport of choice at school level, our plans to involve primary teacher students in basic coaching classes, and the development of our Sports Academy programs, we are confident of continuing growth in membership in the coming years.
